AROUND THE HORN

VOTE D-BACKS: Voting is open on the 2026 KONAMI eBaseball MLB All-Star Ballot for the MLB All-Star Game exclusively online and via mobile devices at MLB.com/vote, all 30 Club web sites, the MLB App and the MLB Ballpark App until the voting period for Phase 1 concludes at 9:00 a.m. PHX on June 25.

CORBIN CARROLL BOBBLEHEAD: Today features a Corbin Carroll 30/30 Mystery Bobble giveaway courtesy of Chase, for the first 25,000 fans, celebrating his milestone 2025 achievement as the franchise's first player with 30 homers and 30 stolen bases in a season.

INTER-TRIBAL TOURNAMENT: The 26th Annual D-backs Inter-Tribal Youth Baseball & Softball Tournament presented by Talking Stick Resort and generously supported by Resolution Copper and Nike will welcome nearly 1,500 participants from more than 20 tribes across six states – Arizona, New Mexico, California, Oklahoma, Texas and Mississippi - making it the largest all-Native American youth baseball and softball tournament in the country... the tournament, for athletes ages 9-18, will feature 84 teams competing in three baseball divisions and one softball division from Monday, June 8 through Thursday, June 11.

HERE'S THE STORY: Since May 9, the D-backs are 10-4 in their last 14 home games...10 home wins are tied for the NL lead (also: Brewers) and tied for second in MLB (Brewers and Orioles), behind the White Sox (13).

- Since May 9, the D-backs' 16 wins are tied for fifth in the Majors (also: White Sox), behind the Brewers (18), Braves (17), Dodgers (17) and Phillies (17).
- The D-backs are 6-3 in their last 9 games vs. NL East...and are 4-2 in their last 6 home games.
- The D-backs are 9-1 in **Eduardo Rodriguez's** last 10 starts.
- **Rodriguez** is 1 win shy (99) of 100 for his career.
- **Rodriguez**, in his last 7 starts (5 quality), is 3-1 with a 1.83 ERA (9 ER in 44.1 IP), opponent .216 AVG (35-for-162), 14 walks and 34 strikeouts.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 14-1 vs. Nationals last night.

- **Aramis Garcia** hit a solo homer in the third inning, his first in the Majors since 2022.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** and **Tommy Troy** had 2 hits apiece.
- **LuJames Groover** made his MLB debut starting at first base and finished the game at third.

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs recalled RHP **Drey Jameson** from Triple-A Reno and optioned RHP **Kade Strowd** to Reno following last night's game.

MILESTONE WATCH: **Corbin Carroll** is 1 triple shy of tying Stephen Drew's 52 (773 G) for the club record.

- **Torey Lovullo** is 3 wins shy of 700 in his D-backs' managerial tenure.

ALL-STAR CALIBER: **Ketel Marte** ranks among NL second basemen in homers (2nd, 11), RBI (2nd, 37) and extra-base hits (2nd, 24)...defensively, is tied for first in fielding pct (1.000) and fewest errors (0) with Matt McLain/CIN.

- **Corbin Carroll** ranks among NL outfielders in extra-base hits (T-1st, 32), triples (1st, 8), OPS (2nd, .925), SLG (2nd, .550), doubles (T-2nd, 15), OBP (4th, .375) and total bases (4th, 122).
- **Nolan Arenado** ranks among NL third basemen in OPS (2nd, .787), SLG (2nd, .448), doubles (2nd, 12), homers (T-3rd, 8), OBP (3rd, .339) and extra-base hits (3rd, 20)...defensively, is tied for third in fewest errors (3) with Max Muncy/LAD, behind Ke'Bryan Hayes/CIN and Manny Machado/SD (2).

VS. LHP: Vs. left-handers, the D-backs rank among MLB leaders in AVG (1st, .274), triples (1st, 9), fewest strikeouts (1st, 114), hits (2nd, 166), SLG (3rd, .446), extra-base hits (3rd, 59), total bases (3rd, 270) and OPS (4th, .775).

SERIES RESULTS: The D-backs are 3-1-0 in their last 4 home series...overall have won or split 8 of their 10 home series (5 wins, 2 losses, 3 splits).

- The D-backs have won or split 6 of their last 8 series (W 2-1 vs. Mets, L 1-2 @ Rangers, W 2-1 @ Rockies, W 3-0 vs. Giants, W 3-1 vs. Rockies, W 3-0 @ Giants, L 0-3 @ Mariners, S 2-2 vs. Dodgers).

IT'S HOT AT HOME: **Ketel Marte** has reached base in 12 of his last 13 home games, batting .380 (19-for-50)/1.241 OPS with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 5 homers, 18 RBI and 5 walks, including 6 games reaching base 2+ times.

- **Nolan Arenado** has reached base in 19 of his last 21 home starts, hitting .329 (23-for-70)/1.005 OPS with 6 doubles, 4 homers, 13 RBI, 8 walks and 3 HBP.
- **Ryan Waldschmidt**, has 5 multi-hit games in his last 7 home starts...in 15 home games, is batting .413 (19-for-46)/.992 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 5 RBI and 3 walks, including 8 multi-hit games.
- **Corbin Carroll**, in his last 11 home games, is batting .378 (17-for-45)/1.147 OPS with 3 doubles, 4 triples, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 1 walk, including 6 games reaching base 2+ times.

BULLPEN FOCUS: **Ryan Thompson** has allowed 1 run over his last 12 games, going 1-1 with a 0.77 ERA (1 ER in 11.2 IP), 2 walks and 8 strikeouts, including 4 outings of 1.1+ innings.

- **Kevin Ginkel** has stranded all 11 of his inherited runners.
- **Brandyn Garcia** is scoreless in 9 straight games (7.1 IP) with a 0.82 WHIP, 1 walk, 5 strikeouts and 0 extra-base hits...has not allowed an earned run (1 R) in 13 home games (12.0 IP) since Sept. 16, 2025, with a 0.75 WHIP, 1 walk and 10 strikeouts.

VS. NATIONALS: The D-backs are 8-5 in their last 13 home games since 2022 and have taken 3 of the last 4 series.
