YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles beat the Rangers, 6-5, to clinch a series victory...**Heston Kjerstad** hit his first career grand slam with a go-ahead blast in the fifth inning...**Anthony Santander** homered for the 13th time in June...**Cade Povich** earned his first win in the majors after allowing two runs in 5.0 innings...**Craig Kimbrel** secured his 19th save of the year, tied for second in the AL, and 436th of his career, most among active players and one behind Francisco Rodriguez for fourth in MLB history.

SWEEP DREAMS: The O's are in search of their sixth series sweep of the season, joining June 7-10 at Tampa Bay (4 G), May 23-26 at Chicago-AL (4 G), May 3-5 at Cincinnati (3 G), April 15-17 vs. Minnesota (3 G), and April 9-11 at Boston (3 G).

☞ A win today would give Baltimore its third four-game sweep of the year; the last time the Orioles had three four-game sweeps in the same season was 1976, when they swept four-gamers from September 21-23 at New York-AL, September 11-13 at Milwaukee, and June 17-20 at Texas.

☞ The Birds have not swept a four-game series at home since July 7-10, 2022 vs. Los Angeles-AL.

ALL-STAR VOTING: MLB announced the finalists for the 2024 MLB All-Star Game on Thursday...Phase 2 of voting, which began today at 12:00 p.m. ET at MLB.com/vote, features the top two vote-getters at each position in each League (and the top six outfielders in the NL; next four outfielders in the AL after leading vote-getter Aaron Judge) based on vote totals from Phase 1, which ran from June 5-27; fans can vote once per day, as opposed to five times in Phase 1...Six O's advanced as finalists at their respective positions...Baltimore has not had multiple starters in an All-Star Game since **Adam Jones** and **Nelson Cruz** in 2014.

☞ **Adley Rutschman** led AL catchers and ranked third in the AL with 2,791,952 votes; he will match up with Kansas City's Salvador Perez; he's seeking his second All-Star nod (2023) and first starting assignment and would become the third O's backstop to start an All-Star Game, along with **Gus Triandos** in 1958 and 1959, and **Terry Kennedy** in 1987; **Matt Wieters** was voted to start in 2014, but did not play (injury).

☞ **Gunnar Henderson** led AL shortstops with 2,664,120 votes; he will face Kansas City's Bobby Witt Jr.; he's vying for his first career All-Star selection and would be the first Orioles shortstop selected to the Midsummer Classic since **Manny Machado** in 2018.

☞ **Ryan Mountcastle** led AL first basemen with 2,296,697 votes; he meets Toronto's Vladimir Guerrero Jr.; he's seeking his first All-Star nod and would be the first O's first baseman selected to the Midsummer Classic since **Chris Davis** in 2013.

☞ **Jordan Westburg** ranked second among AL third basemen with 1,483,679 votes, behind Cleveland's Jose Ramirez (2,336,628); he's seeking his first All-Star nod and would be the first Orioles third baseman selected to the Midsummer Classic since **Machado** in 2016.

☞ **Anthony Santander** finished fourth among AL outfielders with 1,478,034 votes behind New York-AL's Aaron Judge (3,425,309) and Juan Soto (3,000,121), and Cleveland's Steven Kwan (1,723,074), and ahead of Houston's Kyle Tucker (1,426,948); he's looking for his first All-Star selection and would be the first fan-elected Baltimore outfielder since **Jones** in 2014.

WHAT'S TRENDING: The Orioles have won four games in a row after dropping their previous five, the team's longest losing streak since May 13-18, 2022 (6 G)...At 53-30 (.639), the Birds own the third-best record in MLB, behind the Guardians (.642, 52-29) and Phillies (.651, 54-29)...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 154-91 (.629), the best winning percentage and most wins in the majors during that time...The O's are 237-170 (.582) since the start of 2022, the second-best record in the AL and fourth-best in MLB behind the Astros (.584, 237-169), Braves (.620, 251-154), and Dodgers (.645, 263-145).

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles lead MLB with 139 home runs and are one of four clubs with 100+ homers this season, along with the Yankees (122), Dodgers (112), and Mets (101)...The Birds have homered in 27 of the last 28 games, including a club-record 22 consecutive games from June 1-23.

☞ The O's have hit 60 home runs in June, the most homers in a month in franchise history; they are the third team with at least 60 in a month in MLB history, joining the 2023 Braves, who hit 61 in June, and the 2019 Yankees, who hit 74 in August.

☞ The 139 homers are the most through 83 games in team history; Baltimore is the 10th MLB team since at least 1901 with 139+ home runs in the first 83 games of a season and the first since Atlanta hit 158 last season; all such occurrences in MLB have come since 1999 with seven coming since 2018.

☞ The O's are 46-20 this year when homering, 36-6 when hitting multiple home runs, 19-5 when hitting at least three, and 5-2 when hitting four.

☞ Baltimore has an MLB-best seven players with at least 10 home runs: **Gunnar Henderson** (26), **Anthony Santander** (22), **Adley Rutschman** (15), **Jordan Westburg** (13), **Colton Cowser** (12), **Ryan Mountcastle** (11), and **Ryan O'Hearn** (10); no other team has more than five such players this season.

☞ Henderson and Santander are one of three duos in MLB with at least 20 homers each so far this season, along with Cleveland's José Ramirez and Josh Naylor, and New York-AL's Aaron Judge and Juan Soto.

☞ The Birds lead MLB with nine leadoff homers this year; **Gunnar Henderson** has eight of those, the most in MLB and tied for the second-most in a single season in Orioles history with **Cedric Mullins** (2021), trailing only **Brady Anderson** (12, 1996).

TOP GUNN: **Gunnar Henderson** owns a career-best 36-game on-base streak since May 22, the longest active streak in MLB and the longest by an O's batter since **Nick Markakis'** 38-game streak from July 5 to August 18, 2009...New York-AL's Aaron Judge had a 37-game on-base streak from May 2 to June 12, the longest in the big leagues this year, and Juan Soto had a 39-gamer that ended on April 2, 2024, but that started on August 26, 2023 with San Diego...For Henderson, 35 of those have been as the starting shortstop, the longest such streak in team history ahead of a 30-gamer by **Cal Ripken Jr.** from June 26 to July 28, 1986.

☞ He is tied for second in MLB with 26 homers with Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani, trailing New York-AL's Aaron Judge (30)...He's among MLB leaders in a variety of categories (see box at right).

☞ Since May 28, he's slashing .344/.437/.664 (42-for-122) with 12 doubles, nine homers, 33 runs, 21 RBI, 19 walks, one hit-by-pitch, and six stolen bases in 30 games while recording a hit in 27 of those; he leads MLB during that time in hits, extra-base hits (21) and runs.

☞ He leads MLB with 73 runs scored this season, the most runs through the first 83 team games of a season in O's history; the only players in club history to lead the AL in runs are **Frank Robinson** in 1966 (122) and **Cal Ripken, Jr.** in 1982 (121); Robinson is the only player in Orioles history to lead MLB in runs, when he tied with Atlanta's Felipe Alou.

☞ Had a career-long 14-game hitting streak from June 6-21, the longest hitting streak by an O's batter since **Anthony Santander** had a 16-game streak from July 16 to August 6, 2022.

SUMMER SLUGGER: **Anthony Santander** leads MLB with 13 home runs this month, the most in June in team history...He is tied with **Nelson Cruz** (13 in May 2014) and **Frank Robinson** (13 in July 1966), and trails **Jim Gentile** (15 in August 1961) for the most home runs hit in a single month by an Orioles batter.

☞ Santander's 83 home runs since the start of 2022 are the most by a switch hitter, third in the AL, and 11th in MLB; the only AL players to hit more in that span are Houston's Yordan Alvarez (84) and New York-AL's Aaron Judge (129).

MONTHLY DUES: The Orioles have clinched a winning record in June, the team's ninth consecutive winning month (min. 10 games played) since the start of 2023, the longest streak by the O's since May 1982 through September 1983 (11), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*...The current stretch is the longest active streak in the majors; Atlanta had its streak of 11 straight winning months since June 2022 snapped with a 13-14 record in May.

FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME: The Orioles wrap up a seven-game homestand tonight...Tonight's game will be ESPN's *Sunday Night Baseball*...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, this will be Baltimore's 35th appearance on *Sunday Night Baseball* (15-19)...The Birds have clinched a winning homestand after going 1-2 against the Guardians earlier this week and 3-0 vs. the Rangers so far this weekend.

AGAINST TEXAS: The Orioles and Rangers complete their four-game series tonight at Camden Yards...It's the first meeting between the teams since the 2023 ALDS, which Texas swept on its way to the franchise's first World Series title...Baltimore travels to Arlington for a three-game set after the All-Star break from July 19-21.

☞ Since the start of 2021, the O's are 16-6 (.727) against the Rangers during the regular season, including a perfect 6-0 in 2022.

☞ Baltimore is 277-221-1 all time against the Rangers since the Washington Senators moved to Texas in 1972; the .556 winning percentage is the best among current AL teams and the second-best in MLB behind the .558 mark against the Brewers during that time (min. 100 G).

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his 14th start and 16th appearance of the season tonight against Texas...Had a career-high 22.2-inning scoreless streak from April 15 to May 10 earlier this season...Made his fifth Opening Day roster... Began the 2023 campaign in the starting rotation with the big-league club; had four stints with the Orioles after being optioned to Triple-A Norfolk on April 14, May 21, and September 13; recalled from the Tides on May 16, June 10, and October 1. Owned a 1-4 record with a 4.81 ERA (31 ER/58.0 IP) in 12 starts and pitched to a 3.26 ERA (7 ER/19.1 IP) in 12 relief appearances with the O's... Did not appear on the ALDS roster... Acquired by the Orioles along with RHP Kyle Virbitsky from the Oakland Athletics in exchange for INF Darell Hernaiz on January 26, 2023.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his fourth loss of the season on June 25 vs. Cleveland after allowing eight runs (4 ER) on 10 hits (1 HR) with one strikeout in 4.0 innings...Has allowed 17 runs in his last three starts after giving up 18 in his 10 prior starts combined...Surrendered a 116.6 mph double to José Ramirez in the first inning, the hardest hit-hit ball off Irvin in his career, per Statcast... Threw 71 pitches, 46 strikes.

AGAINST THE RANGERS: Owns a lifetime 4-2 record and a 3.04 ERA (16 ER/47.1 IP) across eight career starts against Texas...Allowed two runs (1 ER) on three hits and one walk with eight strikeouts across 7.0 innings in his last start against the Rangers in Oakland on July 22, 2022 (w/OAK).

AGAINST THE AL WEST: Owns a 10-19 record with a 4.08 ERA (98 ER/216.1 IP) in 40 career appearances (38 GS) against the AL West; factored into the decision in 28 of his first 33 appearances but only once in his last seven...Opponents are slashing .260/.306/.400 (219-for-843)...Has gone 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER/9.0 IP) in two outings (1 GS) against the division this season...The Orioles are 6-0 across the last two seasons when he appears in games against AL West teams.

HOME SWEET HOME: Slated to make his ninth home start of the season...Has pitched to a 3-3 record with a 3.38 ERA (17 ER/45.1 IP) in his nine prior outings (8 GS) at Oriole Park this year...Has held visiting opponents to two runs or fewer in five of his eight starts at home.

DAY 'N NITE: Scheduled to make his eighth night start of the season...Has gone 3-2 with a 4.71 ERA (19 ER/36.1 IP) across his seven night starts compared to 3-1 with a 2.55 ERA (10 ER/35.1 IP) across his six day starts this year.

LOVING LEFTIES: Has held lefties to a .194/.216/.264 (14-for-72) slash line through his 15 outings this season compared to .304/.340/.494 (72-for-237) against righties.

WHAT A RELIEF: Irvin has made two relief appearances for the O's this season, pitching to a 5.06 ERA (3 ER/5.1 IP) in those games...Credited with his second career hold in his first relief appearance of the season on May 19 vs. Seattle (2.0 IP)...Worked a season-high 3.1 innings of relief on May 22 at St. Louis, allowing a season-high-tying five runs (3 ER) on six hits (1 HR) with two punchouts.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Tossed a career-high 4.0 innings of relief on July 18 vs. Los Angeles-NL...Did not allow more than one earned run in five straight starts from June 26-August 19, the longest such streak of his career...Pitched for Norfolk in Game Two of the International League Championship Series on September 27 vs. Durham; tossed 3.0 scoreless innings with two hits and five strikeouts.
