WINNING WAYS	
The Washington Nationals open a two-game series set against the Atlanta Braves tonight...The Nationals beat the Marlins, 6-3, last night... Daylen Lile produced his fourth multi-homer game of the season, finishing with four RBI... Erik Tolman recorded his first career save (2.0 IP, 4 SO).	
- The Nationals have won four of their last five games, five of their last eight and are 12-7 (.632) in their last 19 home games. - The Nationals are on a stretch of 16 games in 16 days and 39 games in the span of 41 days...Today is game 15 of the 16 with their next off day coming on Sept. 3.	
ROSTER MOVES	
The Nationals selected the contracts of infielder Yohandy Morales and left-handed pitcher Jared Simpson from Triple-A Rochester and transferred catcher Drew Millas to the 60-day Injured List on Tuesday.	
- Morales, 24, ranked in the Minor League system this season in home runs (3rd, 25), runs (3rd, 82), batting average (4th, .286), hits (4th, 116), RBI (4th, 76) and extra-base hits (5th, 44)...He had multi-hit efforts in four of his final eight Triple-A contests and homered in his last game with Rochester. - Simpson, 26, pitched to a 2.30 ERA with 73 strikeouts in 58.2 innings between Double-A Harrisburg and Triple-A Rochester this season...In nine games from July 26 to Aug. 28., Simpson struck out 21 and allowed just five hits (.091 opponents' average, 5-for-55) in 16.2 scoreless innings.	
NATIONAL LEAGUE PLAYER OF THE WEEK	
Daylen Lile was named National League Player of the Week on Monday after hitting 11-for-24 (.458) with two doubles, one triple, three home runs, 10 RBI, five walks, seven runs scored and just three strikeouts in seven games from Aug. 24-30...He led the the National League in batting average, slugging percentage, OPS and RBI.	
- Lile is 18-for-40 (.450) with three doubles, one triple, five homers, 15 RBI, seven walks, just five strikeouts, one stolen base and 11 runs scored in 11 games since Aug. 21...He has a .521 on-base percentage, a .950 slugging percentage and has reached base safely in nine of the 11 games. - Remember that Lile led Major League Baseball in extra-base hits (T1st, 16), batting average (.372), on-base percentage (.423) and slugging percentage (.681) after Aug. 21 last season.	
START ME UP	
In 12 games since Aug. 19, Simon Mathews' starting rotation leads Major League Baseball with a 2.20 ERA (15 ER/61.1 IP) and a .181 opponents average...The group ranks third with a .312 opponents' slugging percentage, having allowed just six home runs during this stretch.	
Cade Cavalli leads the National League with 47 strikeouts and is fourth with a 1.75 ERA in the month of August. Andrew Alvarez has pitched to a 2.41 ERA (10 ER/37.1 IP) and a .176 opponents' average since July 27.	
CREWSIN'	
Dylan Crews has reached base in nine of his last 10 games...He is hitting .300 (12-for-40) with three doubles, a triple, seven RBI, three walks (.349 OBP) and four runs scored during the stretch	
Crews recorded his first walk-off hit with a 10th-inning RBI-single on Saturday afternoon.	
HOW'S IT GOING, OLD CHAP?	
Andrés Chaparro leads Major League Baseball in OPS (1.028) and is second in slugging percentage (.641) since the All-Star break.	
All told, Chaparro is hitting .293 (27-for-92) with eight doubles, eight homers, 26 RBI, 10 walks and 21 runs scored in 34 games since the break.	
RUIZ IS ROLLIN'	
Keibert Ruiz leads Major League catchers in batting average (.377), on-base percentage (.441), OPS (.949) and is sixth in slugging percentage (.508) since Aug. 2 (min. 60 PA).	
He's 23-for-61 (.377) with two doubles, two homers, nine RBI, seven walks, six strikeouts and eight runs scored during this 18-game stretch.	
YOUNG, WILD AND FREE	
Jacob Young is 21-for-69 (.304) with five doubles, one triple, one homer, five RBI, three hit by pitch, seven walks and 11 runs scored in his last 22 games...He's posted a .388 on-base, a .449 slugging and an .837 OPS over this stretch.	
Young has posted career-highs in homers (10), triples (3), RBI (43) and his 19 doubles are approaching his career mark of 24 in 2024.	
HOMER HAPPY	
Washington is second in Major League Baseball with 192 home runs, four behind the Chicago Cubs (196)...See box to the right for additional rankings.	
- The Nationals have clubbed 155 home runs since May 6, the most in Major League Baseball and six more than the Chicago Cubs (149)...Washington entered play on May 6 with 41 home runs, 12th-most in MLB. - Washington has eight players (Abrams, Crews, Garcia Jr., House, Lile, Mead, Wood, Young) with at least 10 home runs, the most by a Nationals team (2005-pres.) since the 2019 Nationals had 10 players with at least 10 homers...Chaparro and Ruiz are both sitting on nine homers for the sesason.

CAREER

Tall right-hander from the University of Oklahoma developed into a reliable member of Washington's starting rotation and a leader in the clubhouse.

- After making 33 starts in 2024 and 2025, he joined **Max Scherzer** (2015-16) as the only two pitchers in Nationals history to start at least 33 games in back-to-back seasons.
- Had the “Best Control” in Washington’s system, per *Baseball America*, entering the 2023 season.

LAST START

Irvin tossed 4.1 innings of one-run ball on three hits and six walks with six strikeouts against the Colorado Rockies at Nationals Park on Aug. 27...He took a no-decision in the 7-1 win.

vs. ATLANTA

Irvin is set to make his 11th career start against the Atlanta Braves...He is 3-4 with a 4.08 ERA (24 ER/53.0 IP) and 41 strikeouts.

HARD TO HIT

Over his last six starts, opposing batters are hitting .214 (27-for-126) with a .320 on-base percentage in 35.0 IP.

CURVIN' IRVIN

Opponents are batting .107 (8-for-85) against Irvin's curveball...He has given up just two extra-base hits on his curveball this season.

REHAB APPEARANCES

Irvin allowed just two hits (2-for-38) with 12 strikeouts and one walk in 11.1 innings across three rehab outings with the FCL Nationals and Double-A Harrisburg Senators...In two outings with Harrisburg, he allowed one hit in 8.1 innings with nine strikeouts and one walk.

2025

- Was tied for second in Major League Baseball with 33 starts and ninth in the National League with 180.0 innings pitched.
- Matched a career high with 8.0 shutout innings against San Francisco on May 24...The game was completed in 1 hour, 52 minutes, tied for third fastest game in Nationals history (2005-pres.)...Irvin has pitched in two of the top six fastest games in Nationals history.
 - Tossed 7.1 innings on April 25 vs. New York (NL)...Allowed one earned run on five hits with four strikeouts and one walk.
