RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue for Fan Appreciation Weekend with the 2nd game of a three-game series with the division-rival Milwaukee Brewers tonight at Busch Stadium ... The Cardinals are 2-2 on their final homestand of the season against the Red Legs (1-2) and Brew Crew (1-0) ... Tomorrow's home finale marks the earliest St. Louis has wrapped up a home schedule since Sept. 21, 2014 at Busch III and Sept. 21, 2003 at Busch Memorial Stadium.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters tonight in 4th place in the NL Central and 5.0 games back of the Mets (80-74) for the third and final Wild Card spot ... The Cardinals postseason elimination number stands at four (three vs. the Mets due to tiebreakers) ... With eight games remaining, St. Louis needs six wins to end at .500 and to go at least 7-1 for a winning record (82+ wins) ... The last time the Cardinals posted two losing seasons over a three-year span was 1997 (73-89) and 1999 (75-86).

GAMES THAT MATTER: Since 2011 Opening Day, the Cardinals have played 2,296 out of a possible 2,318 regular season games (99.1%) during which they still maintained playoff aspirations and had not yet been eliminated.

LAST ONE FOR MILES: Miles Mikolas potentially makes his final home start at Busch Stadium tonight, where he is 4-4 with a 3.40 ERA (76.2 IP) this season ... Among all-time Busch III rankings, the 37-year-old trails only Adam Wainwright with his 98 starts and 598.2 innings pitched, while ranking among stadium leaders in quality starts (51, 3rd), strikeouts (415, 4th), and wins (29, T-7th).

PLAYERS USED: Forty-four different players have played for the Cardinals this season, tying Cleveland for fewest in Major League Baseball (Baltimore leads with 69) ... The 44 Cardinals matches last season's total, while the 52 different Redbirds in 2023 set a franchise record.

- Seven Cardinals have avoided the Injured List and been active for every game this season (excluding suspension): catcher **Pedro Pagés**, starting pitchers **Miles Mikolas**, **Andre Pallante**, **Sonny Gray**, & **Matthew Liberatore**, and relievers **Kyle Leahy**, and **JoJo Romero**.
- St. Louis is the only MLB team in 2025 with 4+ pitchers with 28+ starts.

BETTER AT BUSCH: The Cardinals have clinched a winning record at Busch Stadium III (43-36, .544) for the 18th time in 20 seasons since the stadium was opened (2006-25), 3rd-most winning seasons at home behind only the Dodgers (20) and Yankees (20).

- Since 2006, their all-time .576 win pct (898-662) at Busch III also ranks 3rd to the Dodgers (.622, 974-593) & Yankees (.614, 960-604).
- Among teams in MLB history over their initial 20 seasons at primary home venues, the Cardinals .575 win pct. at Busch III ranks 11th-best and is 2nd in franchise history to the Gashouse Gang's first 20 years at Sportsman Park (.596, 901-611) from 1920-39. - Elias.
- The New York Yankees hold the MLB record by starting 1,027-501 (.672) at Original Yankee Stadium from 1923-42. - Elias

THE LEFTORIUM: Four of MLB's top eight leaders in batting average among left-handed hitters play in tonight's game: **Sal Frelick** (.295, 1st), **Alec Burleson** (.289, 3rd), **Brice Turang** (.287, 5th), and **Brendan Donovan** (.283, 8th).

EXTRA BASES TAKEN: The Cardinals and Brewers co-lead MLB with 164 extra bases taken this season (bases advanced on fly balls, passed balls, wild pitches, and defensive indifference).

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (September 20, 1998): Mark McGwire's home run total reaches 65 during a 11-6 win over the Brewers at Milwaukee County Stadium with a first-inning blast off **Scott Karl** ... Other Cardinals to go deep that afternoon were **Pat Kelly**, **Ron Gant** (twice), and pitcher **Manny Aybar**, who made a spot start for **Kent Mercker**.

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Riley O'Brien's grandfather **Johnny O'Brien** was drafted by the NBA's Milwaukee Hawks in 1953, but instead chose to play baseball.

Erick Fedde made 30 starts for St. Louis over parts of two seasons (2024-25)...acquired at the 2024 MLB Trade Deadline from the White Sox as part of three-team trade with the Dodgers.

José Quintana made one postseason and 12 regular season starts for the Cardinals in 2022...acquired at the 2022 MLB Trade Deadline with **Chris Stratton** from Pittsburgh in exchange for **Johan Oviedo** and **Malcom Nuñez**.

Brewers Media Relations Intern **Owen Buescher** previously worked as a 2024 Cardinals Communications Gameday Associate...graduated from Belleville (Ill.) West High School and Univ. of Missouri.

Jacob Misorowski played college baseball at Crowder College in Neosho, Mo...made MLB debut vs. St. Louis (June 12, 2025 at Am. Fam.).

Late Brewers broadcaster **Bob Uecker** played two seasons (1964-65) with St. Louis...won the 1964 World Series...traded by Milwaukee Braves to St. Louis for **Jimmie Coker** & **Gary Kolb** (Apr. 9, 1964).

Steve Dillard, father of Brewers broadcaster **Tim Dillard**, was hitting coach for the Single-A Quad Cities Swing/River Bandits from 2006-07 and hitting coach for the High-A Palm Beach Cardinals in 2007...later piloted Quad Cities in 2008-09, where he managed infielder **Oliver Marmol**.

Trevor Megill was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign to return to Loyola Marymount Univ.

Willson Contreras's younger brother, **William**, is a catcher for the Brewers.

Caleb Durbin played college baseball at Washington University in St. Louis (2019-21).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010.

Ricky Horton made five starts for the Denver Zephyrs (AAA-Brewers) in 1990.

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

KMOX broadcaster **Matt Pauley** hosted Brewers pre- and postgame shows for parts of six seasons (2017-22)...was radio play-by-play voice of the Univ. of Wisconsin-GB women's basketball team.

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Makes his 30th start of the season and 212th career; It's his 202nd career start with the Cardinals (2018-present) in addition to the 10 the made with the Rangers in 2014.
- Tonight makes 30+ starts in six seasons over his career - each of those while with the Cardinals, T-2nd-most in MLB since 2018. Only **José Berrios** (7) has more.
- Will Join Chris Bassitt, Jose Berrios, Dylan Cease, Kevin Gausman and Logan Webb as the six pitchers in MLB with 30 starts each of the last four seasons.
- Since joining the Cardinals in 2018, ranks 9th among MLB pitchers in games started with 202.
- Became the 12th pitcher in Cardinals franchise history to make 200 starts, joining most recent Redbirds to accomplish the feat **Adam Wainwright** and **Matt Morris**.
- Has held his opposition to four hits or fewer in 14 starts this season, most of any Cardinals starter and T-8th most in the National League (Peralta, MIL, 20).
- At age 37 is the oldest player on the team's active roster.
- Has not received more than three runs of support in any of his last 16 starts. His 28 runs total runs of support since June 15 is fewest in MLB.
- Receiving an average of 3.32 run support per game; 2nd-lowest in the National League behind Yoshi Yamamoto (3.22).**
- Has surrendered 7 HR in 76.2 innings at home, but 19 homers in 69.2 innings on the road.
- Has hurled 6.0+ innings in 9 of his 29 starts (8 quality starts).
- Mikolas is one of just 3 MLB pitchers to have made as many as 200 starts exclusively with one team since he joined the Cardinals in 2018; also Philadelphia's **Aaron Nola** (223) & Colorado's **Kyle Freeland** (201)
- Opened the season with 29.0 homerless IP (March 31-April 30), but averaging MLB-leading 2.01 HR/9 IP since May 1.
- Is closing out his 8th season (was injured for all of 2020) with the Cardinals in 2025; Leads active Cardinals pitchers in wins (67), innings pitched (1,143.1), strikeouts (820) and games started (200).
- The Cardinals are 109-92 in his 201 career starts with St. Louis and Miles holds a 68-68 mark as a Cardinal.
- Since joining St. Louis in 2018, Mikolas leads MLB in first strike percentage (68.2) and lowest walk percentage (4.4%).

LAST TIME OUT (Sunday, Sept. 14 at Milwaukee): Earned his first road win since May 17 with 5.0 innings holding the opposition to two runs in a 3-2 Cardinals win. Both runs came via solo home run (Durbin & Jansen). Did not walk a batter for the first time since July 30 vs. MIA.

2025 NOTES:

- St. Louis is 14-15 in his starts this season. The Cardinals lost each of his first 5 starts to begin the season, then won 7-straight from April 30-June 5.
- Pitched 3 scoreless starts this season (22nd career since joining STL in 2018). Posted two scoreless starts in July (7/10 vs. WSH & 7/25 vs. SD).
- Surrendered a franchise record six home runs vs. CHI (7/4) at Wrigley Field en route to a franchise record eight total home runs (King - 2) allowed by the Cardinals. Five of the six home runs allowed were solo. Of pitchers who have allowed six home runs in MLB history, pitched the longest outing (6.0) since Tommy Thomas of the St. Louis Browns (6/27/1936) vs. NYY.
- Blanked the Reds over 5.1 IP (77 pitches) on April 30 in Game 1 of double header at Great American Ball Park. Was credited with his 1st win of the season as he and three relievers combined on the 6-0 shutout win. The Cardinals got back/back/back HR's from Scott II, Nootbaar and Winn to break the game open in the 9th inning.
- Fanned a season-high 7 batters in his 6/15 start at MIL over 6.0 IP.
- Threw a 3-pitch inning in 4th inning on 9/2 vs. ATH, just the 4th by a Cardinals pitcher since pitch tracking became official.

- First start against the Brewers at Busch Stadium in 2025. Last start here was Aug. 22, 2024, a 6.0 scoreless inning start for a win in a no decision.
- Struck out 10 batters over 6.0 innings on Aug. 27, 2019 at American Family Field; tying his career-high, one of three instances.
- His 106 strikeouts against Milwaukee are his most against any opponent.
- Hit his first Major League home run at American Family Field, a two-run shot off Zach Davis on April 2, 2018.
