THE WORD ON THE BIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and Milwaukee Brewers play the final game of a three-game series in the Cardinals first trip to Milwaukee this season. St. Louis lost the first two games of the series and are 1-3 on the current road trip after splitting two games with a rain out at Cincinnati. The Cardinals fly home to St. Louis following today's game and will have an open date on Thursday before commencing their longest homestand of the first half on Friday starting with the Chicago Cubs and followed by the Texas Rangers and Cincinnati Reds.

FRIDAY START TIME: Friday night's game against the Chicago Cubs is scheduled for a 6:15 first pitch, unlike their usual 7:15 p.m. start time on Friday. A postgame concert by multi-platinum selling country star **Jordan Davis** will start approximately 30 minutes after the game ends.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters today in second place in the National League Central, trailing their current opponent, Milwaukee, by 3.5 games. The Cardinals are 16-11 on the road this season, including 5-3 against N.L. Central opponents.

SWEEP-STAKES: The Cardinals are looking to avoid their first three game sweep in Milwaukee since June 2011, that season, they went on to defeat the N.L. Central champions in the NLCS en route to their 11th World Championship. St. Louis has been swept only twice at American Family Field since it opened in 2001. This season, the 'Birds were swept once, coming against Seattle (April 24-26) with their last road sweep down 1-94 in Chicago to finish the 2025 season at Wrigley Field.

THIRD TIME'S THE CHARM: Only twice this season have the Cardinals have lost the first two games of a series. The first time was at Detroit (Apr. 3-5), winning the finale 5-3 on Sunday Night Baseball. The second was a 3-2 loss to Seattle at Busch Stadium.

MAY-DAY MAYDAY: Cardinals starting pitcher **Dustin May** is returning to the place where he suffered his first injury. On May 1, 2021, May exited after 1.2 innings at American Family Field, requiring season-ending right elbow surgery and missing the final 134 games of the season. This will be his first appearance against the Brewers and at American Family Field since that first day of May in 2021.

VOTE FOR PEDRO!: **Pedro Pagés** enters today with a Major League-best 12 caught stealing. The Cardinals backstop set a career-high with two caught stealing on Monday against the Brewers. It marked the first time a Cardinals catcher had two caught stealing since **Yohel Pozo** at TB (8/22/25) sniping **Chandler Simpson** and **Carson Williams**.

WELL-RESTED 'PEN: Four Cardinals relievers, who all ranked in the Top 10 in appearances entering this series, have pitched once over the last seven days. **Riley O'Brien**, **JoJo Romero**, **George Soriano** and **Ryne Stanek** all pitched in Saturday's doubleheader for their last game and prior to that, last Tuesday against Pittsburgh.

NOOT NEWS: Cardinals OF **Lars Nootbaar** continued his minor league rehabilitation assignment in Springfield (AA) last night and was 1-for-4 with a double and an RBI while playing eight innings in left field. Nootbaar has appeared in seven games at three different affiliates (Palm Beach-A; Springfield-AA and Memphis-AAA), batting .316 (6-19) with 2 HR, 4 RBI, 2 walks and 3 strikeouts.

THIS DAY IN CARDINALS HISTORY (May 27, 2014): Cardinals pitcher **Lance Lynn** hurls a five-hit shutout against the New York Yankees (6-0) at Busch Stadium. It was his only shutout as a member of the Cardinals and one of two in his career (2021). **Derek Jeter** played his final game against the Cardinals and it was the only Interleague game in which the Yankees were shutout and The Captain did not record a hit.

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Riley O'Brien's grandfather **Johnny O'Brien** was drafted by the NBA's Milwaukee Hawks in 1953, but instead chose to play baseball.

Bryan Torres originally signed with Milwaukee as a non-drafted free agent in 2015 and played parts of five minor league seasons in the Brewers minor league system (2015-19)...played two seasons for the Milwaukee Milkmen of the American Association (2022-23), where he was back-to-back Independent League Batting Champion (.374 and .370).

Matthew Liberatore earned his first MLB win on May 28, 2022 vs. Milwaukee at Busch Stadium.

Nolan Gorman hit his first MLB home run on May 28, 2022 vs. Milwaukee with a 1st-inning solo shot off **Adrian Houser** at Busch Stadium.

Andre Pallante struck out **Christian Yelich** (April 15, 2022 at Milwaukee) for his first career strikeout, and **Matt Svanson** fanned **Isaac Collins** for his first strikeout (April 27, 2025 at St. Louis).

Jacob Misorowski played college baseball at Crowder College in Neosho, Mo...made MLB debut vs. St. Louis (June 12, 2025 at Am. Fam.).

Cardinals Special Asst. to the President of Baseball Ops & 2026 Cardinals Hall of Fame inductee **Yadier Molina** hit his first MLB home run on Sept. 23, 2004 at Milwaukee off **Matt Wise**.

William Contreras's older brother, **Willson Contreras**, played in 344 games for St. Louis from 2023-25.

Jake Woodford was selected by St. Louis in Competitive Balance Round A (39th overall) of the 2015 MLB draft and pitched in 80 games (18 starts) for the Cardinals from 2020-23.

Brewers Lead Hitting Coach **Eric Theisen** played college baseball at Illinois State Univ. (2005-08).

Stubby Clapp was a coach for Team Canada in the 2023 WBC with Brewers Major League Pitching Coordinator **Jim Henderson** on the pitching staff.

Brewers Baseball Ops Special Asst. and Domestic/International Scouting **Rickie Weeks** made his MLB debut on Sept. 15, 2003 at St. Louis.

KMOX broadcaster **Matt Pauley** hosted Brewers pre- and post-game shows for parts of six seasons (2017-22)...was radio play-by-play voice of the Univ. of Wisconsin-GB women's basketball team.

Brewers Sr. Special Assistant to the President and GM **Carlos Villanueva** pitched in 35 games for the Cardinals in 2015.

Steve Dillard, father of Brewers broadcaster **Tim Dillard**, was hitting coach for the Single-A Quad Cities Swing/River Bandits from 2006-07 and hitting coach for the High-A Palm Beach Cardinals in 2007...later piloted Quad Cities in 2008-09, where he managed infielder **Oliver Marmol**.

Trevor Megill was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign to return to Loyola Marymount Univ.

Ramon Urias's younger brother, **Luis Urias**, played in 330 games for Milwaukee from 2020-23. Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** made five starts for the Denver Zephyrs (AAA-Brewers) in 1990.

Cardinals broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played two seasons in Milwaukee (2000-01).

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

TODAY'S GAME:

- The 28-year-old **Dustin May** makes his 11th start as a member of the Cardinals (68th career start & 82nd appearance).
- Has received one run of support or fewer in four of his last five starts (April 27-present), and five runs of support total his last five starts.
- Pitched 6.0 innings in every start over a four-game stretch (April 27-May 15), the longest streak of his career and tying **Michael McGreevy** for the longest by a Cardinal this season. All were quality starts.
- Has four caught stealing on attempted base stealers, T-2nd among Major League pitchers behind **Michael King** (SD) with six.
- Issued just one walk to a right handed batter this season to San Diego's **Ramon Laureano** on a full count at Petco Park (May 9); 86 total batters faced.
- Lifetime 3-6 with a 3.90 ERA (67.0 IP) in 13 career May starts; his best ERA of any month.
- Joins **Nathan Church** (2024-26), **Hunter Dobbins** (2026), **Mark McGwire** (1997-2001), **Red Schoendienst** (1945-56, '61-63), and **Rex Hudler** (1990-92) as notable red-headed Cardinals.

LAST TIME OUT (Thursday, May 21 vs. Pittsburgh): L, 6-2; 5.1 IP, 6 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 2 BB, 7 SO, 91 pitches.

- Dropped his season-high 3rd straight decision in last week's homestand finale against the division-rival Pirates.
- Matched season-high seven strikeouts (also May 9 at San Diego).
- Exited with two runners on and one out in the 6th inning with the Cardinals trailing 4-1.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

DECISIONS, DECISIONS: His 2026 season has been one of streaks starting with 2-straight loses, then 3-straight wins and now three losing decisions.

STEADY STARTER: Has quality starts in 6 of his 10 starts. Has allowed 3 runs or fewer working into the 6th inning in each of his last 8 starts for a 3.28 ERA (46.2 IP/17 ER) in that span. He has received five runs of support over his last five starts.

KICKING THE BABIP HABIT: 17 or his 60 hits allowed this season came in his first two starts; he still owns the 3rd-highest BABIP (.340) in MLB.

DON'T WALK TO STRANGERS: Has the 2nd-lowest walk percentage among Cardinals starting pitchers behind Michael McGreevy (5.5%) with 7.4%.

MAY DAY: Started on May 3 while wearing uniform No. 3, against his former team, the Dodgers, suffering 4-1 loss that snapped his 3-game winning streak.

BACK-TO-BACK JACK: Gained a 5-3 win vs. CLE (4/15) as he paired back/back quality starts & wins over BOS & CLE during that homestand.

MILESTONE WIN: Bested his former team the Red Sox on 4/10 in a 3-2 win. It was his 1st win as a member of the Cardinals and his 20th career win.

TIGER STRIKE: Was hit for a season-high seven runs on seven hits (and struck in leg by line drive) over 3.1 innings in an 11-6 loss at Detroit (4/4) in his second start. First Cardinals pitcher since **Mike Parisi** (2008) to begin a season allowing 6 or more runs in his first two starts of a season; and the first Cardinal to pitch the Opening Day series since **Dizzy Dean** (1936).

OPENING ACT: Took the loss in his Cardinals debut at Busch Stadium vs. TB (3/29) allowing six runs over 4.0 inning. Tied his career-high allowing 10 hits, the first Cardinals pitcher to allow double-digit hits in his debut in 55 years since **Chris Zachary** surrendered 10 to the Phillies (5/3/1971) *Elias*. Recorded his 300th career strikeout retiring **Junior Caminero**.

MAY VS. MILWAUKEE:

- Has made one career start vs. Milwaukee back in 2021. Pitched 1.2 innings allowing a home run to Luis Urias before exiting after 27 pitches.
- Exited with a right arm injury following a 2-2 pitch to Billy McKinney in the 2nd inning. Placed on the 10-day Injured List the following day and missed the rest of the season.
- The 1.2 innings and 27 pitches are his fewest in any career start vs. an N.L. Central opponent.

THE BRIDGE: Threw 2.0 scoreless innings last night, the 3rd time this season and the first on the road (5/20 vs. PIT & 3/29 vs. TB).

NEWS TO KNOW: Has 26 appearances for the Cardinals after making 15 appearances all of 2025 with Toronto. Next will match his career-high of 27 in 2023.

LOST LONGBALLS: Allowed his 2nd HR of the season vs. PIT (5/21) and first since 4/13 vs. CLE. Has only allowed three XBH to left-handed batters.
