QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his second start of the season and first career start against the Angels...Went 4-7 with a 3.92 ERA (47 ER/108.0 IP) for the Samsung Lions last year...Allowed 129 hits (3 HR) and 88 strikeouts in 19 Korean Baseball Organization appearances... Became a free agent following his release from the Lions due to a calf injury...Made 11 starts with the Venezuelan Winter League before signing with the O's; went 4-2 with a 3.79 ERA (23 ER/54.2 IP) with 62 hits(3 HR)and 24 strikeouts in 11 starts...Signed by the Orioles to a minor league contract on October 12, 2023...Began the season with Triple-A Norfolk...Originally signed by Tampa Bay as an international free agent on July 2, 2006.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision on April 17 vs. Minnesota, allowing three hits with four strikeouts, one hit batter, and one wild pitch across 5.2 shutout innings; marked his first MLB appearance since September 26, 2017 at Arizona (w/SF, 6 years, 204 days ago), the most amount of time between Major League appearances for an Orioles pitcher since Danny Boone on September 16, 1990 (7 years, 351 days apart), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*...Threw 75 pitches, 50 strikes.

AGAINST THE ANGELS AND THE AL WEST: Making his first career appearance against Los Angeles-AL and third against the AL West... Pitched in relief in his last matchup against the division on August 8, 2017 vs. Oakland (w/SF)...Allowed two runs on five hits and one walk with five strikeouts across 3.0 innings.

DAY 'N' NITE: Owns a 1-6 record with a 4.97 ERA (42 ER/76.0 IP) in 27 career night appearances (7 GS), compared to a 2-2 record with a 3.18 ERA (16 ER/45.1 IP) in 14 lifetime appearances (6 GS) during the day.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Has posted a 1-5 record with a 5.73 ERA (38 ER/59.2 IP) in 19 career appearances (7 GS) on the road; opponents are slashing .270/.341/.539 (62-for-230).

MR. WORLDWIDE: Spent three seasons pitching for the Yakult Swallows in Nippon Professional Baseball from 2019-2021...Owns a lifetime 10-8 record with a 3.00 ERA (54 ER/162. IP) and 134 strikeouts in 40 appearances with the Swallows...Also played for Samsung in the KBO for the 2022 and 2023 campaigns; posted a 3.04 ERA (95 ER/281.2 IP) across 49 appearances (48 GS) with the Lions.
