WHEN...	NATIONALS NEWS
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BUCKLE UP

The Washington Nationals open a six-game homestand on Friday night with the first of three games against the Arizona Diamondbacks...Following this series, the Nationals will face the Toronto Blue Jays starting Monday.

- Tonight's matchup marks the beginning of a stretch of 17 games in 17 days until Washington's next day off on Aug. 10...In fact, the Nationals will play 39 games in 41 days from Friday through Sept. 2.
- Washington opened post All-Star break play with a winning road trip against the Athletics (2-1) and Colorado Rockies (2-1)...The Nationals combined to outscore both clubs, 51-32, while winning four of six games.

OUT OF THIS WORLD

CJ Abrams ranks in the the National League in RBI (2nd, 76), homers (5th, 24), slugging percentage (5th, .544), OPS (5th, 903) and extra-base hits (6th, 46).

- He is 9-for-17 (.529) with two doubles, four homers, eight RBI, two walks, one stolen base and five runs scored in his last four games.
- Abrams has hit safely in 15 of his last 17 game with a .710 slugging percentage (5 2B, 7 HR) during this stretch.
- Abrams is is one home run away from tying **Ian Desmond** (25, 2012) for most home runs in a season by a Nationals (2005-pres.) shortstop.

LUIS! LUIS!

Luis García Jr. is in the midst of a career year, already hitting a career-high 21 home runs and matching a career-high of 70 RBI (2024)...He ranks in the National League in slugging (3rd .550), RBI (4th, 70) and home runs (T9th, 21).

- Since May 24, he ranks in the MLB in RBI (1st, 48), slugging (2nd, .701), OPS (3rd, 1.042) and homers (3rd, 18).
- He's hitting .338 with a .743 slugging percentage (4 2B, 8 HR), 21 RBI and 12 runs in his last 19 games.

THUNDER FROM DOWN UNDER

Since July 1, **Curtis Mead** is hitting .400 (22-for-55) with six doubles, one triple, three homers, nine RBI, seven walks, two stolen bases and 12 runs scored in 14 games...He has hit safely in 11 of the 14.

- He ranks among National League third baseman in OPS (2nd, .858), homers (3rd, 17), slugging percentage (3rd, .509), RBI (T4th, 48) and doubles (T5th, 17).

GOING RIGHT AGAINST LEFT

The Nationals lead Major League Baseball in OPS (.788), runs scored (162), RBI (156) against left-handed pitching this season...They also rank second in slugging percentage (.443), batting average (.267), on-base percentage (.344) and doubles (59).

- Washington is 21-12 (.636) against left-handed starters this year.

HOMERS EVERYWHERE

Washington leads Major League Baseball with 150 home runs this year...The 150 homers are the second-most in team history (2005-pres.) through 102 games behind only the 2017 Nationals (158 HR).

- The Nationals have clubbed 113 home runs since May 6, the most in Major League Baseball, 17 more than the Astros (96) and Phillies (96)...Washington entered play on May 6 with 41 home runs, 12th-most in MLB.
- Washington has homered at least once in 19 of its last 20 (41 total HR), 26 of its last 28 (54 total HR) and 36 of its last 40 games (72 total HR).

POP FROM THE TOP

James Wood leads Major League Baseball and ranks among the top hitters in the National League in several offensive categories...See chart to the right for rankings.

- Wood is hitting .329 with a .462 on-base (20 BB) and a .753 slugging (5 2B, 3B, 8 HR) in his last 19 games.
- His 10 leadoff homer lead MLB are the most in a season in franchise history (MON/WSH).
- Wood has 13 career leadoff homers, one shy of matching **Trea Turner's** (14) Nationals record (2005-pres.).

NOT ON THE LIST? SORRY.

A few exclusive lists containing several Washington players include:

- **CJ Abrams** and **James Wood** are two of only three players in baseball with at least 20 home runs and at least 15 stolen bases this season...Wood is the only player in the 25 HR/15 SB club.
- There are 12 players in Major League Baseball with at least 20 home runs and at least 65 RBI...**James Wood, CJ Abrams** and **Luis García Jr.** are three of the 12...No other team has more than one player on the list.
- **James Wood** (2nd, .551), **Luis García Jr.** (3rd, .550) and **CJ Abrams** (5th, .544) are three of the top five players in slugging percentage in the National League.

BORN TO RUN

The Washington Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 113 stolen bases, six more than the Miami Marlins (107).

- **Nasim Núñez** leads the league with 37 stolen bases ahead of **Bobby Witt Jr.** (30)...He is 10 stolen bases shy of tying **CJ Abrams'** Nationals record (2005-pres.) of 47 stolen bases in 2023.
- Núñez also leads Major League Baseball in baserunning runs (6) according to Baseball Savant.
- According to FanGraphs, Washington leads Major League Baseball in their baserunning metric, baserunning runs above average, at 8.9...Baserunning runs above average is *all encompassing baserunning statistic that turns stolen bases, caught stealings, and other base running plays (taking extra bases, being thrown out on the bases, etc) into runs above and below average.*

CAREER

Veteran starter is one of 27 pitchers in Major League Baseball to make 67 starts and maintain an ERA under 3.99 since the beginning of 2024.

- Littell (lih-TELL) began his career as a reliever before moving to the rotation in 2023 after being claimed by Tampa Bay...Is 28-30 with a 4.02 ERA in 88 starts since June 29, 2023.
- In 2024, was named the receipient of the Paul C. Smith Champion Award by the Tampa Bay chapter of the BBWAA, presented to the player who best exemplifies the spirit of true professionalism on and off the field.

LAST START

Littell tossed 6.0 innings and allowed eight earned runs on eight hits and four walks with four strikeouts in the 15-1 loss against the Athletics on July 18.

vs. ARIZONA

Littell is set to make his 12th career appearance against the Diamondbacks...He is 2-1 with a 4.84 ERA (12 ER/22.1 IP) and 20 strikeouts.

- Earned win after he allowed just an earned run on two hits and a walk with four strikeouts across 5.0 innings of work on June 6 in the 6-1 win over Arizona.

STREAKIN'

Littell posted a six-game winning streak May 3 to June 6, tied for the second-longest winning streak in Major League Baseball at the time...He went 6-0 with a 2.27 ERA, a .197 opponents' average and just two home runs allowed in seven games during this streak..

- The six wins were tied for the most in Major League Baseball with Milwaukee's **Jacob Misiorowski** and Philadelphia's **Cristopher Sanchez** during the streak.
- He ranked among National League pitchers (min. 35.0 IP) in opponents' slugging (5th, .299), home runs per 9.0 innings (6th, 0.50), ERA (7th, 2.27) and opponents' average (9th, .197).

MAY FLOWERS

Littell went 5-0 in the month of May, pitching to a 2.35 ERA (8 ER/30.2 IP) with a .209 opponents' average and 19 strikeouts across six appearances.

- Was tied for first in Major League Baseball for wins in the month of May with Milwaukee's **Jacob Misiorowski**.

2025

He led Major League Baseball with .042 walks per batter faced and was second with 1.54 walks per 9.0 innings...His 32 starts were tied for ninth in Major League Baseball.

- Set career highs in wins (10), starts (32) and innings pitched (186.2), while pitching to a 3.81 ERA for Tampa Bay and Cincinnati in 2025.
- He tossed his first career complete game on May 31 at Houston (9.0 IP, 10 H, 3 ER, BB, 6 SO).
- Made his Reds Postseason debut as the club's starting pitcher in Game 2 of the National League Wild Card Series at Los Angeles (NL).Was his first career Postseason start after five Postseason relief appearances.
