THE TWINS: After completing their six-game homestand with a record of 4-2 (2-1 vs. Detroit and 2-1 vs. Houston), the Twins began their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with a win on the Southside against the White Sox Monday night...today, they will play the second and third games of the series at Guaranteed Rate Field — their final games here in 2024...after today's games, they will travel to the Bay Area for an off-day tomorrow, then play the Giants at Oracle Park for three games over the weekend.

# Minnesota has gone 45-26 in its last 71 games since April 22, tied with Philadelphia (45-24) for the most wins in baseball since that date.

# Twins are at a high water mark of 13 games over .500, their best since being 13 games over through games of September 30, 2023...last time they were 14 games over was through games of September 28, 2019, when they were 41 games over (101-60).

# Twins have gone 4-0 in doubleheader games this season, sweeping both games in Detroit on April 13 and both games at home against Oakland on June 16.

MONDAY NIGHT LASER SHOW: The Twins beat the White Sox Monday night at Guaranteed Rate Field by a score of 8-6 in 11 innings, making them 4-3 in extras this season...Chris Paddack was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched...the Twins used a season-high seven relievers, combining to pitch 6.0 innings with three earned runs allowed...the offense recorded 15 hits as each player in the starting lineup had at least one...Byron Buxton had three of the hits, doubling twice, his 17th and 18th of the season...Brooks Lee and Matt Wallner both had two hits and two RBI... Wallner hit his second home run of the season, a 116.7 mph shot to rightfield.

WEARING OUT THE SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the ninth and 10th of 13 games this season... the Twins are 8-0 vs. the Sox this season and have already secured the season series... Minnesota has won nine straight and has gone 15-1 in its last 16 against the White Sox. dating back to May 4, 2023.

♣ Minnesota has won nine consecutive games against Chicago, dating back to September 17, 2023... it's their longest streak against the Sox since winning nine straight from September 14, 2010-July 8, 2011... Twins all-time longest vs. Chicago is 10, from September 18, 1965-June 12, 1966... it's the longest active streak against any opponent and longest since beating Baltimore in 16 straight from March 31, 2018-May 31, 2021.

♣ Since 2015, the Twins have gone 95-69 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.

♣ Since 2019, no opponent has hit more home runs at Guaranteed Rate Field than the Twins, hitting 85 home runs (next: Kansas City and Cleveland, both with 49).

♣ Sox Game 2 starter Drew Thorpe and Brooks Lee were teammates at Cal Poly San Luis Obispo from 2020-22... Lee was selected by the Twins eighth overall in 2022 as Thorpe was selected 53 spots later at 61st overall (2nd round) by the Yankees.

SUMMER BREEZE, MAKES ME FEEL FINE: Since June 9, the Twins rank near the top of baseball in several offensive categories...below are their numbers (and MLB rank below) since that date:

YOU'RE UNBE-LEE-VABLE: Brooks Lee has his fafely in all six games to start his career, going 11-for-24 (.458) with one double, one home run, eight RBI and one walk to begin his major league career. Brooks' 11 hits through six career games are second-most in club history for a player's first six career games, trailing Kirby Puckett's 14 in 1984...Brooks' eight RBI through six games are most in club history.

**STREAK PERFORMANCE**: The Twins have homered in a club record 26-straight games, since June 10...during the streak, 13 different Twins have homered...the streak is the longest in baseball for 2024...the last team to homer in at least 26 in a row was Atlanta, which homered in 28 straight from June 10-July 15, 2023.

**CUZ TONIGHT BABY, I WANNA GET STREAKY WITH YOU:** Jose Miranda (12) and Carlos Correa (10) both enter tonight with an active hitting streak...Miranda's is tied for second-longest active streak in baseball and Correa's is tied for fourth...this gives the Twins five streaks this season of double-digits: Kepler - 14 (4/27-5/12), Miranda (current), Castro - 11 (6/16-28), Castro - 10 (4/24-5/4) and Correa (current)...only the Braves (6 streaks), Astros (5 streaks), Royals (5 streaks) and Padres (5 streaks) have had as many.

NOT AT THE TABLE, CARLOS: All-Star Carlos Correa enters today with a .303 batting average, fifth-best in the AL, trailing Steven Kwan (.363), Bobby Witt Jr. (.324), Jose Altuve (.309) and Aaron Judge (.308)...his average has not dipped below .300 since he was hitting .298 the morning of June 16...in his last 29 games, he is hitting .381 (43-for-113) with a 1.082 OPS and 24 RBI...additionally, he enters today with a season-long 10-game hitting streak, six short of his career-high of 16, done April 19-May 6, 2019 with Houston.

WHAT MORE CAN WE JOSE: Jose Miranda is hitting .381 (53-for-139) with 14 doubles, one triple, five home runs, 31 RBI, a .422 on-base percentage, a .604 slugging percentage and a 1.026 OPS in his last 40 games, since May 24...Miranda's 12-game hitting streak is the longest of his career, passing his previous high of seven, done in 2022...the longest for a Twin this season is 14 by Kepler, from April 27-May 12.

**IS SOMEONE GETTING THE BEST OF YOU:** One win today would give the Twins their 19th series victory...they enter play today 18-9-2 in series play this season, going 9-5-0 at home and 9-4-2 on the road...a win would give them their 18th series win in their last 23 tries since April 25...Twins are 4-0-0 in their last four series vs. the White Sox.

**BROCKSTAR ENERGY:** Reliever Brock Stewart began his rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul last night at Louisville, pitching 1.0 scoreless inning with two walks and one strikeout, throwing 21 pitches...he topped out at 96.9 mph and averaged 95.3 mph on his fastball...Beef Stew has missed the club's last 61 games with right shoulder tendinitis, last appearing on May 1 at Chicago-AL.
