**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals continue a 10-game "home" stand with the final of a three-game series against the San Francisco Giants that began with the first game on Thursday at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., where the Cardinals served as the home team. St. Louis will continue the homestand with a three-game series against the Atlanta Braves (June 24-26) and conclude with a four-game series against their division rival the Cincinnati Reds (June 27-30) in their first visit to Busch Stadium in 2024.

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** The Cardinals enter today in second place in the National League Central, 5.0 games behind first place Milwaukee, and tied for the 2nd position in the National League Wild Card race. They have won seven of their last 10 games and own the best record in the National League at 23-13 (.639) since Mother's Day (May 12) with a +19 run differential.

**THE CITY BY THE BAY:** St. Louis and San Francisco all-time series is tied at 361-361 since the Giants moved from New York in 1958.

**TWO OVER:** With a win yesterday the Cardinals moved to a game over .500 for the third time this season. They haven't been two games over .500 since the final day of the 2022 regular season (93-69).

**SWEEP-STAKES:** The Cardinals are looking to sweep the Giants for the first time since Sept. 21-23, 2018 at Busch Stadium in a three-game series. A win today would mark their second sweep of a three-game series this season (Baltimore - May 20-22) and third of the season, counting a two-game sweep of the Cubs (May 25-26) which included a rain postponement.

**CITY CONNECTS:** The Cardinals will be donning their red City Connect uniforms for the third time this season. Earlier this season, the Cardinals defeated the Cubs on May 25 and the Rockies on June 7. The uniforms will be worn 12 times this season. This series, the Cardinals will not have worn "CARDINALS" on the front of their uniforms for any of the three games.

**OH, DONNY BOY...:** Cardinals outfielder **Brendan Donovan** homered in consecutive games for the first time in his career and has an RBI in five straight games tying his career-high (7/10-18/23), longest streak by a Cardinal this season. Donovan's RBI in five straight games is the 2nd-longest active streak in MLB behind **Shohei Ohtani** with seven and longest by a Cardinal since **Nolan Arenado** ran off eight straight games May 10-18, 2023.

**BURLY BLASTS:** Cardinals outfielder **Alec Burleson** connected for two home runs yesterday afternoon for the first time in his career. The North Carolina native also collected a career-high 5 RBI which is the season high for any Cardinals player this season. His go-ahead home run in the 4th inning gave him his 8th go-ahead home run of the season, tied with **Shohei Ohtani**, **Ketel Marte** and **Ryan McMahon** for the most in the National League this season.

**BISCUITS ON THE MENU:** **Alec Burleson** also posted consecutive games with three runs scored, becoming the first Cardinals player since **Lars Nootbaar** came around to score three times on May 14 & 15, 2023. A trifecta of runs today would make him the first player in Cardinals history with three runs in three straight games. His line on Saturday of three runs, three hits, five RBI, two home runs and a stolen base has only been matched by **Don Gutteridge** in Game 1 of a doubleheader at Ebbets Field against the Brooklyn Dodgers on Sept. 11, 1936.

**THE "RAP" SHEET ON RHODE-Y:** When rookie catcher **Nick Raposo** first appears in a Major League game, he will become the first Cardinal born in Rhode Island to play in a Major League game since the late RHP **Phil Paine**, who pitched against the San Francisco Giants at Sportsman's Park on Sept. 19, 1958. Raposo will be the ninth player born in Rhode Island to play for the Cardinals since they joined the National League in 1892, and he's the only active player on a 2024 Major League roster.

**"SPRING" CLEANING:** With a win today by the **Springfield Cardinals** over Corpus Christi (Astros) combined with a loss by Arkansas (Mariners), the Double-A affiliate will clinch a postseason berth joining the **Palm Beach Cardinals**, which clinched a postseason berth in the Florida State League earlier this week. Cardinals No.1 prospect RHP **Tink Hence** will start for the S-Cards tonight.

**Brandon Crawford** played 13 seasons in San Francisco (2011-23), where he was a cornerstone of two World Series Championship teams (2012, 2014) that eliminated St. Louis from the postseason each time...three-time National League All-Star...four-time Gold Glove Award winner...2015 Silver Slugger Award recipient.

**Willie McGee** played four seasons (1991-95) with the Giants...was born in San Francisco...graduated from Harry Ells High School in Richmond, CA...played college baseball at Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Hill, CA...resides in Hercules, CA...worked as an asst. coach for Contra Costa College in San Pablo, CA.

**Tommy Edman** played college baseball at Stanford University (2014-16), where he was teammates with **Austin Slater**.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Keith Hernandez** was born in San Francisco, CA...graduated from Capuchino High School in San Bruno, CA.

**Lars Nootbaar** and **Blake Sabol** were teammates at the University of Southern California (2017-18).

**Nolan Arenado's** brother, **Jonah Arenado**, was selected by San Francisco in the 16th round of 2013 MLB Draft...played seven seasons (2013-19) in the Giants minor league organization.

**Paul Goldschmidt** made his MLB debut at San Francisco (Aug. 1, 2011)...singled in first career plate appearance off **Matt Cain** (Aug. 1, 2011)...homered off **Tim Lincecum** for first MLB home run (Aug. 2, 2011).

Giants Community Ambassador and Hall of Famer **Orlando Cepeda** played parts of three seasons with St. Louis (1966-68)...in 1967, was NL All-Star, NL MVP and won the World Series...traded by the Cardinals to Atlanta for **Joe Torre** (March 17, 1969).

Giants Special Asst. **Will Clark** played in 51 games in his final season (2000) with St. Louis...slashed .345/.441/.621 in eight Postseason games.

Cardinals Bullpen Coach **Julio Rangel** was the Giants Minor League Pitching Coordinator in 2018.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** pitched two seasons in San Francisco (2006-07).

**Duane Kuiper** is a graduate of Southern Illinois University in Carbondale, Ill.

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** made his MLB debut at San Francisco (April 7, 1984).

Athletic writer **Katie Woo** is a native of Vacaville, Calif...previously covered the Giants, 49ers, & Warriors for NBC Sports Bay Area & California.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Tommy Herr** played 32 games for the Giants during his final season (1991).

Cardinals broadcaster **Bengie Molina** played parts of four seasons with the Giants (2007-10).

Cardinals Player Development & Performance Manager **Emily Wiebe** grew up in San Francisco...attended University High School.

- Makes his 14th start of the season tonight, and first career start against the Giants as a member of the Cardinals.
- Opened the season on the Injured List and made his first start on April 9 at Philadelphia, 12 games into the season. Since April 9, ranks among National League leaders wins (8, T-7th) and strikeouts (95, 5th).
- His 95 strikeouts over his first 13 starts with the Cardinals organization is the most in franchise history.
- Is 5-2 with a 1.55 ERA (40.2 IP) and .161 Opp. BA with just one HR allowed at home this year. Ranks 3rd among NL leaders in home ERA & 2nd in opponent BA (min. 5 starts).
- Yielded six home runs this season in 76.1 innings pitched after an MLB-low eight homers allowed over 184.0 innings pitched (among 2023 qualifiers).
- Has a 57.6 strikeout % on his Sweeper pitch (fanning 53 in 92 plate appearances), the 14th-highest K% of any MLB pitch.
- Recorded a decision in his 12 starts to start his Cardinals career, 7th Cardinals pitcher in the organization since 1901 to hit the 12 mark and first since **Kip Wells** (2007)
- Opened the season with 17.0 scoreless innings, longest by a Cardinals starting pitcher this season and 4th-longest in MLB. The last time a Cardinals starting pitcher opened the season with 17.0+ scoreless innings was **Woody Williams** (24.2 IP) in 2003, who set the franchise record in the Divisional Era (1969-present). - *Elias*
- Had an 0.89 ERA through his first five starts with St. Louis, lowest by a Cardinal in his first five appearances as a starter with the organization since 1910.
- Struck out 12 batters vs. Milwaukee (April 21), his most since a career-high 13 vs. Houston (April 7, 2023); Has 16 career double-digit strikeout games, two this year.
- Only **Jaime Garcia** (0.46 in 2011) had a lower Home ERA over his 1st five home starts to begin a season at Busch Stadium III than Gray (0.93). Garcia had 0.81 ERA through his 1st six home starts
- Ranks 13th among active pitchers with 105 career wins. Is joined by teammates **Lance Lynn** (138, 6th) and **Kyle Gibson** (108, T-10th) in the top-20.
- Gray is one of three free-agent starters (**Lance Lynn** & **Kyle Gibson**) that the Cardinals signed this past off-season.
- Has joined his fifth Major League team: Athletics (2013-17), Yankees (2017-18), Reds (2019-21), Twins (2022-23) and Cardinals (2024).

- Has pitched 5.0 innings or longer and limited the Giants to three runs or fewer in all six starts (two quality).

- Pitched a season-high 7.2 innings on Monday at Miami in the Cardinals 7-6 win over the Marlins in 12 innings.
- Exited with a runner on first and two outs in the bottom of the 8th inning before JoJo Romero yielded a game-tying Bryan De La Cruz three-run homer later in the frame.
