THE TWINS: Have gone 2-2 through four games on their current seven-game roadtrip...the Twins and Tigers were rained out on Thursday night, followed by a loss to the Tigers on Friday night, then two wins in the doubleheader yesterday at Comerica, ending the series with a loss yesterday afternoon...tonight, Minnesota will play the first of three against Baltimore through Wednesday afternoon.

STRONG 'PEN CRACKS IN FINALE: The lost to the Tigers on Sunday afternoon by a score of 4-3... Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, pitching 6.0 shutout innings, with three hits allowed, no walks and three strikeouts...the bullpen allowed a four-run eighth inning as Caleb Thielbar gave up three runs on three hits in his first appearance back from the IL and first appearance of 2024...the offense recorded six hits and Ryan Jeffers drove in two with a bases loaded single...the Jeffers hit snapped an 0-for-11 slide for Minnesota with the bases full this season...Christian Vázquez hit his first home run of the season, a solo shot in the fourth inning off Jack Flaherty.

TWINS AND O's: The Twins and Orioles are playing each other for the first of six games in 2024...Minnesota will host the O's for three games to complete the regular season from September 27-29...the Twins went 2-4 vs. Baltimore last season, going 2-1 at Camden from June 30-July 2 and 0-3 at Target Field from July 7-9...last season marked the Twins' first losing season to the Orioles since going 1-5 in 2016.

✦ Minnesota has lost four-straight vs. the Orioles, their longest losing streak to Baltimore since losing five-straight from April 4-May 11, 2016.

✦ The Twins are 38-21 vs. Baltimore since the start of 2014...that marks the most wins against Baltimore among non-American League East teams in that span.

✦ Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 16-9 against Baltimore for a .640 winning percentage, his highest of any opponent.

✦ Since 2018, the Twins have hit 56 home runs in 32 games against the Orioles, tied for their most vs. any opponent (also, Seattle and New York-AL - 56), outside of the AL Central.

✦ Christian Vázquez has 39 career hits at Camden Yards, his most of any opposing ballpark.

✦ Jose Miranda made his major league debut at Oriole Park on May 2, 2022, going 0-for-4... he recorded his first hit the next night, hitting an RBI-double off Bruce Zimmermann.

BUCK AND THE BIRDS: Byron Buxton has hit safely in 10-straight games at Oriole Park at Camden Yards, hitting .341 (14-for-41) with six doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI and a 1.021 OPS in that span...it marks the longest active streak in Baltimore for any major league player... it also marks the second-longest for a Twin in club history...below are the top four hitting streaks for a Twin at this ballpark:

THE 'PEN IS (STILL) MIGHTY: The Twins bullpen has combined to go 4-2, 2.13 ERA (55.0 IP, 13 ER) with 22 walks, 71 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average...below are their ranks among other bullpens in baseball in a few notable categories:

THE LEFTORNIER: Through 14 games this season, Twins hitters are slashing .208/.289/.340 with a .629 OPS vs. left-handed pitching compared to .179/.278/.321 with a .599 OPS vs. right-handed pitching...four of their 14 homers have been hit off lefties (Royce Lewis off Cole Ragans, Manny Margot off James Paxton, Ryan Jeffers off Alex Vesia and Edouard Julien off Vesia).

✦ The only lefty starter the Twins have dealt a loss to was Cole Ragans on Opening Day in Kansas City.

✦ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .302 (16-for-53) with seven home runs and a 1.114 OPS in his last 31 games against left-handed pitching, dating back to June 22, 2023.

✦ Manny Margot is hitting .313 (20-for-64) in his last 34 games vs. lefties, since June 11, 2023.

✦ Edouard Julien is 3-for-9 (.333) off lefties this season...he hit his first career home run off a lefty on Wednesday vs. Los Angeles-NL, an opposite-field shot off Alex Vesia (19th career homer)...it was also Julien's 11th career hit off a lefty, his second career extra-base hit and second career RBI against a southpaw.

AMERICA'S NEXT TOP JEFF: Ryan Jeffers finished the four-game series in Detroit going 5-for-11 (.455) with one home run, four RBI and one walk in three games played...Jeffers enters today with a five-game hitting streak; his career high is 14, done from July-August of 2023...during his current streak, he is hitting .389 (7-for-18) with one double, two home runs, five RBI, a .421 on-base percentage, a .778 slugging percentage and a 1.199 OPS...additionally, among all AL catchers (as primary position), his nine RBI on the season are third most, trailing Salvador Perez (15) and Jonah Heim (11).

JACKIE ROBINSON DAY: As has been tradition each season since 2004, MLB and Clubs are commemorating Jackie Robinson Day at ballparks throughout the league today - the anniversary of Robinson's historic MLB debut as he broke baseball's color barrier in 1947...the Twins will honor and celebrate Jackie Robinson's enduring impact on our game and society across the club's digital platforms, along with activations in the Twin Cities...Twins social platforms will share a video sponsored by Nike that features personal comments from centerfielder Byron Buxton, who reflects on Jackie's legacy and how it has influenced his own journey...on Tuesday, Twins mascot T.C. and front office staff will visit a local elementary school as part of the club's "Reading is Powerful" program - which promotes the fun of reading and shares life lessons through the telling of baseball-themed stories - to entertain and educate students on Jackie's Nine Values...additionally, Chelsey Falzone, the Twins' Manager of Youth Engagement, will be assisting MLB and USA Baseball at the 2024 Trailblazer Series.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2017, two weeks into the major league season, Ervin Santana became the first pitcher in baseball to record a complete game win, one-hitting and shutting out the White Sox at Guaranteed Rate Field, under manager Paul Molitor...the only two complete games before that in 2017 had been of the eight-inning variety, and both had resulted in losses.

LAST START: Faced the Los Angeles Dodgers for the first time in his career, after getting through a clean first three innings, gave up three runs in back-to-back innings in the fourth and fifth innings...gave up a pair of three-run home runs to James Outman and Will Smith...final line was 5.0 innings, seven hits, six runs, three walks and six strikeouts, taking his second consecutive loss.

TWO STARTS AGO: Took a loss in the series finale April 2 at Milwaukee; pitched a career-low 4.0 innings in a Twins' 3-2 defeat...worked a scoreless first inning, including a leadoff strikeout to Sal Frelick...gave up two RBI to Brice Turang and a third-inning home run to Christian Yelich...his final was 4.0 innings pitched, three earned runs, six hits, two walks and five strikeouts.

☞ Shortest start of his career, previous low was 4.1 IP on June 18, 2023 vs. the Detroit Tigers.

BULLPEN GEM: Moved to the bullpen starting on September 6 after being called up from Triple-A St. Paul Saints on September 4...Twins went on to win five out of the seven appearances he made in the month...pitched to a 1-0 record, 1.50 ERA (12.0 IP, 17 ER), one walk, 17 strikeouts and two holds.

☞ Began September with a ERA of 5.03 and ended the season with 4.63...batters hit .150 with a .191 BABIP and slugged .300...recorded two holds in the Postseason in back-to-back games vs. the Blue Jays pitching 0.2 innings with two hits, zero runs and one strikeout in the two appearances.

DEBUT VS. BALTIMORE: Facing the Orioles for the first time in his career...has made five total career start against the AL East, going 1-2, 5.64 ERA (30.1 IP, 19 ER), 29 hits, eight walks and 32 strikeouts.

☞ Set to make his third consecutive start against a team he is facing for the first time in his career...April 2 at Milwaukee, April 9 vs. Los Angeles-NL.

☞ Last appearance against an AL East opponent came in a regular season game on September 12, 2023 vs. Tampa Bay Rays...entered the game in relief of Joe Ryan in the fifth inning pitching a scoreless 2.1 innings, allowing one hit, no walks and three strikeouts...picked up his fourth win on the season.

ON THE ROAD: Set to make his third start of the season and second of the year on the road after making six starts (eight appearances) coming out of the bullpen in the later half of the 2023 season...he logged 2-2, 4.55 ERA (29.2 IP, 15 ER), five walks and 31 strikeouts...his last road win came on May 31, 2023 at Houston where he went, seven shutout innings, four hits, one walk and five strikeouts.

☞ Last road start came on April 2 at Milwaukee, picking up his first loss of the season going 4.0 innings, six hits, three runs, two walks, four strikeouts and a home run to Christian Yelich.

☞ On the road has made 10 career starts (12 total appearances)...has a 3-3 record, 4.53 ERA (57.2 IP, 29 ER), 59 hits, 17 walks and 59 strikeouts.

LEFTIES VS. RIGHTIES: Through two starts in the 2024 season, left-handed hitters have hit .348 (8-for-23), with two home runs, two walks and six strikeouts...righties have hit .313 (5-for-16) with one home run, three strikeouts and four walks...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .244/.293/.462 with eight home runs and 43 strikeouts against Varland, while righties are slashing .275/.328/.516 with 15 home runs and 59 strikeouts.

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Varland used a five-pitch mix in his two starts, including a 4-seam fastball, cutter, slider, change-up and sinker, according to Baseball Savant...used his four-seam fastball and cutter 73.1% in his first two starts of the 2024 season vs. Milwaukee and the Dodgers...below is a look at his 2024 repertoire through two start:

☞ Has thrown 13 change-ups all to right handed hitters.

STRIKEOUT NUMBER 100: Picked up his 100th career strikeout in his last start, fanning Max Muncy in the top of the fourth inning.

☞ Became the 42nd player ever born in Minnesota to record 100 strikeouts.

☞ Ranks 10th all time in strikeouts among Minnesota-born Twins players with 102.

NIGHT CAP: Has made a total of nine starts in night games throughout his career (12 total appearances)...last one came in his last start against the Dodgers...in his career he is 3-4, 4.61 ERA (56.2 IP, 29 ER), 57 hits, 15 walks and 54 strikeouts.

FIRST INNING DEALING: Through his first two starts this year, in the first inning, opponents are hitting .000 (0-for-5), two walks and two strikeouts...only inning he's pitched in where a hitter does not get on via a base hit...Joe Ryan is the only other starting pitcher to do so on the Twins.

CAREER NOTES

- Made his major league debut in game one of a doubleheader on September 7, 2022 at New York-AL, becoming the 10th player to make his major league debut for the Twins in 2022 (5th pitcher).
- Earned first major league win October 5, 2022 at Chicago-AL (5.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 5 K).
- Had allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 18-straight minor league starts from May 18-August 31, 2022, going 4-4, 2.85 ERA (94.2 IP, 30 ER) with 31 walks and 111 strikeouts in that span...his teams went 12-6.
- Went 7-4, 3.34 ERA (105.0 IP, 39 ER) with 39 walks and 119 strikeouts in 20 games (19 starts) for Wichita in 2022 – was promoted to Triple-A St. Paul on August 8.
