A WILD FINISH: Adam Frazier scampered home on a wild pitch to give the Orioles a dramatic 2-1, 10-inning victory yesterday, completing the three-game sweep of the Tigers...The O's did not have a baserunner until **Ryan Mountcastle** broke up Eduardo Rodriguez's perfect game with a two-out single in the seventh inning...**Jorge Mateo** scored from first base on an **Anthony Santander** two-out, pinch-hit double in the eighth inning to tie the game.

WHAT'S TRENDING: The O's have won six consecutive games, eight of their last nine, and 10 of their last 12...Marks the team's longest winning streak by the Orioles since a 10-game stretch from July 3-13, 2022...The 14-7 start to the season is tied for the third-best in team history (since 1954), done in 2017, 2005, 1997, 1994, 1985, 1970, and 1969, and trailing only 1966 (16-5) and 1968 (15-6).

- ⚾ Baltimore is tied for the second-best record in the AL with Texas, trailing only Tampa Bay (19-3); the O's .667 winning percentage is tied for the fourth-best in MLB behind Tampa Bay (.864), Pittsburgh (.696), and Milwaukee (.682).
- ⚾ The Birds have won four straight games at Oriole Park for the first time since winning eight in a row from June 22-July 10, 2022.
- ⚾ The six-game winning streak is the second-longest active stretch in MLB, trailing the seven in a row the Pittsburgh has won.

MAKING THEIR PITCH: The Orioles have pitched to a 1.15 ERA (7 ER/55.0 IP) during the current six-game winning streak...Starters have thrown to a 1.25 ERA (5 ER/36.0 IP), the best in MLB during the streak, while the bullpen has a 0.95 ERA (2 ER/19.0 IP), third-best in MLB, over that period...This comes after the team had a 5.36 ERA (79 ER/132.2 IP) in the first 15 games through April 15, sixth-worst in MLB in that time.

- ⚾ O's hurlers did not allow a run in 34 consecutive innings from the second inning on April 16 at Chicago-AL through the eighth inning on April 21; according to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, it marked the sixth-longest streak in club history (since 1954) and the longest since the O's tossed 45 straight scoreless frames to end the 1995 campaign...According to STATS, it was the longest streak by an AL team in a single season since Baltimore's 45-inning streak in 1995.
- ⚾ Baltimore starting pitchers had a scoreless innings streak of 29.2 from the second inning on April 16 through the sixth inning on April 22...Marks the longest such stretch by Orioles starters in a single season since a 42.0-straight scoreless stretch to end 1995.

THE CANO SHOW: Yennier Cano has set down the first 17 hitters he has faced to begin the season, including five on Saturday night...He is the first O's pitcher to do so since Fred Holdsworth set the team record (since 1954) by retiring the first 24 batters he faced in the 1976 campaign from July 17-24.

HOME SWEET HOME: The O's continue their six-game homestand tonight with the first of a three-game set against the Red Sox through Wednesday...The Orioles swept the series against the Tigers over the weekend...The O's have gone 7-3 so far at home and their .700 home winning percentage ranks second in the AL and tied for second in MLB (see chart at right)...Baltimore went 4-3 (.571) in their season-opening homestand against the Yankees (1-2) and Athletics (3-1) from April 7-13.

AGAINST THE RED SOX: Baltimore and Boston meet for three games for the second time this season after the teams squared off at Fenway Park for the opening series of the year from March 30-April 2...After Wednesday, the O's and Red Sox do not meet again until a three-game series September 8-10 in Boston before the teams wrap up the regular season with four games at Oriole Park from September 28-October 1.

LOOKING AHEAD: Following the current homestand, the Birds embark on the longest road trip of the season with four games at Detroit from April 27-30, an off day on May 1, three games at Kansas City from May 2-4, and three games at Atlanta from May 5-7.

ON THE ATTACK: Baltimore is batting .239/.332/.409 (165-for-689) with 38 doubles, two triples, 25 home runs, 108 runs scored, 104 RBI, and 92 walks to start the season...The O's rank fifth in the AL and tied for 10th in MLB in runs scored after finishing 10th in the AL and 20th in MLB with 674 runs scored in 2022...The Birds rank among AL teams in walks (1st, 92), on-base percentage (4th, .332), slugging percentage (4th, .409), and OPS (4th, .741).

- ⚾ The Orioles lead MLB with 4.11 pitches per plate appearance this season; the O's have three players in the top six in the AL in pitches per plate appearance: **Adley Rutschman** (2nd, 4.40), **Adam Frazier** (4th, 4.35), and **Anthony Santander** (6th, 4.32); **Gunnar Henderson** (12th, 4.22) and **Cedric Mullins** (20th, 4.16) also rank in the top 20 in the AL.

NEED FOR SPEED: The O's have 25 stolen bases, tied for second in MLB with the Pirates and trailing only the Guardians (28 SB) for the most in MLB this season...The 25 steals through the first 21 games of the year are the most in O's history (since 1954) to open a campaign, though the team has not attempted a stolen base in the last four games since April 19...The O's have only been caught stealing three times for an 89.3 percent success rate...**Cedric Mullins** is tied with Chicago-NL's Nico Hoerner for second in MLB with nine stolen bases, behind only Atlanta's Ronald Acuña Jr. with 12, while **Jorge Mateo** is tied for second in the AL and tied for fourth in MLB with eight steals...The duo's 17 combined stolen bases are more than 17 MLB teams while four teams have eight-or-fewer steals to start 2023.

- ⚾ Mullins' nine successful stolen bases are the most to begin a season by an Oriole since Adam Jones also swiped his first nine attempts in 2013; the last Orioles to steal 10-or-more bases successfully without being caught to begin a season are Brian Roberts and Corey Patterson, who each swiped their first 13 attempts, an O's record, to begin 2006.

BY ANY MEANS NECESSARY: The Orioles lead MLB with 26 Net Bases Gained, per *Sports Info Solutions*...Net Bases Gained is an all-encompassing baserunning stat that includes stolen bases, caught stealings, taking an extra base on hits, advancing on wild pitches, passed balls, and fly balls, and not getting thrown out on the bases... The O's have taken 33 bases on wild pitches, passed balls, balks, sacrifice flies, and defensive indifferences this season, tied for the most in MLB with the Mariners, Rangers, and Red Sox.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his fifth start of the season, third at home, and second against the Red Sox this season tonight...Made a career-high 22 appearances (21 GS) in 2022, 11 appearances at home (10 GS), and 11 on the road... Owned an 8-7 record with a 3.23 ERA (45 ER/125.1 IP) and 87 strikeouts...Made six starts of 5.0-or-more scoreless innings, tied for seventh-most in the AL... Acquired by the Orioles along with 2B Breyvic Valera, RF Yusniel Díaz, RHP Zach Pop and 3B Rylan Bannon in exchange for SS Manny Machado on July 18, 2018... Originally selected by the Dodgers in the 14th round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of UNLV.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his first win of the season on April 18 at Washington, allowing four hits with six strikeouts and a hit batter in a season-high 6.2 innings; left with a runner on first base...Also marked his first quality start of the season... Issued no walks in a start for the first time since August 27, 2022 at Houston...Went 10 games (9 GS) between no-walk outings...Threw a season-high 95 pitches, 66 season-high strikes.

AGAINST BOSTON: Making his seventh career start against the Red Sox...Owns an 0-4 record with a 7.76 ERA (23 ER/26.2 IP) through his first six career outings against Boston...Made his 2023 debut on April 1 at Fenway Park; did not factor into the decision after allowing five runs on six hits (2 HR) with one walk and three punchouts in 3.0 innings at Boston...Has pitched to a 3.48 ERA (4 ER/10.1 IP) in two career home starts against the Red Sox.

AGAINST THE AL EAST: Making his 25th career appearance (24th start) against the AL East...Sports a 2-11 record with a 5.91 ERA (74 ER/112.2 IP) through his first 24 appearances against divisional foes...Appeared in 10 games (9 GS) against the division in 2022, going 1-5 with a 3.90 ERA (24 ER/55.1 IP) with three quality starts... Did not factor into the decision in his last start against the AL East on April 7 vs. New York-AL.

HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS: Went 3-4 with a 2.95 ERA (19 ER/58.0 IP) in 10 games (9 GS) with 46 strikeouts to 14 walks at Oriole Park in 2022...The Orioles owned a 6-4 record in those games...Allowed three earned runs-or-fewer in eight of his 10 home starts...Opposing batters slashed .236/.288/.311 (50-for-212) with just four home runs against Kremer at OPACY in 2022...Owns a 4-7 record with a 4.57 ERA (55 ER/108.2 IP) with seven quality starts in 21 career appearances (20 GS) at Oriole Park.

'KREM' OF THE CROP: Had his career-high scoreless streak snapped at 22.2 innings on July 4 vs. Texas...Marks the longest scoreless streak by an Orioles starter since Mike Mussina pitched 27.0 scoreless innings from September 21, 1995 to April 2, 1996...The last Orioles pitcher with a scoreless streak of at least 22.2 innings was Steve Johnson, who tossed 25.1 scoreless frames across eight games (three starts) from August 25 to September 29, 2012.

WORLD BASEBALL CLASSIC: Pitched for Team Israel in the 2023 World Baseball Classic...Made the start in Team Israel's 3-1 win over Team Nicaragua in Pool Play on March 12 at loanDepot park in Miami (4.0 IP, 3 H, BB, K)...Was the youngest player (20) on Team Israel's 2017 WBC roster...Kremer has dual Israeli-American citizenship and became the first Israeli drafted by an MLB team in 2016.

2022 HIGHLIGHTS: Made his second Opening Day Roster...Placed on the 10-day Injured List (left oblique strain) on April 11 (retroactive to April 8)...Tossed 9.0 scoreless innings across three rehab starts with Triple-A Norfolk and Double-A Bowie before being reinstated on June 5...Tossed his first career shutout and complete game on September 23 vs. Houston, allowing four hits and two walks with six strikeouts over a career-high 9.0 innings; marked the first shutout by an O's pitcher since LHP John Means threw a no-hitter on May 5, 2021 at Seattle; was one of 16 players in MLB to throw a shutout in 2022 and joined RHP Jordan Lyles (9/21 vs. DET) as the only O's pitchers with a complete game during the season.... Made the start for the O's in their 5-3 win at the Little League Classic on August 21 vs. Boston; did not factor in the decision after allowing one run on five hits with two walks and four strikeouts over 5.1 innings... Allowed 11 home runs in 125.1 innings for a 0.79 HR/9, the ninth-lowest in the AL (min. 125.0 IP), compared to 17 home runs in 53.2 innings in 2021 for a 2.85 HR/9, the highest in the majors (min. 50.0 IP).

Bradish will make his third start of the season, first at home, and sixth career start against the Red Sox tomorrow...Earned his first win of the season on April 19 at Washington, allowing five hits with one walk and six strikeouts in 6.0 scoreless innings...Marked his first start since being placed on the 15-day Injured List (right foot contusion) on April 5 (retroactive to 4/4)...Threw 92 pitches, 59 strikes...Owns an 0-3 record with a 7.54 ERA (19 ER/22.2 IP) in his five career starts against Boston...Did not factor into the decision in his last start against the Red Sox on September 27, 2022 at Fenway Park.
