PITTSBURGH PIRATES (44-48) vs. MILWAUKEE BREWERS (54-39) July 11, 2024 at American Family Field, Milwaukee, WI - 1:10 CDT - GAME #93/ROAD #47 RHP PAUL SKENES (5-0, 2.12 ERA) vs. RHP AARON CIVALE (2-6, 5.18 ERA)

THE PIRATES:...lost 9-0 last night in the second game of their series against the Brewers, ending their streak of 36 straight games of not being shut out...Have won 10 games in their last at-bat, matching their total from all of 2023 (the team won 13 games in the final at-bat of 2022)...Have gone 33-3 (.917 winning percentage) when outhitting their opponents this season...Have drawn at least one walk in 57 straight games, which is the longest active streak in MLB (the Brewers have the second-longest active streak at 44 games)...Have played in 30 one-run games, which are the second-most among National League teams behind the Cubs (33)...Have the fourth-most quality starts (44) in MLB behind the Mariners (55), Phillies (52) and Royals (47)...Have the fifth-best ERA (3.60) among all starting rotations in MLB, trailing only the Phillies (3.19), Mariners (3.41), Royals (3.50) and Orioles (3.50)...Have gone 3-4-1 in eight series against the National League Central heading into the deciding game of this series against the Brewers...Rank second in all of MLB in stolen base percentage (84.5 percent), trailing only the Brewers (84.8 percent)...Are 6-9 in the rubber game of a series...Are 5-7-2 in their first 14 series on the road...Rank sixth in MLB with a .991 fielding percentage this month

ALL-STAR ACCOLADES: Paul Skenes was named to this year's All-Star Game just one year after the Pirates selected him No. 1 overall in the draft...According to MLB, the 22-year-old Skenes is the first player ever to earn an All-Star selection in the season after being the No. 1 overall selection in his draft...Since making his big league debut on May 11, Skenes has the third-lowest ERA (2.12) in all of MLB, trailing only Atlanta's Reynaldo Lopez (1.82) and Garrett Crochet of the White Sox (1.84).

DECISIONS, DECISIONS: Paul Skenes brings a 5-0 record into his 11th big league start this afternoon...The 22-year-old Skenes is the first Pirates rookie to win each of his first five decisions since Justin Wilson did so as a reliever in 2013...The last Pirates rookie starter with a longer winning streak to begin his big league career was Zach Duke, who won each of his first six decisions in 2005.

ON DECK: The final series leading up to this year's All-Star break will take the team to Chicago for a three-game series beginning tomorrow against the White Sox (the Bucs are 4-3 against the AL Central this year)...It will be Pittsburgh's first trip to the south side of Chicago since 2021, but the first three-game series the Pirates play against the White Sox on the road since 2009...That series concluded on May 14 when the Pirates scored twice in the ninth inning and Matt Capps earned his ninth save of the season.

HOT ROWD: Since the beginning of last month, Rowdy Tellez ranks second in the National League in batting (.351) and third in slugging (.638) and OPS (1.034) among players with at least 95 plate appearances...Tellez is also 10-for-16 (.625) with runners in scoring position since the beginning of last month...Since June 26, Tellez has hit six home runs, which are the second-most in all of MLB behind Colorado's Brenton Doyle (seven)...Tellez' 11 RBI during that time are also tied for ninth among all National League players.

ON THE OFFENSE: The Pirates come into today leading all of MLB in home runs (19) this month (the Tigers rank second with 18)...The Bucs also rank sixth in all of MLB with 49 runs scored this month...The only five teams to plate more runs this month are the Diamondbacks (63), Twins (55), Athletics (55) and Astros (54).

NO JOSHING AROUND: Joshua Palacios went 1-for-3 last night and has now reached base safely in each of his first seven games since being promoted from Triple-A on July 4...In his first five starts, Palacios is 5-for-18 with two home runs, four RBI and five runs scored...Palacios has also drawn two walks as a pinch hitter...Since the beginning of last year, Palacios' eight pinch-hit RBI are tied for the second-most in MLB.

KEEPING UP WITH CUTCH'S MILESTONES: Andrew McCutchen's double on July 3 moved him into sole possession of sixth place for the most career extra base hits (591) in Pirates history...He is now one extra base hit shy of tying Pie Traynor for the fifth-most in team history...McCutchen also ranks fifth on the team's all-time walks list (799)...The only four Pirates with more career walks are Willie Stargell (937), Max Carey (919), Paul Waner (912) and Honus Wagner (877).

TODAY'S STARTER RHP PAUL SKENES #30

2024 RECORD: 5-0, 2.12 ERA

HEIGHT/WEIGHT: 6-6/235 **BATS/THROWS:** R/R
BORN: May 29, 2002
AGE: 22 **SIGNED:** Thru 2024
HOW ACQUIRED: Selected by the Pirates in the 1st round (No. 1) of the 2023 Draft.

STARTING OFF: The 22-year-old righthander is in his first Major League season with the Pirates...Began the season with Triple-A Indianapolis where he made seven starts, posting an 0.99 ERA (27.1ip/3er) with 45 strikeouts against just eight walks before being selected to the Major League roster on May 11...Was the No. 1 overall selection by the Pirates in the 2023 First-Year Player draft out of Louisiana State University.

PROSPECT SZN: Skenes entered the 2024 season rated as the No. Pirates 1 prospect by Baseball America, as well as the top pitching prospect in baseball and the No. 3 overall prospect in the sport by MLB.com...Entering the 2023 draft, he was rated by MLB.com as the No. 1 prospect in the 2023 class, as well as having the "Best Fastball", "Best Breaking Ball", third "Best Control" and fifth "Best Changeup" in the 2023 college class.

LEAGUE LEADERS: Since making his Major League debut on May 11, Skenes ranks among the NL leaders in strikeout-to-walk ratio (1st, 6.50), strikeouts per 9.0 IP (2nd, 11.83), ERA (2nd, 2.06), strikeouts (T2nd, 78) WHIP (5th, 1.01),and opponents batting average (15th, .221).

GOING LOW: Among players to debut since 1912 (first year earned runs were tracked in the NL; 1913 for AL), Skenes is one of two pitchers with a 2.12 or lower ERA in their first 10 career pitching appearances – which were all starts – for Pittsburgh, joining Zach Duke (1.81).

- If you don't require that a pitcher's first 10 career appearances were all starts, Pirates pitchers since 1912 with a 2.12 or lower ERA in their first 10 starts only (ignoring relief appearances) are Cy Blanton (1.23), Duke and Skenes.

HE'S A WINNER: Since being drafted first overall in the 2023 MLB Draft, Skenes has not lost a game as a professional (Major or Minor Leagues)...His last loss came on May 25, 2023 at Arkansas while pitching at LSU.

- Skenes has not exited a game while trailing yet in his Major League career.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his fifth win of the season on July 5 vs. New York-NL after allowing two runs on four hits with eight strikeouts against two walks in 7.0 innings pitched.

JUNE BOOM: Skenes posted a 2-0 record with a 1.78 ERA (6 ER in 30.1 IP), 40 strikeouts and five walks in five starts during the month of June...He ranked among the NL leaders last month in wins (T1st), ERA (3rd), strikeouts (T4th) and WHIP (15th).

RACKING UP PUNCHIES: Skenes has recorded seven or more strikeouts in seven consecutive games dating back to the second game of a doubleheader in Detroit on May 29, matching the franchise record set by Mitch Keller from April 27-May 31, 2023.

- In total, Skenes has recorded seven or more strikeouts in nine of his 10 career outings, making him the first pitcher in Major League history to have nine such outings in their first 10 career games.

BODY OF WORK: Is making his 11th career start and appearance today...He has allowed three earned runs or fewer in each of his 10 career outings, including two or fewer eight times and one or fewer six times (two scoreless outings).

- Skenes is the second pitcher in Pirates history to win at least five of his first 10 career outings with 70+ strikeouts, joining Jose DeLeon in 1983 (6-2, 85 strikeouts).
- His 78 strikeouts through 10 outings are the second-most by a Pirates pitcher to start their career, trailing only DeLeon's 85 in 1983...DeLeon had 91 strikeouts through 11 career outings.

THAT SEEMS GOOD: Skenes (78 K, 12 BB) is one of two pitchers to debut in the modern era (since 1901) with at least 75 strikeouts and 15 or fewer walks allowed through 10 Major League appearances, joining NYY Masahiro Tanaka (79 K, 10 BB) in 2014.

BRINGING THE HEAT: Skenes has thrown 74 pitches of 100.0+ mph this season, the most of any Major League starter in 2024...To date, Skenes has thrown three of the top-10 hardest thrown pitches by Major League starters this season and nine of the top 20...Prior to Angels flamethrower Ben Joyce making his first career start on June 16 and throwing nine pitches of 101.0+ mph, Skenes had previously thrown seven of the top-10 hardest thrown pitches by Major League starters this season.

- Skenes has thrown 10 pitches of 101.0+ mph, including the hardest thrown pitch by a Pirates starter since data started being tracked in 2008 (101.9 on May 11 vs. Chicago-NL)...His 10 pitches at that velocity are tops in the Majors among starters in that category, ahead of LAA Ben Joyce (9).
- His 74 pitches of 100.0-plus mph are already the most ever by a Pirates starter since 2008, topping Gerrit Cole's 33 he had during his five years with the Bucs.

MILITARY MAN: Spent the first two years of his collegiate career at the Air Force Academy, where he earned the 2022 John Olerud Award as the nation's best two-way player while both pitching and catching...He majored in Military Strategic Studies while at Air Force and was a member of Cadet Squadron 9.

- Has pledged to donate \$100 for every strikeout he records this season to the Gary Sinise Foundation to support our nation's defenders, veterans, first responders, their families, and those in need...ESPN's Pat McAfee has also pledged to match Paul's donation at the end of the season.
