RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a nine-game, 10-day homestand against the Mets (3-0), White Sox (3 to play) and Yankees (3 to play) tonight at Tropicana Field...the Rays have won a season-high-tying three straight games (also April 9-12)...last series against the Mets, Tampa Bay earned its first series sweep of the season, its first three-game sweep since Aug. 22-24, 2023 vs. Colorado and its second walk-off victory of the season (also April 16 vs. LAA).

★ **RF Jonny DeLuca** (2-for-4, 3B, 3RBI, BB, R) registered his first career walk-off plate appearance and first three-bagger, tallying the fifth walk-off triple in Rays history, including the first since **Kevin Kiermaier** did so July 26, 2020 vs. TOR.

★ The Rays drew a season-high nine walks and stole a season-high seven bases...they became the first club in the majors this season with 9+ BB and 7+ SB in a single game and the first team to accomplish the feat since Arizona did so at Milwaukee on June 21, 2023 (9BB, 7SB).

★ Each of the Rays last eight wins have come by two runs or fewer, their longest such streak since an eight-game run from June 3-14, 2015...their 13 total such wins are second most in the majors behind the Yankees (14), and their .667 (13-6) winning pct. in such contests ranks third behind the Phillies (11-2/.846) and Orioles (11-5/.688).

★ Tonight, Tampa Bay can capture a fourth straight win for the first time since another four-game streak from Sept. 8-11, 2023...the Rays can also earn their fifth straight win at Tropicana Field for the first time since another five-game run May 28-June 9, 2023.

★ After beginning the season 1-8 in series openers, a win tonight would mark Tampa Bay's third straight series-opening victory.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS—Prior to tonight's game, Tampa Bay reinstated OF **Josh Lowe** (right oblique strain) from the 10-day IL and optioned LHP **Jacob Lopez** to Triple-A Durham...additionally, RHP **Edwin Uceta** had his contract selected from Durham and INF **Niko Goodrum** was designated for assignment.

★ Lowe played six games for the Bulls during his rehab stint and hit .231 (9-for-39) with 3 HR and 11 RBI...he brings an active career-high-tying 11-game MLB hitting streak dating back to Sept. 15, 2023.

★ Since allowing 5 ER over 2.0 IP in his season debut on March 30 at Norfolk, Uceta has posted a 5.06 ERA (16.0IP, 9ER) with 18 SO over his last nine appearances.

WALK-OFF STUFF—According to Elias, **Jonny DeLuca** became the fifth player in team history to record a walk-off RBI in one of their first three games with Tampa Bay, joining **Brandon Allen** (HR) on April 26, 2012 vs. Los Angeles-AL, **Joel Guzmán** (single) on Aug. 19, 2007 vs. Cleveland, **Nick Green** (single) on April 8, 2005 vs. Oakland and **Eduardo Pérez** (single) on April 9, 2004 vs. Baltimore.

RUNNING WILD—In yesterday's win, the Rays stole 7+ bases for the fifth time in franchise history, the last coming on May 25, 2023 vs. Toronto...the 2009 Rays stole a franchise-best eight bags on May 3 vs. Boston.

★ The 2024 club became the first team in the majors to this season reach the 7+ SB mark, including the first since Arizona stole eight bags at Minnesota on Aug. 6, 2023.

★ Four Rays tallied at least one steal, including **José Caballero** (4SB), **Randy Arozarena** (1SB), **Richie Palacios** (1SB) and **Amed Rosario** (1SB)...it marked the first time May 28, 2023 vs. Los Angeles-NL that four different Rays recorded a stolen base (B. Lowe, J. Lowe, Raley, Siri).

★ Tampa Bay has an AL-best 40 stolen bases on the year, fourth in the majors behind Cincinnati/Washington (57SB each) and Milwaukee (45SB).

RARE COMPANY—In yesterday's walk-off victory, **SS José Caballero** did not record a hit, but drew a career-high three walks and stole a career-high four bases...he became the 14th player (15th instance) to record 3+ BB and 4+ SB in a game since 1901, including the first since LAD **Dave Roberts** on April 9, 2004 vs. Colorado.

★ He became the second Ray (3rd instance) to steal 4+ bases in a game, joining **Carl Crawford** (6SB on May 3, 2009 vs. BOS & 4 SB on May 24, 2006 at TOR)...he became the first player in the majors with 4+ SB in a game since WSH **Lane Thomas** (4) on July 23, 2023 vs. San Francisco.

★ His 13 SB overall pace the AL and rank fourth in the majors behind CIN **Elly De La Cruz** (19SB) and ATL **Ronald Acuña Jr./MIL Brice Turang** (14SB each)...it marks the most steals through a player's first 31 games with the Rays in club history.

RAYS ON THE RISE—**Isaac Paredes** has reached base safely in 16 straight home games, the third-longest active streak in the AL behind LAA **Mike Trout** (21G) and LAA **Luis Rengifo** (19G)...the last Ray with a longer streak was **Yandy Díaz** (21G) from May 2-June 25, 2023.

★ Paredes is batting .359 (14-for-39) with 2 2B, 2 HR, 4 RBI and 5 BB over his last 10 games since April 23, ranking among the AL during that period in multi-hit games (3rd, 6), AVG (5th) and OBP (7th, .432).

★ Following an 0-for-15 stretch from April 28-May 1, **Yandy Díaz** has recorded three straight multi-hit efforts for the first time since another three-game run from Sept. 9-11, 2023...the last time he did so in four straight games was a career-best six-game streak from Aug. 16-23, 2023.

★ **Richie Palacios** has reached base safely in each of his last seven games, batting .375 (9-for-24) with 1 2B, 1 HR, 7 BB and 4 SB during the run...he is two games shy of matching his career-long nine-game streak from Sept. 24, 2023-March 29, 2024.

IT TAKES GRIT—Four of the Rays last five wins have been of the come-from-behind variety after coming back in only five of their first 14 wins...their nine comeback wins are tied for fourth most among AL clubs...the Rays have not scored first in any of their last five games, but are 5-2 in their last seven games in which their opponent landed the opening blow...they began the season 3-10 in such games...their eight wins when the opposition scores first are tied with the Orioles and Rangers for third most in the AL, trailing the Yankees (10) and Twins (9).

SOUTH SIDERS IN ST. PETE—The Rays and White Sox continue a six-game season series tonight at Tropicana Field...Chicago swept a three-game set at Guaranteed Rate Field from April 26-28, earning its first sweep over Tampa Bay since Aug. 3-5, 2018.

★ The Rays are 7-3 vs. the White Sox at Tropicana Field since July 21, 2019, outscoring Chicago, 55-36 (+19), during that time...prior to the 10-game stretch, the White Sox won five straight games at Tropicana Field from Aug. 3, 2018-July 20, 2019.

★ **Yandy Díaz** has reached base safely in 15 of 16 games vs. Chicago dating back to Aug. 21, 2021, batting .417 (20-for-48) with 5 2B, 1 HR and 5 RBI.

CONNECTIONS

- ★ Chicago INF/OF **Gavin Sheets** played high school baseball at the Gilman School in Baltimore, MD, less than three miles from Towson University, where both Rays INF/OF **Richie Palacios** and Tampa Bay Radio Broadcaster **Andy Freed** attended college.
- ★ White Sox Bench Coach **Charlie Montoyo** spent 22 seasons in the Rays organization, including four on **Kevin Cash's** staff as third base coach (2015-17) and bench coach (2018), before departing to manage the Blue Jays in 2019.
- ★ Chicago RHP **Jordan Leasure** attended Riverview High School in Tampa and went on to pitch parts of four seasons at the University of Tampa from 2016-21.
- ★ White Sox RHP **John Brebbia** attended Wellington High School in Central Palm Beach County, roughly 210 miles from St. Petersburg.
- ★ Chicago 1B/OF Coach **Jason Bourgeois** played for Chicago (6G, 2008) and Tampa Bay (9G, 2013) during his eight-year ML career.
- ★ White Sox ML Coach **Grady Sizemore** appeared in 58 games with the Rays in 2015 to conclude his major league career.
- ★ White Sox Assistant Hitting Coach **Mike Tosas** began his professional coaching career as a hitting coach with Tampa Bay...worked with the Gulf Coast League Devil Rays in 1996 and Rookie-level Princeton from 1997-99.
- ★ Rays Senior Advisor, Player Development & Baseball Operations **Mitch Lukevics** was a second-round selection by the White Sox in 1975 and worked in the Chicago farm system as a pitching coach (1981-85) and minor league administrator (1986-88).
- ★ The late **Al Lopez**, one of four Tampa natives in the Hall of Fame, is the second-longest-tenured skipper in White Sox history behind **Jimmy Dykes** (13), guiding the club for 11 seasons (1957-69).

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE

In 16 games vs. the CWS dating back to Aug. 21, 2021, **Yandy Díaz** has drawn 16 walks while striking out only seven times...among all active players, his .442 on-base percentage against the White Sox is the second highest in the majors, trailing only LAA **Mike Trout** (.452)...he has hit safely in each of his last home games vs. Chicago, going 13-for-25 (.520) with 2 2B and 8 BB while striking out only twice.

TONIGHT'S START—Alexander will take the mound for his seventh appearance of the season this evening, including his fourth start...he is 1-1 with a 3.26 ERA (19.1IP, 7ER) in his last four games (2GS) after posting an 8.68 ERA (9.1IP, 9ER) in his first two (1GS)...this marks his first home start since Sept. 30, 2022 vs. MIN...is seeking his first win as a starter since Sept. 19, 2022 at BAL.

LAST TIME OUT—Making his third road start, Alexander worked 4.0 innings and took the loss in the Rays 8-2 setback at Milwaukee on April 30 (L, 4.0IP, 6H, 3ER, 2BB, 3SO)...yielded all three runs in the first two frames, allowing a **Willy Adames** sacrifice fly in the 1st before the Brewers pushed across a pair of runs in the 2nd via **Brice Turang's** RBI-single and **William Contreras's** sacrifice fly...retired 5 of his final 6 BF before departing with the Rays trailing, 3-1.

SOX TALK—Alexander made 19 appearances (9GS) opposite the White Sox during his stint with the AL Central-rival Tigers, going 1-5 with a 4.52 ERA (61.2IP, 31ER)...he is 0-4 with a 4.67 ERA (44.1IP, 23ER) across the nine starts, but that includes a 2.86 ERA (22.0IP, 7ER) in his last four...the 19 career games against Chicago are his most against any opponent—Cleveland (14) is the next closest club.

✦ Since the beginning of last season, Alexander has posted a 2.70 ERA (13.1IP, 4ER) in seven relief appearances against AL Central foes...his last start against the division came on Sept. 30, 2022 vs. MIN.

SWINGMAN—Of his 126 career appearances, 46 (36.5%) have come as a starter while 80 were in relief...his 41 multi-inning relief appearances since 2020 are tied for sixth most in the majors—he has gone 7-3 with a 3.51 ERA (110.1IP, 43ER) in those outings.

✦ In his three starts this season, Alexander has produced a 4.61 ERA (13.2IP, 7ER)...in three outings working behind an opener, he has recorded a 5.40 ERA (15.0IP, 9ER).

✦ For his career, he is 4-21 with a 4.70 ERA (212.2IP, 111ER) in 46 starts vs. 8-3 with a 4.06 ERA (157.1IP, 71ER) in 80 relief appearances.

FIRST THINGS FIRST—Alexander has recorded a career-high 73.6 pct. first-pitch strike rate, up from 72.4 pct. last season...min. 100 BF, it signals the second-highest mark in the majors, trailing **AZ Brandon Pfaadt** (76.4%)... however, to this point, he has had the most success in hitter's counts, holding opponents to a .118 (2-for-17) average when he is behind in the count compared to .280 (14-for-50) when ahead...opponents are 15-for-45 (.333) against him in even counts, including 4-for-13 (.308) on the first pitch.

LEFT SIDE, BEST SIDE—Alexander is holding left-handed hitters to a .152 (5-for-33) clip and .586 OPS, but three of the five hits have gone for extra bases (2B, 2HR)...right-handed hitters are batting .329 (26-for-79) against him with an .881 OPS—they had gone 18-for-47 (.383) in his first three outings, but are 8-for-32 (.250) in his last three.

CUT IT UP—Opponents are 5-for-28 (.179) in at-bats that end with Alexander's cutter...min 25 AB, it signals the ninth-lowest mark on any AL pitcher's cutter...along with his four-seamer and sinker, Alexander averages 86.6 mph on his fastballs...only **LAD Ryan Yarbrough** (85.5 mph) has recorded a lower mark among all major league pitchers (min. 200 fastballs thrown).

SOFT SERVE—Alexander has posted career lows in average exit velocity (88.0 mph) and hard-hit rate (37.1%)...he has not allowed a homer in three consecutive outings after yielding 5 HR in his first three...keeping the ball in the field of play is key for Alexander, whose career-high 35.9 pct. fly ball rate is fourth highest in the AL behind **LAA Tyler Anderson** (37.9%), **TB Ryan Pepiot** (37.5%) and **HOU J.P. France** (37.2%)...his average launch angle of 22.5° is third highest in MLB behind **MIN Bailey Ober** (23.5°) and **NYN Nestor Cortes Jr.** (23.0°).

✦ Opponents are batting .226 (7-for-31) against him on fly balls, well below his career mark of .254.

BOTTOMS UP—The 7-9 spots in the opposing order are a combined 16-for-39 (.410) with a 1.066 OPS against him...he has held 1-6 hitters to a .205 (15-for-73) average and .656 OPS.
