ART OF STORYTELLIN': After completing their six-game homestand with a record of 3-3 (1-2 vs. Detroit and 2-1 vs. New York-NL), the Twins began their three-game roadtrip/series against the Braves with a loss last night...tonight, they will play the second of three at Truist Park...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, the Twins will travel home to enjoy an off-day on Monday, before beginning a six-game homestand with three against the White Sox (April 22-24) and three against the Angels (April 25-27).

SORRY MS. JAX-ON: The Twins lost to the Braves last night at Truist Park by a score of 6-4, allowing a 4-0 lead...Chris Paddock was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on three hits (1 HR - Kelenic) in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and a season-high six strikeouts...Griffin Jax (0-2) was dealt the loss in relief, allowing four runs on two hits and two walks in the eighth inning...the offense recorded six hits, two from both Carlos Correa and Luke Keaschall...the defeat made the Twins 0-7 in series openers in 2025.

SO FRESH, SO KLEAN: Luke Keaschall made his major league debut last, going 2-for-4 with a double, an RBI, a run scored and a stolen base...he became the fourth Twin in club history (since 1961) to record a hit, an RBI and a stolen base in his debut, joining Jake Cave (5/19/18), Matt Macri (5/24/08) and César Tovar (4/12/65).
 ☞ Additionally, he became the first player in Twins/Senators franchise history (since 1901) with two hits, an extra-base hit, an RBI, a stolen base and a run scored in their debut.

RETURN OF THE 6: The Twins have returned right-handed pitcher Brock Stewart from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 15-day Injured List...Stewart, who has missed all 20 games for Minnesota with a left hamstring strain, appeared in two games on rehab assignment this week with Low-A Fort Myers, pitching 1.2 scoreless innings, with no hits allowed, no walks and five strikeouts...to make room, the Twins optioned Kody Funderburk to St. Paul.
 ☞ The 33-year-old made 16 appearances for the Twins last season, allowing nine runs on 15 hits in 15.2 innings pitched, with eight walks and 20 strikeouts before missing nearly the entire second half with a right shoulder injury...he began 2024 with 12.1 scoreless innings before allowing nine runs in 3.1 innings pitched in his final four games.

WHEELZ OF STEAL: Byron Buxton has been on base 20 times this season and has scored 15 runs...he ranks second in baseball in sprint speed (29.9 mph), trailing only Bobby Witt Jr. (30.1 mph)...Buck enters tonight with four stolen bases (4 attempts) on the season...he has 97 for his career, one short of tying Brian Dozier for eighth on the Twins all-time list (since 1961):

SOUTHERNPLAYLISTICADILLACMUZIK: The Twins and Braves are playing each other in the regular season for the 26th, 27th and 28th times in their history this weekend...the Twins are 8-18 all-time against the Braves in the regular season, going 6-11 in Minnesota (4-2 at the Metrodome, 2-9 at Target Field) and 2-7 in Georgia (2-3 at Turner Field and 0-4 at Truist Park).

AT-L-IENS: The Twins have dropped nine-straight against the Braves, dating back to August of 2019...their last win came on August 5, 2019, when Miguel Sanó hit a pinch-hit, 443-foot, two-run, walk-off home run to centerfield against Chris Martin, giving the Twins a 5-3 victory...it marks the Twins' second-longest active losing streak against any opponent, trailing their current losing streak against Baltimore, which is 10 (dating back to July of 2023).
 ☞ Marks the second-longest losing streak to an NL opponent in Twins history with the only longer one being 11-straight against the Dodgers, from April 30, 2014-May 15, 2023.

INTERLEAGUE PLAYER'S BALL: Twins have gone 2-5 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis from March 27-30, 2-1 vs. New York-NL from April 14-16 and 0-1 at Atlanta...Minnesota is just 4-13 against the NL since August 25, 2024.

SPEAKERBUXXX: Byron Buxton is hitting .292 (42-for-144) with 10 home runs, 23 RBI, a .528 slugging percentage and an .863 OPS in 38 Interleague games dating back to the start of 2024...his .528 slugging percentage ranks ninth-among AL players with a minimum of 150 plate appearances, while his .863 OPS ranks 12th.

I LIKE THE WAY YOU MOVE: In their first 10 games of the season, the Twins starting staff went 1-5, 6.90 ERA (45.2 IP, 35 ER), with 17 walks, 42 strikeouts, a .314 opponent batting average and 11 home runs allowed...in their last 10 starts, they have combined to go 3-1, 1.36 ERA (53.0 IP, 8 ER), with nine walks, 53 strikeouts, a .187 opponent batting average and four home runs allowed.
 ☞ Since April 8, Twins starters lead baseball in ERA and WHIP (0.85), rank second in opponent OPS (.526) and fielding independent pitching (2.68), and third in opponent batting average.

NECK UV DA WOODS RICHARDSON: Since May 6, 2024, Simeon Woods Richardson is tied for second on the Twins staff in starts (28) with Pablo López, trailing Bailey Ober (29)...in innings pitched (133.2), he ranks third, trailing Ober (166.0) and López (164.1).
 ☞ During his rookie season in 2024, SWR posted a 1.22 WHIP, fourth best in Twins history among rookies, trailing Joe Ryan (1.10 - 2022), Bert Blyleven (1.16 - 1970) and Kevin Tapani (1.21 - 1990).

L-EVATORS (ME AND YOU): The Twins are hitting .118 (15-for-127) with eight doubles and one home run (.381 OPS) against left-handed pitching this season, compared to .237 (126-for-531) with 28 doubles and 13 home runs (.678 OPS) against right-handed pitching.
 ☞ Minnesota's .422 slugging percentage vs. lefties last season ranked fourth in the AL and ninth in baseball...their .732 OPS ranked fourth in the AL and 10th in baseball.
 ☞ The Twins have scored 48 runs (45 earned) on 80 hits off tonight's Braves starter Chris Sale in his last 15 starts (since 2015), as he has posted a 4.62 ERA (87.2 IP) in that span, his highest against an AL opponent.

CORR-HEY YAI! Carlos Correa began the season slashing .111/.179/.139 (.318 OPS) with one extra-base hit in his first 10 games, but in his last nine games, he is slashing .286/.355/.464 (.819 OPS) with five extra-base hits...he ranks tied for eighth in baseball in outs made (12) among balls hit at least 100 mph...Shohei Ohtani and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. lead baseball with 15.

DRACULA'S WEDDING: Jonah Bride is getting his first start for Minnesota today...he was acquired via trade with Miami on Wednesday, in exchange for cash considerations...he has three career home runs and seven RBI against the Braves (48 PA), both his most against any opponent...he hit his fourth career home run in this ballpark on August 4, 2024, off Luke Jackson.

TWO DOPE BOYZ: Pablo López (right hamstring strain) is scheduled to make his first rehab start this afternoon for Triple-A St. Paul at Iowa...Michael Tonkin (right shoulder strain) pitched 2.0 innings last night on rehab assignment for Low-A Fort Myers, allowing one unearned run on two hits, with no walks and three strikeouts against Bradenton.

COOLER THAN A POLAR BEARS TOENAILS: Joe Mauer is celebrating his 42nd birthday today...Mauer shares a birthday with former Twins Frank Viola (65), Joe Beimel (48), Dennys Reyes (48) and Zach Duke (42).

LAST START: Earned his first win of the season, and first since August 21, 2024, against Detroit on April 13 in Minnesota's 5-1 victory...allowed one run on five hits (1 HR - Torkelson), with no walks and five strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...allowed no walks for the first time this season.

- ☞ Has recorded five-or-more strikeouts in all three starts this season; second career time striking out five-plus batters in three consecutive games (also, April 22, 2023-April 25, 2024).
- ☞ Detroit's only run came on a solo home run from Spencer Torkelson in the fourth inning.

TWO STARTS AGO: Took the loss, his first of the season, on April 7 at Kansas City...allowed four runs on eight hits (1 HR), with four walks and six strikeouts over 5.2 innings...surrendered a sixth-inning home run to Kyle Isbel to put the Royals up 4-1...four walks allowed tied his career high, first set on June 14, 2024 vs. the Athletics at Target Field.

- ☞ The Royals' two first-inning doubles marked the first time Woods Richardson has allowed multiple doubles in one inning since June 20, 2024 vs. Tampa Bay.

HERE TO STAY: Since May 6, 2024, Simeon Woods Richardson is tied for second on the Twins staff in starts (28) with Pablo López, trailing Bailey Ober (29)...in innings pitched (133.2), he ranks third, trailing Ober (166.0) and López (164.1).

AGAINST ATLANTA: Has one career start against Atlanta on August 27, 2024 at Target Field...did not factor into Minnesota's 6-8 loss, allowing four runs on three hits (4 ER, 1 HR), with three walks and three strikeouts in 4.2 innings...allowed a .176 (3-for-17) opponent batting average...home run came from Michael Harris II in the second inning.

- ☞ Is 2-3 against Interleague opponents in 11 career games (10 starts), posting a 5.21 ERA (48.1 IP, 28 ER), with 20 walks and 45 strikeouts...also has a .288 (55-for-191) opponent batting average.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Since joining the Twins, Woods Richardson has gone 2-2 with a 4.08 ERA (68.1 IP, 31 ER), 8.82 K/9, 3.29 BB/9 and 1.05 HR/9 in 14 starts at home compared to 4-5 with a 4.24 ERA (85.0 IP, 40 ER), 7.31 K/9, 3.18 BB/9 and 1.16 HR/9 in 18 road starts.

- ☞ SWR is 0-2 in his last five starts on the road, posting a 4.84 ERA (22.1 IP, 12 ER) with 11 walks and 21 strikeouts, allowing 12 runs off 27 hits (2 HR).
- ☞ Is 2-2 against Interleague opponents on the road, has a 4.03 ERA (29.0 P, 13 ER), with nine walks and 27 strikeouts in six career starts...has a .272 (31-for-114) BAA.

PLATOON SPLITS: In his career, Woods Richardson has a .267 (69-for-258) opponent batting average against lefties with 25 walks and 58 strikeouts, compared to a .241 (84-for-348) opponent batting average against righties with 33 walks and 83 strikeouts...lefties are slugging .395 with eight home runs while righties are slugging .405 with 12 home runs.

- ☞ In Woods Richardson's three starts of the season, lefties are slashing .423/.467/.654 with two walks and five strikeouts, while righties are slashing .212/.278/.364 with three walks and 11 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Woods Richardson uses a four-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 40% of the time...primarily uses his slider against right-handed batters, while favoring his changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

CAREER NOTES

- In 2025, pitched in the Twins' season-opening rotation for the first time in his career.
- In 2024, pitched a career-high 147.0 professional innings (MiLB and MLB).
- In 2024, finished second among all rookies in Twins history (minimum of 125.0 innings pitched) in strikeouts-per-9.0-innings pitched (7.9) and swing and miss percentage (22.3%); finished fifth in opponent batting average (.246), tied for fifth in strikeouts (117), sixth in opponent OPS (.695), eighth in WHIP (1.29) and 11th in fielding independent pitching (4.04) in 2024.
- Struck out 26 batters in June 2024, the most among AL rookies and tied for fifth most among all rookies in baseball...also ranked third among AL rookies in innings pitched (26.0).
- Entered 2024 ranked by *Baseball America* as Minnesota's No. 29 prospect.
