- Making 18th start of season and 75th of career. Last pitched on July 4 vs. Detroit, allowing three runs (1 ER) on seven hits in 6.0 innings, with no walks and eight strikeouts hits (1 HR), with no walks...earned his eighth victory in a 12-3 Twins win. Faced Chicago-AL on May 1 at Guaranteed Rate Field and earned the win, allowing four runs on six hits (1 HR) in 6.0 innings, with no walks and three strikeouts.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on July 4th, earned his eighth win, allowing three runs (1 ER) on seven hits (1 HR) in 6.0 innings, with zero walks and eight strikeouts...allowed a solo home run in the first inning and two unearned runs - after a dropped third strike/passed ball - in the second...threw 103 pitches, one shy of his career high (104, 5/12/24 at TOR and 8/4/23 vs. AZ)...

TWO STARTS AGO: Made the start on June 28 at Seattle, a 3-2 Twins loss in extra innings...didn't factor into the decision; started his outing by tossing a 40 scoreless innings until allowing a RBI double to Josh Rojas in the fifth inning, his only run allowed...permitted one run on two hits, three walks and nine strikeouts in 6.0 innings.

LAST FOUR STARTS: In his last four starts, Ober has gone 3-0, 1.65 ERA (27.1 IP, 5 ER), five walks, 35 strikeouts, a 0.88 WHIP and a .194 (19-for-98) opponent batting average...in five June starts he went 2-1, 3.19 ERA (31.0 IP, 11 ER), 11 walks, 34 strikeouts, a 1.06 WHIP and a .202 (22-for-109) opponent batting average.

VS. CHICAGO-AL: Making his 12th career start against Chicago-AL today; also facing them for the second time this season. In one start this year vs. Chicago-AL he is 1-0, 6.00 ERA (6.0 IP, 4 ER), one walk, three strikeouts, a 1.00 WHIP and a .261 (6-for-23) opponent batting average.

ON THE ROAD: Making his 10th road start of the season today...in previous nine, has gone 4-3 with a 4.69 ERA (55.2 IP, 29 ER), 14 walks, 55 strikeouts, a 1.08 WHIP and a .224 (46-for-205) opponent batting average...in seven home starts, he is 4-1, 3.29 ERA (38.1 IP, 14 ER), nine walks, 45 strikeouts, a 1.12 WHIP and a .234 (34-for-145) opponent batting average.

REVERSE SPLITS: On July 4, Detroit left-handed hitters went 3-for-12, with a home run and three strikeouts against Ober, while righties went 4-for-14, a double with five strikeouts. Lefties have a 27.9 percent whiff rate and 86.5 mph average exit velocity vs. Ober, while righties a 28.2 percent whiff rate and 88.7 mph average exit velocity.

THE ARSENAL: Has used a five-pitch mix thus far in 2024, per Baseball Savant...uses 4-seamer and cutter against both left- and right-handed hitters...predominantly throws changeup and curveball to lefties, slider to righties. Here's his pitch usage through 17 starts:

DAYTIME DOMINANCE: In nine daytime starts, Ober is 6-1 with a 3.66 ERA (51.2 IP, 21 ER), six walks, 54 strikeouts and a .231 (45-for-195) opponent batting average, compared to 2-3 with a 4.68 ERA (42.1 IP, 22 ER), 17 walks, 46 strikeouts and a .226 (35-for-155) BAA in eight night games.

GAME 2 STARTER - RHP PABLO LÓPEZ (2024: 8-7, 5.18 ERA // CAREER: 47-46, 4.02 ERA)

Right-handed pitcher Pablo López is set to start Game 2 of today's doubleheader - and the three-game series finale - at Chicago-AL...last pitched on July 5 vs. Houston, took his team-leading seventh loss in a 13-12 Twins loss...tossed 5.0 innings, allowing six runs on eight hits, with two walks and six strikeouts...set to face Chicago-AL for the second time this season and fifth time in his career; is 0-1, 4.56 ERA (23.2 IP, 12 ER), four walks and 32 strikeouts in his prior four outings...making his 10th start on the road this season, in previous nine starts he is 5-3, 4.67 ERA (52.0 IP, 27 ER), 14 walks, 67 strikeouts, a 1.04 WHIP and a .207 (40-for-193) opponent batting average.

CAREER NOTES

- Made Postseason debut in 2023 ALDS vs. Houston, allowing six runs on eight hits (4 HR) in 4.1 total innings between Games 1 and 3. In 2023, made 26 regular season starts for the Twins, going 8-6 with a 3.43 ERA (144.1 IP, 55 ER), 29 walks, 146 strikeouts and 12 quality starts. In 2022, made 11 starts for the Twins along with four rehab starts in the minors, going 2-3, 3.21 ERA (56.0 IP, 20 ER) with 11 walks and 51 strikeouts for Minnesota. Set career highs in innings pitched (7.1) and strikeouts (10) in 4-0 win over Chicago-AL on September 27, 2022. Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL. Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks and 117 strikeouts in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota. In 2020, spent spring training on minor league side of Lee County Sports Complex in Fort Myers, FL...was not part of Twins' 60-man Player Pool for season. Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020. Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, High-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola. Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA in 2019 and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961. Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week twice during the 2019 season: once for Fort Myers on August 4 (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 6 H in 1 start) and again on August 25 with Pensacola (1-0, 7.0 IP, 0 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 12 K). In 2018, was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week in consecutive weeks: July 7, going 1-0 with 7.0 shutout innings and 12 strikeouts vs. Wisconsin for Low-A Cedar Rapids Kernels, and again July 14, going 1-0 with two runs allowed in 7.0 innings and 10 strikeouts vs. Fort Wayne...became first ever Twin to win the award twice in a season. Selected by Twins in 12th round of 2017 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Seth Moir...originally selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 23rd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, but elected to return to the College of Charleston. Attended College of Charleston from 2014-17, missing the 2015 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow...compiled a 24-9 record with a 2.91 ERA and 254 strikeouts in 259.2 innings over the course of his collegiate career.
