**BIRDLAND BITES:** The Orioles continue their eight-game homestand against the Blue Jays (1-1), Guardians (3 to play), and Reds (3 to play) tonight at Oriole Park at Camden Yards.

🦅 Three of the Birds last four games have been decided by one-run (1-2) after opening the season with 11 straight games without one such contest.

🦅 The O's tallied 15 hits in each of their last two games opposite the Guardians last season from August 3-4...Baltimore tallied 15+ hits against Cleveland in a franchise-record three straight games from August 13-15, 1998.

🦅 Baltimore has been out-hit 140-116 (-24) through 15 games and has conceded 40 hits over the last three games, its most allowed in a three-game period since April 12-14, 2024 (42 H).

🦅 The Orioles have drawn a walk in 93 straight games dating to July 2, 2024, the longest active streak in MLB and the longest by Baltimore since a 116-game run from June 3, 1995–April 5, 1996.

🦅 The Birds struck out a season-high 13 times in Sunday's 7-6 loss vs. the Blue Jays, marking their most punchouts since September 20, 2024 vs. Detroit (also 13).

**RECENT TRANSACTIONS:** Prior to tonight's game, the Orioles activated right-handed pitcher **Scott Blewett** and optioned right-handed pitcher **Colin Selby** to Triple-A Norfolk...Blewett was claimed off waivers from the Twins yesterday after being designated for assignment on April 11...To make room on the 40-man roster, left-handed pitcher **Luis González** was designated for assignment yesterday and released today.

🦅 Blewett, 29, made four appearances with the Twins to open the season, allowing one run across 4.2 innings with five strikeouts.

**CHARLIE AND CLEVELAND:** **Charlie Morton** is 4-2 with a 2.53 ERA (12 ER/42.2 IP) on 32 hits (5 HR) and 15 walks with 45 strikeouts in seven career starts against the Guardians, having thrown 5.1+ innings in each outing...He is 4-0 with a 1.44 ERA (5 ER/31.1 IP) on 20 hits (1 HR), 10 walks, and 37 strikeouts in his last five outings opposite Cleveland since May 18, 2018.

**RUTSCHMAN ROLLING:** **Adley Rutschman** has reached base safely in each of his first 14 games, the longest season-opening streak by an Oriole since **Anthony Santander** (18 G) from April 8-27, 2022.

🦅 His 14-game on-base streak is the second-longest active run in the AL behind BOS' **Kristian Campbell** (17 G) and sixth longest in MLB...It's tied for the fourth longest of his career and his longest since a career-high 16-gamer from June 12-29, 2024.

🦅 Rutschman's eight-game hitting streak is tied for the second-longest active streak in the majors behind STL's **Brendan Donovan** and his longest since a 10-game stretch from May 26 to June 6, 2024 (10 G).

🦅 He has gone a career-high 21 straight games with one strikeout or fewer since September 21, 2024...It is tied for the second-longest active streak by an Oriole, trailing **Ramón Urías** (33 G, since 8/16/24).

**LEFT SIDE, STRONG SIDE:** **Ramón Urías** is 4-for-8 (.500) with one double, four RBI, and three walks off lefties this season, while **Ryan Mountcastle** is 5-for-12 (.417) with one double...Since 2024, **Tyler O'Neill's** 1.111 OPS against southpaws ranks second in MLB, trailing only NYY's **Aaron Judge** (1.296).

**BIRDS FLY TOGETHER:** Baltimore has 16 home runs through 15 games, ranking 18<sup>th</sup> in the majors...Of the 16 home runs, however, 14 have been hit in six games against the Blue Jays, while hitting just two in the other nine contests.

🦅 The O's have two straight multi-homer games at Camden Yards for the first time since July 29 (G1)-31, 2024 (4 G).

**RISPY BUISNESS:** In six wins, Baltimore hitters are 21-for-58 (.362) with three doubles, one triple, and two home runs with runners in scoring position, compared to 4-for-46 (.087) with no extra-base hits in nine losses...The Birds went 0-for-13 with runners in scoring position vs. the Blue Jays on Sunday.

🦅 O's pitching has limited the opposition to a .221 (33-for-149) RISP average, the fourth-lowest mark in the AL and eighth lowest in MLB.

**FINDING THE BARREL:** The O's 44.3 percent hard-hit rate ranks fourth in the majors behind the Yankees (47.7%), Red Sox (45.1%), and Mets (44.6%), while their 10.4 percent barrel rate ranks third in the AL and sixth in MLB.

🦅 **Gunnar Henderson** has recorded an exit velocity of 102.5+ mph on 13 of his 21 batted balls, posting a 99.4 mph average exit velocity and 66.7 percent hard-hit rate.

**BRINGING HOME THE HARDWARE:** On Monday, it was announced that Single-A Delmarva **RHP Chase Allsup** was named Carolina League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 7-13... He earned the victory on April 10 (G2) vs. Fayetteville after tossing 5.0 shutout innings, allowing just one hit and two walks with 10 strikeouts... Allsup 21, was selected by the Orioles in the fourth round of the 2024 First-Year Player Draft out of Auburn University.

**THE FOREST CITY:** The O's and Guardians begin a seven-game season series tonight in Baltimore...Cleveland took the 2024 season set, 4-3, taking two of three at Camden Yards from June 24-26.

🦅 Cleveland left-handed pitcher **Logan Allen** was originally selected by the O's in the 16<sup>th</sup> round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign, honoring his commitment to Florida International University.

🦅 Orioles Vice President, International Scouting and Operations **Koby Perez** spent five seasons in the Cleveland organization from 2014-18, first as an International Crosschecker for two years and later as their Director of Latin American Scouting.

🦅 Cleveland Assistant Hitting Coach **Jason Esposito** was selected by Baltimore in the second round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt, playing four seasons in the Orioles system from 2012-15, reaching as high as Double-A Bowie in 2015.

🦅 Baltimore Third Base Coach **Tony Mansolino** joined the O's prior to the 2021 season after spending 10 years in the Cleveland organization.

April 15, 2000 - Cal Ripken, Jr. gets his 3,000 <sup>th</sup> career hit, a single at Minnesota off Hector Carrasco in the 7 <sup>th</sup> inning. Playing in his 2,800 <sup>th</sup> game, Ripken, Jr. becomes the 24 <sup>th</sup> major leaguer to reach the 3,000 career hit milestone and only the seventh player to get 3,000 hits and 400 home runs in major league history.

**QUICK HITS:** Morton is set to make his fourth start of the season tonight and the eighth of his career against Cleveland...At 41 years, 142 days old in his home debut, became the oldest Orioles pitcher to record 10 strikeouts in a game in franchise history (since 1954), per [@SlangsOnSports](#)...Made four Grapefruit League starts, recording a 3.38 ERA (3 ER/8.0 IP) on nine hits and one walk with six strikeouts...Signed a one-year contract with the Orioles on January 3, 2025...Made 30 starts with the Braves in 2024, going 8-10 with a 4.19 ERA (77 ER/165.1 IP) on 154 hits (23 HR), 85 total runs, 65 walks, and 18 hit batters with 167 strikeouts...Was on Atlanta's NLWC roster, but did not appear in a game.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Was dealt his third consecutive loss on April 8 at Arizona after allowing four runs on four hits (1 HR), a season-high five walks, and one hit batter with four strikeouts in 5.0+ innings...Did not record an out before being removed in the sixth inning with two batters on who were later stranded...Has received losing decisions in each of his first three starts of the season for the second time in his career (2010, five straight losses)...Is one of three MLB starters to lose their first three starts so far this year (PHI's Aaron Nola & TB's Zack Littell)...Threw 87 pitches, 51 strikes.

**GUARD THE YARD:** He has made seven career starts opposite Cleveland, going 4-2 with a 2.53 ERA (12 ER/42.2 IP) on 32 hits (5 HR), 15 walks, and five hit batters with 45 strikeouts...Did not factor in the decision in his last start against the Guardians on April 27, 2024 at Truist Park (w/ATL) after tossing 7.0 scoreless innings on four hits, one walk, and one hit batter with six strikeouts.

🗯️ Has pitched 5.1+ innings in each of his seven starts against the Guardians since July 3, 2015, recording 6.0+ innings in five of the seven.

🗯️ In 27 career starts against AL Central opponents, he is 14-8 with a 3.01 ERA (55 ER/164.1 IP) on 130 hits (13 HR), 51 walks, and 10 hit batters with 170 strikeouts.

**LIKE FINE WINE:** In his Orioles debut, at 41 years, 136 days old, Morton became the oldest pitcher in franchise history to start a game for the Orioles, surpassing Orlando Peña (39y, 177d) on May 13, 1973 (G1) at New York-AL...The oldest pitcher to ever appear in a game in club history is Jesse Orosco (42y, 160d) on September 28, 1999 at New York-AL.

🗯️ His 167 strikeouts were the most by an Atlanta pitcher age 40 or older since Phil Niekro in 1980 (176).

**AROUND THE CURVE:** Opponents are slashing .421/.455/.842 (8-for-19) with two doubles, two home runs, and two walks off Morton's curveball this season...Through his first four starts in 2024, he held opponents to a .209/.292/.256 (9-for-43) line and two extra-base hits (2-2B) with his curveball.

🗯️ In 2024, Morton limited opponents to a .200 (55-for-275) average on the offering while producing a 34.2 percent whiff rate...Of his 167 strikeouts last season, 102 came on the curveball (61.1%).

**WALK THIS WAY:** Has issued at least one walk in 16 straight starts dating back to July 20, 2024 (G1)...The 16-game stretch is the eighth-longest active streak among MLB starters...Has walked multiple batters in 11 of the 16 outings (35 total BB).

**FOUR-GET ABOUT IT:** Has allowed four or more runs in a career-high-tying five consecutive starts (21 total R) dating back to September 20, 2024...The last time Morton held such a streak was April 8 to May 1, 2014 (G1) with Pittsburgh (22 total R)...It is the longest active stretch in the majors and the first such streak since Boston's Kutter Crawford's five-gamer from July 21 to August 13, 2024 (26 total R).

**MODEL OF CONSISTENCY:** Made 30+ starts in each of his last six full seasons (excluding 2020) since 2018...He joins Toronto's José Berríos, Texas' Patrick Corbin, and Philadelphia's Aaron Nola as the only pitchers in MLB to accomplish the feat during that stretch...Morton had not reached the 30-start mark in each of his first 12 seasons from 2008-19.

🗯️ Last season, he became the fifth player in Braves franchise history to make 30 starts in his age 40 season or older, joining R.A. Dickey (2017), Phil Niekro (1979-80, 82-83), John Smoltz (2007), and Warren Spahn (1961-63).

**UPS AND DOWNS:** His 3.97 run support average in 2024 was the sixth lowest in MLB (min. 120.0 IP) behind Pittsburgh's Luis Ortiz (3.32), Pittsburgh's Jared Jones (3.48), Washington's Patrick Corbin (3.50), Cincinnati's Hunter Greene (3.89), and St. Louis' Andre Pallante (3.93).

🗯️ Since 2023, Morton is 19-5 with a 3.33 ERA (69 ER/186.1 IP) when receiving three runs or more of support, compared to 3-20 with a 5.03 ERA (87 ER/155.2 IP) when receiving two runs or fewer.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Made his third start of the season on April 9 at Arizona...Was dealt the loss after allowing a season-high six runs on eight hits (3 HR), a walk, and a hit batter with four strikeouts in 4.2 innings...The three home runs surrendered match a career high for the third time (last: 6/24/23 vs. SEA)...Has failed to complete 5.0 innings in back-to-back starts for the first time since July 9 (4.0 IP) and July 24 (4.2 IP), 2024.

**vs. CLEVELAND:** Has gone 0-3 with a 6.50 ERA (13 ER/18.0 IP) on 22 hits (1 HR), five walks, and one hit batter with 10 strikeouts across four career starts against the Guardians...Last faced the club on August 2, 2024 at Progressive Field, taking the loss after allowing four runs on six hits and two walks with two strikeouts in 5.0 innings.
