MONDAY'S GAME: The Brewers were defeated by the Reds, 5-4, in Goodyear....**2B Caleb Durbin** went 2-for-4 with 2 runs, a HR (#2) to lead off the game and a stolen base....**3B Vinny Capra** went 2-for-3 with a double, solo HR (#4), walk and a stolen base....**LHP Aaron Ashby** started for Milwaukee (1ip, 2bb, 1hbp) before leaving due to an oblique injury.

THE ROSTER: The team currently has 62 players in Major League camp: 30 pitchers, 7 catchers, 14 infielders and 11 outfielders....there are 22 non-roster invitees in camp: 8 pitchers, 4 catchers, 6 infielders and 4 outfielders.

THE NEW BREW: LHP Tyler Alexander (free agent), RHP Grant Anderson (trade with TEX), LHP Nestor Cortes (trade with NYY), INF Caleb Durbin (trade with NYY), RHP Elvin Rodríguez (free agent), LHP Connor Thomas (Rule 5 Draft from STL) and LHP Grant Wolfram (free agent).

GONE FROM 2024: SS Willy Adames (SF), RHP Kevin Herget (NYM), LHP Wade Miley (CIN), LHP Hoby Milner (TEX), RHP Frankie Montas (NYM), RHP Colin Rea (CHC), RHP Joe Ross (PHI), C Gary Sánchez (BAL), RHP Devin Williams (NYY), RHP Bryce Wilson (CWS) and LHP Rob Zastryzny (CHC).

2024 IN REVIEW: The Brewers went 93-69 and finished in first place in the NL Central, 10.0 games ahead of the Cardinals and Cubs....the team tied the Padres for the fourth-best record in baseball, trailing only the Dodgers (98-64), Phillies (95-67) and Yankees (94-68)....the Brewers lost to the Mets, 2 games to 1, in the NL Wild Card Series in Milwaukee.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times over the last seven seasons (missed in 2022) and have won the NL Central in four of the last seven seasons, three of the last four, and two straight....the Brewers are one of just five teams to qualify for the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons....they are joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6).

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24)....this does not include the shortened 2020 season....the Brewers have 666 wins since 2017, which ranks sixth in the majors and third in the National League....the teams was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight consecutive seasons, missing out by just a game in both 2017 and 2022.

TODAY’S STARTER: #51 - RHP FREDDY PERALTA

RHP Freddy Peralta, 28, went 11-9 with a 3.68 ERA in a career-high 32 starts last season.....his 173.2 innings pitched marked a career high.....Peralta was among NL leaders in K/9IP (5th, 10.36), H/9IP (5th, 7.41), strikeouts (6th, 200) and AVG (6th, .224).....the team went 19-13 in his starts.....he produced 11 quality starts.....Peralta, who made his first career Opening Day start last season, is signed through the 2025 season with a club option for 2026.

ALSO SCHEDULED TO PITCH...

RHP Deivi García, 25, is a non-roster invitee.....he has pitched in the Major Leagues with New York-AL (2020-21, '23) and Chicago-AL (2023-24), appearing in 30 games (8 starts).....he made his first career Opening Day roster with the White Sox last season and went 1-2 with a 7.07 ERA and 1 save in 14 relief appearances.

RHP Abner Uribe, 24, went 2-2 with a 6.91 ERA and 3 saves in 14 relief appearances with Milwaukee last season.....he underwent right knee surgery last July 18, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache, and missed the remainder of the season.

RHP Nick Mears, 28, went 1-5 with a 5.93 ERA in a career-high 54 relief appearances between Colorado (41g) and Milwaukee (13g).....he was traded to the Brewers on July 27 for RHP Bradley Blalock and RHP Yujanyer Herrera.....he had 75 strikeouts in 57.2 innings.....he was on the 15-day injured list from 8/25-9/25 with right forearm inflammation.

LHP Bruce Zimmermann, 30, signed with Milwaukee on Dec. 19 and is a non-roster invitee.....Zimmermann went 3-4 with a 4.34 ERA and 1 save in 23 games (15 starts) last season at Triple-A Norfolk (Orioles).....he missed time while on Norfolk's injured list from 5/12-7/2 with a strained right hamstring.....Zimmermann pitched parts of four seasons (2020-23) in the Major Leagues with Baltimore, going 8-10 with a 5.57 ERA in 38 games (27 starts).
