BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles wrap up a nine-game road trip today at Colorado (1-1) following series wins against the Cardinals (2-1) and Athletics (3-0)...Baltimore returns home tomorrow for a seven-game homestand against the Red Sox (4 G) and Guardians (3 G)...The O's are in fourth place in the AL East and are tied with Texas in the Wild Card race, 1.5 games behind Cleveland for the final playoff spot.

- 👤 **Luis De León** made his MLB debut last night...At 23 years, 140 days old, he became the youngest Orioles pitcher to make his major league debut since right-handed pitcher Grayson Rodriguez (also 23-140) on April 5, 2023 at Texas, and the youngest O's left-hander to debut since Nestor Cortes (23-111) on March 31, 2018.
- 👤 He became the sixth Oriole to debut this year, joining outfielder **Christian Franklin** (8/4 vs. LAA) and right-handed pitchers **Cameron Weston** (5/28 vs. TOR), **Trey Gibson** (5/3 at NYY), **Cameron Foster** (4/16 at CLE), and **Anthony Nunez** (3/28 vs. MIN).
- 👤 **Jackson Holliday** went 3-for-5 with a game-tying solo home run in the seventh inning last night...The homer marked his third career go-ahead or game-tying blast in the seventh inning or later, joining August 16, 2025 at Houston (2-run HR in 8th down 4-2) and August 7, 2024 at Toronto (2-run HR in 7th down 3-2).
- 👤 The Orioles had their season-high 10-game errorless streak snapped yesterday, the team's longest such streak since May 15-25, 2023 (also 10 G).
- 👤 **Coby Mayo** has scored a run in a career-high six straight games, the longest active streak in the majors...The only Oriole to score a run in seven straight games in 2026 is **Gunnar Henderson**, who did so in eight straight from August 9-17.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE: The O's lead the AL and rank third in the majors with 520 walks this season behind the Cubs (586 BB) and Brewers (573 BB)...The Yankees rank second in the AL with 501 free passes.

- 👤 The team's 30 games with 6+ walks are the most by a Baltimore club since 1999 (35).
- 👤 The Birds are averaging 3.98 pitches per plate appearance, second in MLB behind the Brewers (3.99).

'PEN PALS: Despite giving up two runs last night, Orioles relievers have a 1.13 ERA (5 ER/39.2 IP) in 12 games since August 20...It is the lowest bullpen ERA in MLB during that period ahead of the Phillies (1.97 ERA) and Guardians (2.18 ERA).

- 👤 In 28 appearances since June 24, **Andrew Kittredge** has posted a 1.05 ERA (3 ER/25.2 IP) and eight saves.
- 👤 **Alex Hoppe** has yet to allow an earned run in 11 appearances (9.0 IP) since making his Orioles debut on August 5...His streak of 11 consecutive appearances without allowing an earned run is tied for the fourth-longest active streak in the AL behind HOU's Josh Hader (18 G), TOR's Mason Fluharty (17 G), and NYY's Paul Blackburn (15 G).
- 👤 **Yennier Cano** has gone 47 consecutive appearances (35.2 IP) without allowing a home run...It is the fourth-longest active streak among all MLB relievers behind MIL's Trevor Megill (61 G), CLE's Colin Holderman (52 G), and LAD's Edgardo Henriquez (48 G).
- 👤 Ten Baltimore pitchers have recorded at least one save this season, tying the 1987 Orioles for the most in franchise history (since 1954)...The Birds are one of 11 teams in MLB to have at least 10 players tally at least one save this year, led by the Cubs (13).

POLAR BEAR SIGHTING: **Pete Alonso** ranks 3rd among AL leaders in RBI (2nd, 91), total bases (3rd, 260), home runs (4th, 32), slugging percentage (5th, .499), OPS (6th, .859), extra-base hits (6th, 56), runs (8th, 84), and hits (T-8th, 140).

- 👤 Alonso has started all 139 O's games this year, tied for the most in the majors this year with SF's Rafael Devers, PHI's Bryce Harper, and ATL's Matt Olson...The only other player in the AL to start each of his team's games this year is TB's Junior Caminer...The last Oriole to start every team game in a season was Jonathan Schoop in 2016.
- 👤 In 20 career games at Coors Field, he's slashing .358/.422/.728 (29-for-81) with four doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 18 runs, and 18 RBI...Among all active players with at least 80 career plate appearances, his 1.151 career OPS at Coors Field is second highest in MLB behind LAD's Shohei Ohtani (1.194).
- 👤 Alonso's 91 RBI rank second in the AL behind HOU's Yordan Alvarez (94)...He looks to become the eighth player in franchise history (since 1954) to lead the AL in RBI, joining Chris Davis (138 RBI, 2013), Miguel Tejada (150 RBI, 2004), Eddie Murray (78 RBI, 1981), Lee May (109 RBI, 1976), Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), Brooks Robinson (118 RBI, 1964), and Jim Gentile (141 RBI, 1961).
- 👤 According to *STATS Perform*, since RBI became official in 1920, the only players to lead the AL in RBI in their first year playing in the Junior Circuit (including ties) are TEX's Josh Hamilton (130 RBI, 2008), CWS' Dick Allen (113 RBI, 1972), BAL's Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), BOS' Dick Stuart (118 RBI, 1963), and BOS' Ted Williams (145 RBI, 1939).

PLAYING THE LONG GAME: The Birds have hit 35 homers since August 9, second most in MLB behind the Cubs (50).

- 👤 The O's have hit multiple home runs in nine of their last 16 road games (27 HR total).

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles are 46-47 (.495) in games decided by three runs or fewer, tied for the most such games in MLB this season with the Guardians (48-45), followed by the Royals (92 G, 41-51), and Blue Jays (91 G, 48-43).

- 👤 Despite owning a 16-19 (.457) record in one-run affairs this season, the Birds have won four straight and are 6-1 in their last seven such games since August 14.

KEYS TO SUCCESS: The High-A Frederick Keys need one victory in their final five games to match the franchise record for regular season wins, set in 2011 when the Keys finished with 80.

- 👤 Frederick leads the South Atlantic League North Division second half by 1.5 games despite already clinching a playoff spot after going 41-23 in the first half...The playoffs begin on September 8 with the first home game scheduled for September 10.

QUICK HITS: Rogers is scheduled to make his 26th start of the season and 128th of his career...Was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (illness) on May 12...Voted as the winner of the 2025 Most Valuable Oriole Award by members of the local media, joining Randy Myers (1997), Mike Cuellar (1974), and Dave McNally (1968) as the only left-handed pitchers in franchise history to be named Most Valuable Oriole...He was the first pitcher to earn the honor since Rodrigo Lopez (2002).

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the loss on August 27 at St. Louis after working 5.0 innings, allowing six runs on seven hits (2 HR) and one walk with seven strikeouts...Threw 86 pitches, 60 strikes.
⚡ His two home runs allowed matched a season high (4x, last: 5/29 vs. Toronto)...Has permitted six home runs over his last five starts (28.0 IP) after allowing one long ball over his previous eight outings from June 14-July 29 (49.2 IP).

UP IN THE MOUNTAINS: Rogers is set to make his fourth career start opposite Colorado, having gone 2-0 with a 3.06 ERA (6 ER/17.2 IP).
⚡ Did not factor into the decision in his lone career start at Coors Field on June 1, 2022...Threw 3.2 innings in the outing, allowing five runs on five hits (1 HR) and five walks with two strikeouts.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Rogers owns a 1.08 ERA (3 ER/25.0 IP) in the first inning, allowing two home runs and five walks.
⚡ In the second inning, however, he has posted a 5.84 ERA (16 ER/24.2 IP), allowing two long balls and seven free passes.

EBBS AND FLOWS: Over his last 15 starts since June 4, Rogers is 7-3 with a 3.03 ERA (30 ER/89.0 IP) and 1.08 WHIP.
⚡ He went 0-3 with a 10.31 ERA (21 ER/18.1 IP) and .996 opponent OPS across four May starts...Among all MLB starters who made at least four starts in May, his 10.31 ERA was second highest ahead of COL's Kyle Freeland (12.46).
⚡ Over his first three starts of the season, Rogers went 2-0 with a 1.89 ERA (4 ER/19.0 IP) and a 1.05 WHIP.

SWEPT AWAY: Rogers has limited the opposition to a .175 (14-for-80) clip on his sweeper...Over his last 13 starts, opponents are 7-for-47 (.149) with a 31.0 percent whiff rate on the offering.
⚡ Overall, he is holding lefties to a .115 (3-for-26) mark with 10 strikeouts on the sweeper, compared to 11-for-54 (.204) with 22 punchouts against righties.

SWING AND MISS STUFF: In 12 starts since June 20, Rogers owns a 25.3 percent strikeout rate and 25.2 percent whiff rate...He posted a 16.6 percent strikeout rate and 22.0 percent whiff rate over his first 13 outings.
⚡ Over his last 12 starts, he owns a 30.8 percent strikeout rate on his four-seam fastball, while producing a 26.2 percent whiff rate on the offering...Over his first 13 starts, he owned a 13.8 percent strikeout rate on the heater with a 21.2 percent whiff rate.

THORN IN THE SIDE: Opposing nine-hole hitters are 16-for-51 (.314) off Rogers, the highest batting average of any spot in the batting order, ahead of the three-hole (.303, 20-for-66).
⚡ Rogers has had the most success against two-hole batters, limiting them to a 8-for-65 (.123) clip with zero extra-base hits.

TWO-OUT TALK: Opponents are slashing .272/330/376 (47-for-173) with seven doubles, one triple, three home runs, and 32 RBI off Rogers with two outs.
⚡ Over his last 15 starts since June 4, however, he has limited the opposition to a .194/.252/.272 (20-for-103) line with two outs after they slashed .386/.442/.529 (27-for-70) over his first 10 outings.

PINPOINT: On July 24 vs. Atlanta, Rogers' 81.8 percent strike rate (72-of-88) marked the highest by any pitcher in MLB this season (min. 50 pitches thrown), ahead of MIL's Jacob Misiorowski on August 2 at Los Angeles-AL (79.5%, 66-of-83).
⚡ Under the same parameter, it was the highest strike rate by an Oriole pitcher in the pitch tracking era (since 2008), ahead of Kevin Gausman's 80.4 percent clip (86-of-107) on May 11, 2018 vs. Tampa Bay.
⚡ From July 24-August 5, Rogers recorded 6+ strikeouts while issuing zero walks in three consecutive starts, tying the longest streak by an Oriole pitcher in franchise history (since 1954) along with Scott McGregor's three-start stretch from July 13-24 (G2), 1979.
