TODAY'S GAME:

- Is the finale of 3-game series (1-1) vs **Zach Weber's Mets** and Game 3 (1-1) of a 7-game homestand that includes an upcoming 4-game set vs the defending National League Central Division champion **Brewers**.
- Following this homestand the Reds will embark on a 6-day, 6-game road trip at **WSox** (4/12-4/14) & **Sea** (4/15-4/17).
- The Reds are coming off their first road trip of the season in which they won 2 of 3 games in **Philadelphia**.

SERIES NOTES: The Reds won last season's 6-game series, 4-2, including a 2-1 series win from 5/9-5/11 in Cincinnati and a 2-1 series win from 9/15-9/17 in New York.

- Beginning 9/24/13, the Reds are 20-41 vs NYM, including a 14-game losing streak from 9/7/14 - 9/7/16 that ranks as Cin's longest ever vs the Mets and its longest vs any team since a 16-game skid vs AZ from 5/8/01 - 8/13/03.
- Dating back to 1962, the 7-0 series win by the Mets in 2015 was the first season series sweep by either team, followed by NYM's 6-0 series win in 2016.
- The Mets' .615 winning percentage (40-25) at Great American Ball Park is the highest of any National League team (LAD, .612).

REHAB ASSIGNMENTS: **RHP Ian Gibaut** (15-day IL, right forearm strain) began a rehab assignment Fri in A-Dayton's season opener and pitched a scoreless inning of relief in the Dragons' 1-0 loss vs Lansing (1h, 1bb, 3k, 22TP)...he's expected to pitch again vs Lan today...**LHP Nick Lodolo** (15-day IL, left calf tenosynovitis) began a rehab assignment on 3/31 for AAA-Louisville vs Indianapolis (5.0ip, 2h, 1r/1er, 3bb, 8k, 77TP)...he's expected to pitch again today for Lou at Gwinnett... **LHP Sam Moll** (15-day IL, left shoulder impingement) began a rehab assignment on 3/29 (4g all with Lou; 1-1, 13.50)...he's expected to pitch again today for Louisville.

INDESPENCEABLE: **LF Spencer Steer** yesterday off NYM's **RHP Yohan Ramirez** belted a go-ahead 3-run homer in the eighth inning to propel the Reds to a 9-6 victory.

- It was **Steer's** second home run in as many days and his Major League leading third go-ahead homer of the season.
- It was Steer's second **go-ahead** HR after the seventh inning...he is the first Reds batter to hit multiple go-ahead HRs in the **eighth inning or later** within a **5-game stretch** since **Joey Votto** did it in 2015 (8/29 at Mil and 9/2 at Chc).
- Prior to Steer, **OF Jake Fraley** was the last Reds batter to produce 3 or more go-ahead HRs in a 5-game span when he did it over 2 days last season (5/12-5/13, 3hr).
- Steer** is the first Reds batter to have as many as 3 HR and 9 RBI in a 5-game span since **C. Encarnacion-Strand** (4hr, 10rbi) last September.

STEERING COMMITTEE: **LF Spencer Steer's** 10th inning go-ahead grand slam Mon night off **RHP Connor Brogdon** led to the Reds' 6-3 win at Citizens Bank Park...it marked the first Reds grand slam in extra innings since **3b Todd Frazier's** GS in the 13th inning off Det's **RHP Joakim Soria** on 6/17/15 (8-4 win at GABP)...**Steer's** slam put him over 100 RBI for his career (101rbi/188g)...he's the sixth-fastest Red to reach that milestone since 1957.

2024 SPRING TRAINING NOTES:

- The Reds went 11-15-2 in Cactus League play with a .255 team batting avg and a 5.54 team ERA...their .472 SLG ranked first and 41 stolen bases ranked 3rd among all Major League teams.
- INF Christian Encarnacion-Strand** (16g, .333/.382/.784, 5hr, 10 XBH, 14rbi, 3bb, 40TB) and **INF/OF Spencer Steer** (17g .340/.393/.700, 4hr, 9 XBH, 12rbi, 5bb, 3sb, 35TB) each led the Reds with 17 hits during the 2024 Cactus League season.
- INF/OF Jonathan India** (.393/.485/.607) hit safely in 9 of 10g, including 7 straight from 3/10-3/20.
- SS Elly De La Cruz** (.280/.379/.540) hit safely in 8 straight games from 2/29-3/16...his 470-foot home run on 3/2 off Col's Cal Quantrill is the longest home run on record of **De La Cruz'** career.

2024:

- Is making his second start of the season and his second ever vs NYM (also: 9/16/23 at Citi Field).
- In Spring Training went 0-0, 7.88 with 8 strikeouts over 8.0 innings pitched (14h, 1bb, 1hr, 3.25 FIP).

2023:

- Didn't debut until 6/5 but still ranked among the National League's rookie leaders in strikeouts (2nd), wins (T3rd), ERA (5th), starts (6th), lowest batting average against (6th, .244), lowest OPS against (6th, .741), innings pitched (T6th), WHIP (8th, 1.32) and lowest on-base percentage against (8th, .316).
- Began his career with 17.2 scoreless innings, a new club record since 1893, until Col's **Brenton Doyle** hit a leadoff HR in Abbott's fourth start...the previous team record was held by **Wayne Simpson**, who in 1970 began his Major League career with 15.0 scoreless innings.
- Since the mound was moved to its current distance in 1893, became the first Major League pitcher to begin his career with 3 consecutive scoreless starts of at least 5.0 innings (courtesy: Elias Sports).

PERSONAL: Graduated from Halifax County High School (South Boston, VA), the same school attended by All Elite Wrestling champion "Hangman" Adam Page and Major League pitcher **Jeremy Jeffress**...was named 2017 Gatorade Virginia Player of the Year...was a 4-year member of the Halifax swim team...at the University of Virginia became only the second pitcher in school history to record at least 300 strikeouts.

INSTAGRAM:

- Led the 2023 staff in starts (26), quality starts (15) and innings pitched (145.2) despite stints on the 15-day disabled list with a left calf contusion (6/9-6/23) and broken toes in his right foot (9/2-remainder of the season).
- On 9/19/23 had surgery to repair fractures in his right big toe and right second toe.
- In his last 12 apps of the 2023 season, beginning 6/30, went 4-3, 2.58 (.228baa) with 10 of his 15 quality starts.
- In the 5-3 walkoff win on 4/26 vs Tex, pitched 2 days after the death of his 82-year-old grandmother, Ann Ashcraft, a Rangers fan who lived in Fort Worth...the next day went on the bereavement list...in his next start, on 5/2 at SD, allowed 1 run in 6.0 innings.
- Between a solo HR by Pit's Bryan Reynolds in his season debut and a 2-run HR by WSox' Hanser Alberto's on 5/7 in his seventh start, Ashcraft recorded a career-high homerless streak of 33.0 innings.
- Made his last appearance of the season on 9/1, when he left his start in the top of the fifth inning with the right foot injury...went on the 15-day injured list the next day.
