THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
MAY 15
2005 - 3B Morgan Ensberg sets the Daikin Park record, and ties the club record, with 13 total bases by going 4x4 with three homers in a 9-0 win over the Giants...Ensberg is now one of just six players in club history to record 13 total bases in a single game...since Ensberg, this feat has been accomplished three times by an Astro: **LF Yordan Alvarez** (2022, 2024) and **CF Jake Meyers** (2025).

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros will continue their seven-game homestand tonight as they open up the Silver Boot Series, presented by the Texas Lottery, against the in-state rival Rangers...**RHP Spencer Arrighetti**, who's been one of the best pitchers in the Majors since rejoining the Astros rotation in mid April, will get the start for Houston tonight opposite third-year starter **RHP Jack Leiter** and the Rangers.

HOT SPAGHETTI: Tonight's Astros starter **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** made his season debut on April 15 and has since gone 4-1 with a 1.88 ERA (6ER/28.2IP) and a .206 opponent batting average...since making his season debut, he ranks tied for first in the AL in wins (4), sixth in ERA (1.88), and ninth in opponent batting average (.206).

THE SILVER BOOT SERIES: The Astros and Rangers have played each other 292 times in their franchise histories, splitting those matchups evenly with 146 wins apiece...recently, the Astros have had the upper hand, winning or splitting nine straight season series, going 93-51 against the Rangers since the start of the 2017 season.

ABOUT THE SKIPPER: Manager **Joe Espada** recorded his 192nd career managerial victory on Wednesday, which moved him past **Harry Craft** (1962-64) into 12th in club history...he now immediately trails **Jimmy Williams** (215) for 11th on the club's all-time managerial wins list.

TODAY'S FASHION SHOW: The Astros held the annual Astros Foundation's Champions for Healthy Families Luncheon & Fashion Show presented by Shaftel Diamonds and styled by TOOTSIES earlier today at Daikin Park...the models of the fashion show were the wives and significant others of Astros players and coaches...the goal of the event was to impact and promote healthy families in support the Astros Foundation and a variety of local nonprofits.

TONIGHT'S PROMOTIONS: Friday night at the ballpark should prove to be exciting as 10,000 fans will receive a **Hunter Brown Orange Jersey**, presented by SLB...postgame, Friday Night Fireworks presented by ConocoPhillips, will feature the musical theme **Texas Country**.

FELIZ CUMPLEAÑOS! The Astros would like to wish broadcaster **Francisco Romero** a Happy Birthday today...he shares his birthday with Astros great **Michael Brantley**, who's turning 39 today.

YESTERDAY'S MATINEE: The Astros allowed a three-run 1st inning and were unable to claw back in the game in club's eventual 8-3 loss to the visiting Mariners...**DH Yordan Alvarez** (3x3, HR, RBI) and **SS Braden Shewmake** (2x4, 2RBI) did all the damage offensively for Houston...**RHP Mike Burrows** (5.2IP) started the contest for the Astros.

DOWN ON THE FARM: **C Jason Schiavone** had a two-homer game for Class A Asheville yesterday, giving him 17 home runs on the season, which leads all of minor league baseball...meanwhile, at Class A Fayetteville, **RHP Javier Perez** made the longest start in Woodpecker history, tossing 8.0 scoreless innings while fanning seven.

POSTING: The Astros have used 45 different lineups in their 45 games in 2026...**LF Yordan Alvarez** has started every game, while **1B Christian Walker** has played in every game, making 44 starts.

AIR YORDAN: **DH Yordan Alvarez** is batting .321 (53x165) with 11 doubles, 14 HR, 30 RBI and a 1.071 OPS (.429 OBP/.642 SLG)...in the AL, he ranks first in total bases (106), first in extra-base hits (25), first in OBP, second in OPS, second in SLG, tied for second in hits, tied for second in RBI, fourth in batting average, fourth in homers, tied for eighth in doubles, and tied for eighth in runs (29).

EXTRA! EXTRA!: **DH Yordan Alvarez** had two extra-base hits yesterday, giving him 357 career extra-base hits, which moved him past **3B Doug Rader** (355) for 10th in extra-base hits in Astros franchise history...he now immediately trails **1B Bob Watson** (410) for ninth on that all-time list.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS: **2B Jose Altuve** has exactly 900 career RBI, making him the fifth player in franchise history to reach that mark...he also has 238 career homers as a second baseman, needing one more to tie **Lou Whitaker** for seventh place all-time in MLB history among second basemen.

BEST IN TEXAS: **2B Jose Altuve** has 37 home runs and 100 RBI in his career vs. the Rangers, which are his most vs. any opponent...all-time in MLB history opposite the Rangers, Altuve ranks fifth in runs scored (143), tied for seventh in homers, and eighth in hits (241)...all-time leaderboards vs. TEX below:

THE SHEW FITS: **SS Braden Shewmake** went 2x4 yesterday, which extended his current hitting streak to a career-long nine games, which ties as the longest active streak in the Majors...Shewmake has hit .378 (14x37) with three homers and a 1.027 OPS in 14 games since being acquired by the Astros in a trade from the Yankees on April 19.

GUN 'EM DOWN: In just 21 games, **C Christian Vázquez** has thrown out nine baserunners attempting to steal (in 25 attempts), which ranks tied for first in the AL and tied for third in the Majors.

STARS DOWN IN CORPUS: **SS Jeremy Peña** (right hamstring strain), **CF Jake Meyers** (right oblique strain) and **LHP Josh Hader** (left biceps tendinitis) are all on rehab assignments for Double A Corpus Christi...in his last game, Peña went 1x2 with a double and a HBP on Tuesday and is expected to play again tonight...Meyers has started twice in center field for the Hooks, including a start last night...Hader last pitched on Tuesday, tossing 1.0 inning, allowing 1 hit with a strikeout.

LAST START, MAY 9 at CIN: Struck out 5 through 5.2 innings of work, allowing 3 runs (1 earned) on 5 hits with 3 walks...received the losing decision in the Astros' 3-1 loss to the Reds at Great American Ball Park, snapping a streak of 4 consecutive winning decisions to open his season...has worked at least 5.0 innings in each of his 5 starts this year, marking the longest such streak by an Astros this season.

SPAGHETTI DAY: The 3rd-year starter has dominated in his Major League action this season, going 4-1 in 5 starts with a 1.88 ERA (5ER/23IP), while fanning 30 in 28.2 innings and allowing a miniscule .206 (21x102) opponent average...leads the Astros with 4 wins on the young season...his 4-game winning streak this season is tied for the 2nd-longest in the AL this season and is the longest of his Major League career...all this came after he began the season at Triple A Sugar Land (recalled on April 15).

VS. TEX: Tonight will mark just his 2nd start vs the intrastate rival, but was fantastic in his lone career outing vs. the Rangers, coming on July 13, 2024 at Daikin Park...allowed just 1 run on 2 hits while striking out 7 and walking 3...did not factor into the decision of a 2-1 Astros loss in 10 innings...has traditionally been strong vs. AL West opponents in his career, posting a 2.87 ERA (15ER/47IP), a .200 opponent batting average and 9.77 SO/9IP in 8 career starts vs. divisional opponents, including 5 quality starts.

SINCE HIS RECALL: Since making his season debut on April 15, Arrighetti ranks T-1st among MLB pitchers in wins (4)...in the AL over that span, he also ranks 6th in ERA (1.88), 9th in opponent batting average (.206) and T-10th in strikeouts (30).

SAVANT SAYS: Ranks in the 99th percentile in extension (7.4) and 77th percentile in hard-hit percentage (33.8).

RACKING UP K'S: Has 30 strikeouts in his 28.2 innings pitched this season, which included a 10-strikeout game in his season debut on April 15 vs. COL...his 10 strikeouts are the most strikeouts in a game by an Astros pitcher this season and marked his 5th career game with 10+ strikeouts (last: 11 strikeouts on Aug. 11, 2024 at PHI).

STRIKEOUT PACE: His 232 career strikeouts are 3rd-most through a player's first 41 career appearances in Astros history, trailing only **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** (271) and **RHP Tom Griffin** (235).

DOWN IN SUGAR LAND: Broke camp with Triple A Sugar Land and posted a 1.26 ERA (2ER/14.1IP), 0.77 WHIP and .111 opponent batting average, with 20 strikeouts, through 3 starts with the Space Cowboys...on the date of his recall from Triple A (April 15), he ranked 1st in the PCL in strikeouts and 2nd in ERA, WHIP and opponent batting average.

2025 SEASON: Battled through a pair of IL stints in his 2nd season in the Majors, missing 105 team games due to a broken right thumb from April 7-Aug. 6, and then the final 26 games of the regular season due to right elbow inflammation...held opponents to a .229 average through his 7 starts, also recording a 5.35 ERA (21ER/35.1IP), 1.415 WHIP and 7.9 SO/9IP...was fantastic at Daikin Park, recording a 2.08 ERA (4ER/17.1IP) and .056 opponent average (3x54) in his 3 home starts.

ABOUT ARRIGHETTI: Grew up in Albuquerque, N.M., but moved to the Houston suburb of Katy for high school and attended Cinco Ranch High School, located approximately 30 miles from Daikin Park...was selected by the Astros in the 6th round of the 2021 MLB First-Year Player Draft from UL-Lafayette and was routinely ranked as one of the club's top pitching prospects in ascent through the minors...was named the Astros 2023 Minor League Pitcher of the Year.

LAST APPEARANCE (5/13 vs. SEA): Earned his 2nd win of the season Wednesday night vs. SEA after he allowed 1 walk and struck out 1 in 1.0 scoreless inning.

TIDES TURNING: Has gone 2-0 with a 1.42 ERA (1ER/6.1IP) in his last 6 games dating back to April 24...prior to this hot streak, posted a 14.73 ERA (12ER/7.1IP) in his first 9 games of the season.

VS. TEX: Has made 29 career regular-season appearances vs. the Rangers, the most among current Astros pitchers and tied for 4th-most among active players...has struck out 35 batters through 30.0 career innings vs. TEX while posting a 4.20 ERA (14ER/30IP)...his 10.50 SO/9IP vs. TEX ranks 8th among active pitchers (min. 30 IP)...also appeared in 6 of the 7 games of the 2023 ALCS vs. TEX, posting a 3.00 ERA (1ER/3IP) with 4 strikeouts and a .100 opponent average (1x10) through his first 4 apps of the series, before surrendering 3 runs through 2.0 innings in the final 2 apps.

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: With his outing on April 24 vs. NYY, he reached 338.0 career innings, passing **RHP Octavio Dotel** for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...currently has 343.1 IP, with **RHP Xavier Hernandez** next on the all-time list at 371.2 innings...also among Astros relievers all time, he ranks 4th in strikeouts (469) and 7th in apps. (332).

DAIKIN PARK RANKINGS: Is 1.0 inning from matching **RHP Ryan Pressly** (179.1) for the 4th-most innings pitched by a reliever in Daikin Park history...is also 3 strikeouts from matching **RHP Octavio Dotel** (247) for the 2nd-most strikeouts by a reliever in Daikin Park history.

CAREER: In 332 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.88 ERA (110ER/343.1P) with 469 strikeouts, a 1.21 WHIP, 12.29 -K/9 and a 0.76 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.
