NEW YORK METS (51-66) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (57-61)
August 8, 2026 - PNC Park - Pittsburgh, PA - 6:40 EDT - Game #119/Home #59
RHP Robert Stock (0-1, 1.80 ERA) vs. RHP Bubba Chandler (4-8, 4.49 ERA)

THE PIRATES: dropped the first game of this brief, three-game homestand vs. New York-NL (Friday-Sunday) with Friday's 6-4 loss at PNC Park (it marks their only three-game homestand of the season and their first three-game homestand since June 20-22, 2025 vs. Texas)...Won two of eight games on their recent road trip to Cincinnati (1-3, July 30-August 2) and Milwaukee (1-3, August 3-6)...Will embark on a three-game road trip to Miami (Tuesday-Thursday) following this homestand (it will mark their first three-game road trip against a non-National League Central opponent since they ended the 2024 season with a three-game series from September 27-29 at Yankee Stadium)...Are in the 16th day of a stretch of 17 consecutive days with a game (their last off day was on July 23, while their next off day is scheduled for August 10)...Have hit 143 home runs (they hit 117 home runs in 2025)...Have the most hits (1048) in all of Major League Baseball...Have scored the third-most runs (592) in Major League Baseball, behind Washington (628) and Chicago-NL (601), after scoring 583 runs all of last year...Have struck out the third-most batters (1094) in Major League Baseball, behind Philadelphia (1140) and Milwaukee (1135).

MEET THE METS: The Pirates are hosting the Mets for a three-game series (Friday-Sunday) this weekend at PNC Park...Pittsburgh dropped two of three games in its season-opening series against New York at Citi Field (March 26-29)...The Pirates have won or split each of their last three series against the Mets at PNC Park...They won two of three games from June 9-11, 2023, split a four-game series from July 5-8, 2024 and swept a three-game series from June 27-29, 2025...Pittsburgh has won or split at least four straight home series against the Mets only five times in series history (since 1962), coming from April 21, 1962-June 6 (G2), 1965 (10 straight series), September 20, 1965-August 11, 1966 (four straight series), September 19, 1980-August 16, 1983 (eight straight series), April 15, 1991-June 20, 1993 (seven straight series) and July 12, 2013-June 8, 2016 (four straight series).

J-HAY: Josh Harrison, who was a two-time All-Star with the Pirates (2014 and 2017), officially retired as a member of the organization on Friday and will be honored with a special pregame ceremony and first pitch prior to tonight's game against the Mets...He batted .270 (1080-for-3997) across his 1209 Major League games with Pittsburgh (2011-18), Detroit (2019), Washington (2020-21), Oakland (2021), Chicago-AL (2022) and Philadelphia (2023)...Harrison went 2-for-4 with an RBI and a run scored in his Major League debut on May 31, 2011 at Citi Field (he picked up two singles off New York starter R.A. Dickey in the Pirates' 5-1 win)...He is also remembered for his elusive escape of a rundown during the 10th inning of Pittsburgh's 3-2, 11-inning win over the Mets on June 27, 2014, a game that he ended via a walkoff double (off Vic Black) that scored Clint Barmes.

IRON CITY BRYAN: Bryan Reynolds, who went 2-for-5 with a double on Friday vs. New York (NL), has played in each of Pittsburgh's 118 games this season and 127 consecutive team games (he missed his last game last season on September 17 vs. Chicago-NL)...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, that marks the fifth-longest streak by any Pirate since 1989, trailing Jason Bay (307, 2004-06), Bobby Bonilla (189, 1989-90), Kevin Young (142, 1998) and Andrew McCutchen (132, 2011)...He is on pace to become the seventh Pirate (10th instance) in the Expansion Era (since 1961) to play in all of the team's games in a season, joining Dick Groat (161 in 1962), Bill Mazeroski (162 in 1964, 162 in 1966 and 163 in 1967), Matty Alou (162 in 1969), Omar Moreno (162 in 1980 and 103 in 1981), Johnny Ray (162 in 1982) & Jason Bay (162 in 2005).

THE MORE YOU YO: Yohan Ramirez struck out four batters while allowing just two baserunners (a single and a walk) without allowing a run over a career-high 3.1 innings of relief on Friday vs. New York (NL)...Ramirez, who had 11 strikeouts in five games (8.1ip) with the Mets in 2024, became the first Pirates reliever with at least 3.1 scoreless innings, two or fewer baserunners allowed and four strikeouts in an outing since Bryse Wilson (April 27, 2022 vs. Milwaukee)...He has a 0.33 ERA (27.2ip/1er) and a .161 batting average against (15-for-93) in his last 20 relief outings (since June 6 at Atlanta)...Ramirez has become the fifth different Pittsburgh relief pitcher (14th instance) since earned runs became an official statistic in the National League in 1912 to post an ERA of 0.33 or lower over a 20-game span (minimum 27.2 innings pitched during the span), along with Elroy Face (0.28 ERA, May 17 [G1]-July 9, 1959), Bob Moose (0.00 ERA, June 17, 1975-May 24, 1976), Bill Landrum (10 spans in 1989) & Brad Lincoln (0.31 ERA, May 1-July 28, 2012).

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected in the third round of the 2021 Draft.

AS OF LATE: Chandler won a 4-3 decision after allowing three runs (two earned) across his 5.2 innings of work on August 3 at Milwaukee...He has pitched to a 3.05 ERA (20.2ip/7er) across his last four starts, dating back to July 11 (G2) vs. Milwaukee.

HOMER HIATUS: Chandler allowed nine home runs over 74.0 innings of work (1.09 home runs per 9.0 innings) in his first 15 games (14 starts) from March 31-June 19...He has allowed one home run across 36.1 innings in his last seven starts, dating back to June 25 vs. Seattle (it came from Luis García Jr. on July 5 at Washington)...Chandler is one of five Major League pitchers with at least 36.1 innings pitched and one home run allowed during that stretch, along with Baltimore's Shane Baz (42.1ip), St. Louis' Andre Pallante (41.1ip), Arizona's Brandon Pfaadt (40.2ip) and Miami's Eury Pérez (42.1ip).

AND THE WHIFF: Chandler's 98 strikeouts are the sixth-most among all Major League rookies, behind New York (NL)'s Nolan McLean (156), Cleveland's Parker Messick (136), Boston's Payton Tolle (124), Cleveland's Foster Griffin (122) and Milwaukee's Brandon Sproat (100)...Mike Burrows paced all Pittsburgh rookies with 97 strikeouts last season.

RIGHT ON: Chandler has limited right-handed hitters to a .218 batting average against (42-for-193) and a .609 OPS this season...The only righthanders to take him deep were Chicago (NL)'s Dansby Swanson (April 12) and San Francisco's Heliot Ramos (May 10).

WHAT A RELIEF: Chandler allowed just one hit and struck out seven batters over 5.1 innings out of the bullpen on June 7 at Atlanta...He became only the second Pirates reliever in the Modern Era (since 1901) to pitch at least 5.0 innings, strike out at least seven batters and allow one or zero hits in an appearance...Chandler joined Bill Swift, who did that over his 7.1 innings out of the bullpen on July 28 (G2), 1935 vs. St. Louis.

GIMME FIVE: Chandler struck out a career-high 11 batters in 5.0 innings on May 22 at Toronto...He joined Erik Bedard (May 3, 2012 at St. Louis) as the only Pirates in the Modern Era (since 1901) to have at least 11 strikeouts in an outing of 5.0 or fewer innings...Chandler also became one of 11 Major Leaguers (since earned runs became an official stat in both leagues in 1913) to have at least 11 strikeouts and zero earned runs in an outing of 5.0 or fewer innings (he was only the fourth rookie to accomplish that).

A BIT OF BOTH: Chandler went 2-1 with a 5.12 ERA (19.1ip/11er) in four starts and 2-0 with a 2.25 ERA (12.0ip/3er) in three relief appearances in 2025...Nine of the 11 runs he allowed as a starting pitcher came during his first career start (Sept. 7 vs. Milwaukee).

FINISHING STRONG: Chandler went 2-0 with a 1.08 ERA (16.2ip/2er), 19 strikeouts (zero walks issued), a .123 batting average against (7-for-57) and a 0.42 WHIP over his final three starts of the 2025 season, including 5.2 innings of one-run ball in his final start on September 27 at Atlanta (he is a native of Lawrenceville, GA, located approximately 30 miles from Truist Park)...He became the first Pittsburgh pitcher during the Modern Era (since 1901) to make three consecutive starts with one or zero runs allowed, zero walks issued and at least six strikeouts...Chandler also joined Milwaukee's Corbin Burnes (four starts) in 2021, Arizona's Zac Gallen (three starts) in 2023 and Detroit's Tarik Skubal (three starts) last season as the only Major League pitchers during the Modern Era to make at least three consecutive starts with four or fewer hits allowed, one/zero runs allowed, zero walks issued and at least six strikeouts.
