### Kelenic Hits

Jarred Kelenic combined to go 6-for-9 with a homer and four RBI in yesterday's doubleheader, collecting three hits in each of the two games.

He is one of just two players in baseball this season, along with Texas's Marcus Semien, to collect at least three hits in both games of a doubleheader.

Since moving to the top of the batting order on June 15, Kelenic has batted .362/.380/.660 with four homers and 10 RBI in 11 games, and his 17 hits in that span are most by a leadoff batter in the National League.

**TODAY'S GAME:** Atlanta and Chicago are set to play at 3:10 CT this afternoon, in a make-up game from a weather postponement on April 3...This is the final scheduled game between the two teams this season.

*A* Atlanta and Chicago split the two games of that series in early April, with the Braves winning the opener, 9-0, and the White Sox taking the second game, 3-2.

*A* The Braves and White Sox have played just 23 times since the introduction of Interleague Play in 1997, with Atlanta going 12-11 (.546) all-time versus Chicago...The White Sox have won four of the eight total series between the clubs, with one split.

*A* Atlanta went 1-2 in three games versus Chicago at Truist Park last season, July 14-16, winning the opener before dropping the final two games of the set...The White Sox's two wins were their first ever in the city of Atlanta, after getting swept in three games at Turner Field in 2002 and in three more at Truist Park in 2019.

*A* The Braves trip to Guaranteed Rate Field earlier this season was their first in eight seasons, last visiting from July 8 to July 10, 2016...Atlanta took two-of-three in that series, its only series win in four tries in this park...The Braves are 5-9 (.357) here overall following the split earlier this year.

*A* Atlanta today plays its 34th interleague game of the season, and its 22-11 (.667) record is the best in baseball against the opposing league...Chicago is just 6-19 (.240) against NL opponents this season, the worst interleague mark in baseball.

*A* RH Chad Kuhl has made four career starts and pitched in five total games against Atlanta in his career, compiling a 1-1 record with a 2.70 ERA (7 ER/23.1 IP)...The 6-foot-3, 207-pound native of Newark, DE, faced them once last season while with the Nationals, and allowed two hits and one run over 1.2 innings in relief...The right-hander has yet to start a game this season and today makes just his fourth appearance, after allowing eight hits and six runs in 8.0 innings (6.75 ERA) over his first three games.

**SPLT:** Atlanta split the two games of yesterday's doubleheader, winning the opener, 6-2, before dropping the nightcap, 4-1...The loss in Game 2 meant St. Louis won the series, two-games-to-one.

*A* Atlanta dropped just its second rubber game of the season with the loss in Game 2, falling to 5-2 in such games...It was the Braves' first such loss since their first rubber game of the season, April 11 vs. the Mets.

*A* Atlanta has not lost back-to-back games since suffering a season-worst five-game losing streak from June 7 to June 12...The Braves need a win today to avoid dropping their second straight.

*A* The Braves moved to 17-12 in day games with the win in Game 1 yesterday, and are set to play in the daytime against this afternoon.

**CHRIS SALE:** Returns this afternoon to Guaranteed Rate Field to make the sixth start of his career against his former club...The 6-foot-6, 180-pound native of Lakeland, FL, is 2-1 with a 3.30 ERA (11 ER/30.0 IP) over his first five games, striking out 46.

*A* The left-hander was originally drafted by the White Sox with the 13th overall pick in the 2010 First-Year Player Draft and debuted with the club that same season...He would pitched seven total season for Chicago, 2010-2016, compiling a 74-50 record with a 3.00 ERA (370 ER/1110.0 IP) over 228 games, 148 starts.

*A* Sale was a five-time All-Star while with the White Sox, and finished Top 5 in AL Cy Young voting in each season from 2013-2016.

*A* His 274 strikeouts in 2015 stand as the most in a single season in White Sox history, and his 1,244 total strikeouts for the club rank sixth in franchise annals.

*A* Through 14 starts in his first season with Atlanta, Sale is 10-2 with a 2.91 ERA (28 ER/86.2 IP) and 107 strikeouts...His 10 wins are tied with Seth Lugo and Ranger Suárez for most in the majors, while his 107 strikeouts are tied for ninth.

*A* He has completed at least 7.0 innings in eight of his 14 turns this season, tied for the second-most such starts in the majors.

*A* Opponents have compiled an average exit velocity of just 85.7 miles per hour on their balls in play against him, which ranks in the top five percent among all pitchers baseball.

**RILEY IN JUNE:** Austin Riley picked up three more hits across yesterday's doubleheader, going 3-for-8 with a walk and a run scored...He also made outs on balls hit 107.2 and 104.9 miles per hour.

*A* Over 23 games in June, Riley has hit .310/.383/.560 with six doubles, five homers and 12 RBI...He entered the month hitting just .228/.295/.353.

*A* He has raised his batting average for the season by 27 points (.228 to .255) and his OPS by 99 points (.648 to .747) this month.

*A* All five of his homers have come in his last 12 games dating to June 14, and he has hit .429/.500/.881 in this stretch...His 1.381 OPS since that date is third highest in baseball behind just Shohei Ohtani (1.582) and Francisco Alvarez (1.414).

**BULLPEN:** In Atlanta's Game 1 win yesterday afternoon, four Braves relievers combined to toss 4.0 scoreless, hitless innings of relief...The Braves' 3.20 ERA (91 ER/255.2 IP) in relief ranks fourth in baseball.

*A* Pierce Johnson, Joe Jiménez and Raisel Iglesias pitched the seventh, eighth and ninth innings, respectively, in Game 1...It marked the seventh time this season those three were assigned those respective innings, and Atlanta is a perfect 7-0 when doing so.

### Today's Game

- ⚡ Scheduled to make his 15th start of the season and fifth of his career against Chicago (AL).
  - ⚡ Has gone 2-1 with a 3.30 ERA in five starts against his former team.
  - ⚡ Went 74-50 with a 3.00 ERA and five All-Star nods while with the White Sox.
  - ⚡ Needs to four strikeouts to reach 2,300 on his career.
- ⚡ His eight games with at least 7.0 innings pitched are tied for second most in the majors.
- ⚡ Has struckout at least 10 hitters in a game 83 times...Needs one more to tie to Hall-of-Famer Steve Carlton who ranks eighth on the leaderboard.
- ⚡ His 10 wins are tied for the third most in the majors...among qualified starters in the National League, Sale ranks first in FIP (2.41) and in BB/9 (1.66), third in WHIP (0.93), fifth in strikeouts (107) and eighth in ERA (2.91).
  - ⚡ His seven wins at home are the most in baseball.
- ⚡ Through 14 starts this season, Sale has only issued two free passes or more in four of his starts.
- ⚡ Hitters are chasing 35.0% of his pitches out of the strike zone this season; it's the highest rate in the majors among qualified starters.
  - ⚡ Recording strikes on 68.5% of pitches thrown this year; it is the highest rate in the National League among qualifiers.
- ⚡ Sporting an 11.06 strikeout per nine innings rate through his career; the highest rate among active pitchers (min. 1,500 IP).
- ⚡ Opposing hitters are averaging 85.0 mph on balls in play against Sale; tied for the lowest mark in the majors among qualified starters.

### 2024 Recap

- ⚡ Sale's eight wins in the span of 10 games to start the season are the most by a Braves pitcher since Hall-of-Famer John Smoltz won nine of his first 10 in 1996...Smoltz won the Cy Young Award the same year.
- ⚡ Snapped his streak of consecutive games with nine strikeouts at four games on June 1...The streak was tied for the longest on the season with Tyler Glasnow at the time.
- ⚡ LH Chris Sale was named as the National League Pitcher of the Month for May... He went a perfect 5-0 with a 0.56 ERA (2 ER/32.0 IP) across five starts, walking just two and fanning 45.
  - ⚡ The award was Sale's fifth career Pitcher of the Month honor, and his first since winning back-to-back awards in June and July of 2018 while with Boston.
  - ⚡ His 0.56 ERA is the lowest in baseball during the month of May since Tommy Greene pitched to a 0.29 ERA in six starts with Philadelphia in 1991...Greene struck out 30 in 31.0 frames while Sale fanned 45 hitters in 32.0 innings pitched.
- ⚡ Sale's ERA is the lowest in a calendar month by an Atlanta starter with at least five outings since Kris Medlen pitched to a 0.50 ERA in August, 2012.
- ⚡ Per Baseball Reference...since 1910, it's the lowest ERA by a Braves starter in a calendar month who had at least 45 strikeouts and 30.0 innings pitched.
- ⚡ Sale is one of 18 pitchers in history with at least five monthly awards and the eighth left-hander of the group... He is the first Brave to win the award since teammate Max Fried did so in September 2021.
  - ⚡ The 35-year-old led the majors in ERA in May, ranked second among NL pitchers in strikeouts and WHIP, and tied for seventh in opponents' average.
- ⚡ Between April 19 and May 26, Sale had won each of his seven outings going a perfect 7-0 with a 1.17 ERA (6 ER/46.0 IP) with 58 strikeouts and just four walks.
  - ⚡ His wins in seven consecutive turns was the longest streak by a Braves starter since Russ Ortiz won eight straight outings in 2003...No Atlanta starter has a longer streak of consecutive starts with a win since Ortiz.
- ⚡ Is 8-2 on the season and 6-0 at Truist Park.
- ⚡ Scattered four hits over 7.0 innings of one-run ball while fanning eight Pittsburgh hitters and collecting his eighth win of the season on May 26.
- ⚡ His 83 career games with 10 or more strikeouts are the ninth most in baseball history (dating to 1901)...Needs one more to tie Hall-of-Famer Steve Carlton.
- ⚡ Morton and Chris Sale become the first pair of teammates to have each made an Opening Day start and record the last out of a World Series since Hall-of-Famer Dennis Eckersley and Cy Young award-winner Bret Saberhagen with Boston in 1998... Research courtesy of Elias Sports Bureau.
  - ⚡ Morton was the Opening Day starter for Tampa Bay in 2020 and induced a groundout from Corey Seager for the final out in Game 7 of the 2017 World Series with Houston.
  - ⚡ Sale was the Opening Day starter for the Red Sox (2018-'19) and the White Sox (2013, '14 & '16)...He struck out Manny Machado in Game 5 as the final out of the '18 Fall Classic with Boston.
- ⚡ Pitching to a 4.50 ERA in the first frame while sporting a 2.73 ERA in all other innings.
  - ⚡ Surrendered a leadoff home run in consecutive games on 4/19 and 4/26 for the first time in his career.
  - ⚡ Prior to this season, he had only allowed three leadoff home runs in his career (2014, '16, '19), but has now doubled his career total in just five starts this year.

- ⚡ Entering his 15th major league season, Sale was been selected to seven consecutive AL All-Star teams from 2012-2018, and has seven career Top 10 finishes in Cy Young voting.
- ⚡ He is the only player in major league history to record at least 200 strikeouts with 50 or fewer walks issued in seven separate seasons.
  - ⚡ Hall-of-Famers Pedro Martínez and Roy Halladay are the next closest pitchers with five such seasons.

**Aaron Bummer • LHP • 6-3 • 215 • 30 yrs • #49**

- **Has yet to allow a barreled ball this season (Statcast)...Is one of two pitchers in baseball with at least 100 batters faced and no barrels allowed...Also Justin Martinez (ARI).**
- Opponents are hitting ground balls off him 59.5% of the time (league average 43%)...Ranks in the 96th percentile.
- Was acquired by Atlanta from Chicago on November 16, 2023, in exchange for INF Braden Shewmake, LHP Jared Shuster, INF Nicky Lopez, RHP Michael Soroka and minor-league RHP Riley Gowens.

**Jesse Chavez • RHP • 6-1 • 175 • 40 yrs • #60**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 25/11 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 11/1

- **With RISP, opposing batters are hitting just .059 (2-for-34) off him, which leads Major League Baseball (min. 30 BF with RISP).**
- Just one of Chavez's 13 inherited runners has scored, posting the second-best percentage (7.7%) in the National League (min. 10 IR) behind Hunter Harvey (WSH, 7.7%).
- Among pitchers with 150 appearances for the Braves in the Atlanta era (since 1966), Chavez's ERA (2.78) ranks seventh behind Craig Kimbrel (1.43), Jonny Venters (2.62), John Rocker (2.63), Greg Maddux (2.63) and Mike Remlinger (2.74) and Luis Avilan (2.77).
- By Run Value, Chavez owns the fifth most valuable cutter (8 RV, tied) in baseball among both starters and relievers...Emmanuel Clase (CLE, 12), Corbin Burnes (BAL, 11), Garrett Crochet (CWS, 11) and Marcus Stroman (NYY, 9) are the only pitchers ahead of him...Using the cutter as his primary fastball, Chavez throws the pitch on 54% of his offerings.
- On June 22 snapped his scoreless streak of 14.1 innings...Among relievers, it was the second-longest active in the majors (2024 only)...Pedro Avila (CLE, 14.0 IP) led him.
- Among the 28 MLB pitchers aged 36-or-older, Chavez owns the best ERA (min. 5 games) in the National League and second-best in MLB (1.38)...Texas' Kirby Yates is the only player to lead him in that regard (0.95).
- Reached 1,000 career strikeouts on June 10...Among active primary relievers, his 1,008 strikeouts rank sixth behind Craig Kimbrel (1,234), Aroldis Chapman (1,195), Kenley Jansen (1,191), David Robertson (1,109) and Matt Moore (1,037).
- From 2021-present, owns a 2.05 ERA (35 ER/154.0 IP) as a Brave...With other clubs during that period (TEX, CHC, LAA), has pitched to a 7.16 ERA (13 ER/16.1 IP).
- On March 30 was credited with his 50th career win (50-63)...Eleven of those wins have come with Atlanta, second-most of any of his major league clubs (Oakland, 17).
