AROUND THE HORN

RECORD-SETTING 50/50: The D-backs Give Back 50/50 Raffle supported by Avnet Cares generated a record jackpot of \$712,332 on Saturday, surpassing \$560,331 on Father's Day 2025...this season's 50/50 Raffle jackpots totaled \$5.0 million with \$2.5 to winning fans and \$2.5 to charity.

RACE AGAINST CANCER THIS SUNDAY: This Sunday, Sept. 27, the D-backs Foundation will host their 13th annual Race Against Cancer, presented by Dignity Health Cancer Institute...the charitable 5K, which begins and ends at Chase Field, brings together community members in support of Arizona nonprofit organizations dedicated to cancer screening, treatment, and support for individuals and families affected by all types of cancer.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs are 4-1 in their last 5 road games and 7-4 in their last 11 road games.

- Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 15 straight games, batting .358 (19-for-53)/1.178 OPS with 2 doubles, 6 homers, 13 RBI and 7 walks.
 - His 6 home runs in September are tied for seventh in the Majors.
- Michael Soroka**, in 3 starts vs. Rockies this season, is 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA (3 ER in 16.0 IP), 5 walks and 14 strikeouts.
- The bullpen, in their last 4 games, has a 1.80 ERA (4 ER in 20.0 IP), opponent .211 AVG (15-for-71)/.607 OPS, 5 walks and 23 strikeouts.
- Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 13 straight games, hitting .326 (14-for-43)/.829 OPS with 1 double, 1 triple, 4 RBI and 8 walks.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 8-4 vs. Yankees on Sunday for the series win.

- Nolan Arenado's** fifth-inning grand slam, his third of the season, capped a 5-run frame.
- Ryne Nelson** (1.1 IP), **Justin Martinez** (1.0), **Taylor Clarke** (1.0), **Brandyn Garcia** (1.0) and **Jonathan Loáisiga** (1.0) combined for 6.1 scoreless frames (3 H, 0 BB, 6 K) behind **Corbin Burnes** (4 R in 2.2 IP).
- Geraldo Perdomo** and **Corbin Carroll** each had 2 RBI.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are fourth in the NL Wild Card race, 5.0 games behind the Cubs (WC T-1, trail 2-4) and Padres (WC T-1, season tied 5-5, 3-game series from Sept. 25-27), and 4.0 games behind the Phillies (WC3, tied 3-3).

SNAKEBITES: **Gabriel Moreno** has hit safely in 13 of his last 15 games at a .368 clip (21-for-57)/1.086 OPS with 3 doubles, 4 homers, 8 RBI and 8 walks.

- Corbin Carroll**, in his last 9 games, has 3 homers and 11 RBI.
- Brandyn Garcia** has a 13-game scoreless streak (13.1 IP, 4 H, 3 BB, 16 K).

STRONG SEPTEMBER 'PEN: The bullpen's 2.34 ERA (25 R-21 ER in 80.2 IP) in September is second in the Majors to the Guardians (2.18) and ahead of the Red Sox (2.60).

- In 17 games in September, have posted a .204 AVG (58-for-285)/.578 OPS with 25 walks and 79 strikeouts.

- VS. ROCKIES:** The D-backs are 6-4 vs. Rockies this year.
- Corbin Carroll** has a 17-game on-base streak vs. Rockies, hitting .377 (26-for-69)/1.296 OPS with 5 doubles, 3 triples, 7 homers, 17 RBI, 9 walks and 1 hit by pitch.
 - Nolan Arenado** has a 10-game on-base streak vs. Rockies, hitting .273 (9-for-33)/.944 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 7 RBI, 6 walks and 3 hit by pitches.

ANSWERBACKS: The D-backs' 47 comeback wins lead the Majors, ahead of the Padres (44), Dodgers (44), Cubs (42), Brewers (41) and Braves (41).

- Their 22 comeback road wins lead the Majors, ahead of the Red Sox (20), Braves (20), Brewers (18), A's (18), Cubs (18), Reds (18).

COMFORTABLE @ COORS: **Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely in 19 straight games @ Rockies, batting .333 (24-for-72)/1.107 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 6 homers, 11 RBI, 15 walks and 1 hit by pitch.

- His 19-gamer is tied for the third-longest road streak @ Rockies in club history (also: Ketel Marte from June 10, 2018-April 6, 2021) behind a 23-gamer from Luis Gonzalez (June 18, 2000-Sept. 21, 2002) and 25-gamer by Paul Goldschmidt (Sept. 20, 2013-Sept. 3, 2016).

SHUTTING IT DOWN: **Justin Martinez** has not allowed an earned run in his 12 games (2 R-0 ER in 11.1 IP) since returning from the 60-day Injured List on Aug. 18.

- Is 3-0 with an opponent .135 AVG (5-for-37)/.456 OPS, 6 walks and 15 strikeouts.
- Brandyn Garcia** has held road foes scoreless in 6 straight games (5.0 IP, 1 H, 1 BB, 8 K) and 10 of his last 11 outings (2 ER in 9.0 IP, 2 H, 3 BB, 16 K).
- Juan Morillo** has held opponents scoreless in 11 of his last 12 road games (2 ER in 11.2 IP, 8 H, 2 BB, 15 K).

HOME WIN MARK BEST SINCE 2017: The D-backs' .567 (45-36) home win pct. was their highest since 2017 (.642, 52-29).

WALKIN' IT OFF: The D-backs' franchise-record 6 walk-off homers lead the Majors, ahead of the White Sox (5) and Padres (4).

- The 10 walk-off wins tied for second most in team history (also: 1999), behind 13 in 2013.

ARENADO'S NINTH 25/75 SEASON: **Nolan Arenado** (27 HR/78 RBI) is the fifth third baseman since 1969 with 9+ seasons of 25+ homers and 75+ RBI [min. 100 GS per year], joining Mike Schmidt/PHI (12 from 1974-87), Aramis Ramirez/PIT-CHC-MIL (10 from 2001-12), Manny Machado/BAL-LAD-SD (10 from 2015-2026) and Adrián Beltré/LAD-SEA-BOS-TEX (9 from 2004-16).

GABI ON PACE FOR .300 AVG: **Gabriel Moreno's** .307 AVG looks to become the first catcher (min. 100 games at catcher) to hit .300+ since 2021 (Buster Posey/SF, .304).

- Among catchers over the last 15 seasons since 2012 (min. 100 games at catcher), his .307 AVG is ninth with Buster Posey's .336 AVG in 2012 being the best during that span.

VS. ROCKIES: The D-backs took 2 of 3 @ Rockies from May 15-17.
