SERIES BUSINESS	
The Washington Nationals square off against the Arizona Diamondbacks in the third and final game of this three-game weekend series...The Nationals beat the Diamondbacks, 5-3, on Saturday...With a win today, the Nationals would secure their third consecutive series.	
• CJ Abrams led the offense, going 3-for-4 with a double, homer, three RBI and a run scored, while Foster Griffin earned his 12th win of the season with 6.2 innings of three-run ball. • Washington is in the midst of a stretch of 17 games in 17 days until it's next day off on Aug. 10 and a run of 39 games in 41 days from Friday through Sept. 2.	
ROSTER MOVES	
The Nationals acquired left-handed pitcher Connelly Early from the Boston Red Sox in exchange for infielder Curtis Mead on Sunday...Washington also recalled infielder Brady House from Triple-A Rochester on Sunday.	
• Early went 7-5 with a 3.44 ERA in 17 games (17 starts) for the Boston Red Sox in 2026...He struck out 93 batters, walked 34 and held opponents to a .235 batting average...Early went 2-0 with a 1.69 ERA (3 ER/16.0 IP), 21 strikeouts, five walks and a .182 opponents' average in three starts from June 20-30 prior to being placed on the 15-day Injured List on July 1 with left elbow inflammation. • House hit .301 with 11 doubles, three triples, eight home runs, 34 RBI, 12 walks, three stolen bases and 26 runs scored in 50 games with Triple-A Rochester since being optioned on May 19...His 62 hits are tied for second in the International League since May 22.	

OUT OF THIS WORLD	
CJ Abrams leads Major League Baseball with 79 RBI...He ranks in the National League in slugging percentage (2nd, .557), OPS (4th, .921), extra-base hits (4th, 48) and homers (5th, 25).	
• He is 14-for-25 (.560) with three doubles, five homers, 11 RBI, two walks, two stolen bases and seven runs scored in his last six games. • Abrams has tied Ian Desmond (25, 2012) for most homers in a season by a Nationals (2005-pres.) shortstop.	
HIT MORE THAN...	
Washington leads Major League Baseball with 152 home runs ahead of the New York Yankees (150).	
• The Nationals have clubbed 115 home runs since May 6, the most in Major League Baseball, 18 more than the Astros (97)...Washington entered play on May 6 with 41 home runs, 12th-most in MLB. • Washington has homered at least once in 21 of its last 22 (43 total HR), 28 of its last 30 (56 total HR) and 38 of its last 42 games (74 total HR).	

...YOU ALLOW	
Washington's pitching staff has surrendered just two home runs (both in the same game, 7/21 at COL) over the last six games, the fewest home runs allowed in MLB since July 19...Four of those came on the road against the Athletics (1 G) and Colorado Rockies (3 G).	
• Nationals starters/openers have not given up any home runs during this stretch. • Overall, Washington's staff has pitched to a 3.23 ERA over the last six games.	

GOING RIGHT AGAINST LEFT	
The Nationals lead Major League Baseball in OPS (.796) and slugging percentage (.449) against left-handed pitching this season...They rank second in batting average (.269), on-base percentage (.348) and doubles (63).	
• Washington is 24-13 (.649) against left-handed starters this year.	

POP FROM THE TOP	
James Wood leads Major League Baseball and ranks among the top hitters in the National League in several offensive categories...See chart to the right for rankings.	
• Wood is hitting .317 with a .441 on-base (20 BB) and a .695 slugging (5 2B, 3B, 8 HR) in his last 21 games. • His 10 leadoff homer lead MLB are the most in a season in franchise history (MON/WSH). • Wood has 13 career leadoff homers, one shy of matching Trea Turner's (14) Nationals record (2005-pres.).

• CJ Abrams and James Wood are the lone members of the 25 HR/15 SB club in MLB this season. • There are 13 players in Major League Baseball with at least 20 home runs and at least 65 RBI...James Wood, CJ Abrams and Luis García Jr. are three of the 12...No other team has more than one player on he list. • CJ Abrams (2nd, .557), James Wood (5th, .543) and Luis García Jr. (6th, .541) and are three of the top six players in slugging percentage in the National League.

Luis García Jr. is in the midst of a career year, already hitting a career-high 21 home runs and matching a career-high of 70 RBI (2024)...He ranks in the National League in RBI (4th, 70) and slugging (6th .541).	
• Since May 24, he ranks in MLB in RBI (1st, 48), slugging (3rd, .680), OPS (3rd, 1.017) and homers (3rd, 18). • He's hitting .316 with a .696 slugging percentage (4 2B, 8 HR), 21 RBI and 12 runs in his last 21 games.

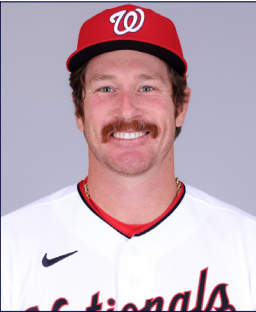

Two-time National League All-Star (2018, 2022) signed with the Nationals on Feb. 11...A veteran of 10 Major League seasons, most recently with the St. Louis Cardinals (2018-25).

- Is 1-2 with a 2.20 ERA (4 ER/16.1 IP) in four career Postseason games (three starts).

- Participated in the 2018 All-Star Game at Nationals Park.

LAST APPEARANCE

Mikolas tossed 3.2 innings and allowed three earned runs on six hits with one strikeout...He took a no-decision in the 8-7 loss to the Colorado Rockies on July 21.

vs. ARIZONA

Mikolas is set to make his seventh career start and ninth appearance against the Arizona Diamondbacks..He is 3-3 with a 3.79 ERA (17 ER/40.1 IP) with 29 strikeouts.

DON'T WALK SIGN

Mikolas leads Major League Baseball with just 0.96 walks per 9.0 innings since May 22...He's walked just six batters in 56.1 innings over this stretch...His 3.83 strikeout-to-walk ratio (22 SO/6 BB) over this stretch is ranked seventh in the National League.
