# **THE NL CHAMPS:** Last season, the D-backs captured their second NL pennant and made their second trip to the World Series, first since winning it all in 2001, in their seventh Postseason berth ('99, '01, '02, '07, '11, '17, '23).

**ROSTER MOVES:** The D-backs reinstated RHP **Ryne Nelson** from the 15-day injured list (right elbow contusion) and optioned LHP **Brandon Hughes** to Triple-A Reno following last night's game.

**VS. PADRES:** Last season, the D-backs took the season series vs. Padres 7-6 (3-4 @ home, 4-2 on the road), outscoring them 26-16 (+10 run differential).

The D-backs won 5 of their last 6 games vs. Padres.

- LAST GAME: The D-backs fell to the Padres 13-1 last night.
- Ketel Marte hit safely in his sixth straight game.
- Gabriel Moreno collected his sixth multi-hit game of the season, tallying the lone RBI of the night.
- Brandon Pfaadt tossed his second consecutive quality start (L; 3 ER in 6.0 IP).

**LINEUP PRODUCTION:** D-backs' 1-4 batters have compiled 70 walks and a .354 OBP, which ranks second and third in the NL, respectively, while batters 6-9 rank first in the NL with fewest strikeouts (102) and second in RBI (69).

WALKER'S BUZZIN': Christian Walker has reached base safely in 10 of his last 11 games...in the span, he boasts a 1.027 OPS with 1 double, 4 homers, 9 RBI and 6 walks.

- Since April 22, Christian Walker's 4 homers are tied for the most in the NL (also: Nick Senzel/WSH, Christopher Morel/CHC and Max Muncy/LAD).
- Defensively, Walker currently boasts a 34-game errorless streak, tied for the second-longest (also: 3 others), behind Teoscar Hernández/LAD (35) and Juan Soto/NYY (35).

**SEEING IT WELL VS. SD:** Since 2022, **Christian Walker**'s 8 homers vs. Padres are third most among all players (min. 100 PA), behind Mookie Betts/LAD (11; .720 SLG) and Ryan McMahon/COL (9; .603 SLG).

Since 2022, Ketel Marte's 23 strikeouts in 121 PA vs. Padres are tied for fourth fewest among all players (min. 100 PA) [also: Freddie Freeman/LAD (23 in 164 PA)], behind Wilmer Flores/SF (19 in 113 PA), Will Smith/LAD (21 in 147 PA) and Mookie Betts/LAD (22 in 159 PA).

**ATTENDANCE BOOST:** The D-backs 584,142 total home attendance in 18 openings is currently the sixth largest in the Majors, behind the Dodgers (871,526), Padres (772,923), Phillies (692,351), Astros (605,599) and Rangers (585,190).

♦ It is the first time Chase Field has welcomed 580,000+ fans thru the first 18 openings since 2004 (593,436).

**GOLDEN BACKSTOPS:** D-back backstops' 8 stolen bases allowed and 14 attempts are the fewest in the Majors. **Gabriel Moreno's** 50.0 caught-stealing pct. (5-for-10)

leads the Majors (min. 10 SBA).

 Moreno leads active catchers with a 40.5 caught-stealing pct. (34-for-84) and Tucker Barnhart is 11th with a 30.7 CS pct. (171-for-557).

**bWAR RANKINGS:** Ketel Marte's 2.4 bWAR is tied for second among all players (pitcher or position) with 2 others, behind Mookie Betts/LAD (3.2) while his 0.9 defensive bWAR is third, behind Marcus Semien/TEX (1.2) and Bobby Witt Jr./KC (1.0).

**HARD HITTING:** The D-backs' 343 hard hit balls (Batted balls with exit velocity of 95 mph+) rank fifth in the NL, behind the Dodgers (422), Padres (381), Braves (368) and Phillies (344).

 Ketel Marte's 56 hard hits are tied for fourth among NL players (also: Mookie Betts/LAD), behind Shohei Ohtani/LAD (67), Fernando Tatis Jr./SD (57) and William Contreras/MIL (57).

SAVING RUNS [courtesy fieldingbible.com]: Christian Walker's 8 defensive runs saved (DRS) are tied for second in the Majors (also: Daulton Varsho/TOR), behind Marcus Semien/TEX (11) while Ketel Marte's 7 are tied for fourth.
 The D-backs' 16 DRS as a team are second in the NL, behind the Dodgers (19).

**JOC KNOCK:** Since April 22, **Joc Pederson**'s .474 BABIP (Batting Average on Balls in Play) ranks second in the NL, behind Alec Bohm/PHI (.524), while his 52.6 pct. out rate ranks second in the NL, behind Bohm (47.6%).

**LIMITING THE STRIKEOUT:** The D-backs' 19.2% strikeout rate is the lowest in the NL, ahead of the Padres (19.8), Mets (20.0), Marlins (20.2) and Dodgers (21.0), while their 2.04 strikeout-to-walk ratio is the second lowest to the Dodgers (1.92).
