LEADING THINGS OFF: Andrew McCutchen homered leading off the game for the second straight night on Tuesday...Prior to McCutchen, Adam Frazier was the last Pirate to hit a leadoff home run in back-to-back games after doing so on September 1 and 3rd, 2019, at Colorado and vs. Miami...The Pirates have now hit 192 leadoff home runs in 138 seasons as a member of the National League.

<u>ABOUT TONIGHT'S STARTER:</u> Lefthander Josh Fleming will become the seventh different pitcher to start a game this season for the Pirates...Fleming made three starts in 2023 while pitching for Tampa Bay (his last one came on May 28 against the Dodgers) and a total of 22 in his career.

THE BOOK ON FLEMING: Josh Fleming has recorded a 71.0 percent ground ball rate in his first 10 outings this season with the Pirates...That's the third-best ground ball rate among all relievers in MLB...Fleming's 1.74 ERA is the seventh-lowest among left-handed relievers in the National League (Milwaukee's Bryan Hudson has the lowest dividing lett indicate relevers in the 98th percentile in average exit velocity (82.1 miles-per-hour), 98th percentile in hard hit rate (22.6 percent) and 94th percentile in chase rate (36.7 percent) according to Baseball Savant.

ORDINARY AVERAGE GUYS: The Pirates allowed a season-low three hits in Tuesday's game against the Brewers...Coming into today, Pittsburgh's pitching staff has the ninth-lowest batting average against (.224) in all of MLB (the Tigers have the lowest batting average against at .207).

Gregory Polanco WINNING STARTS HERE: Pittsburgh's starting rotation has recorded a 3.64 ERA (136.0ip/55er) this season...That's the Craig Wilson second-lowest ERA among all National League teams and eighthbest in MLB...Philadelphia's starting rotation has a NL-best 2.22 ERA.

COMING THROUGH IN A PINCH: Connor Joe recorded his third pinch hit of the season last night with his run-scoring single in the sixth inning...Joe is now 3-for-3 in pinch-hit situations this season (tied for the Major League lead)...Since the beginning of last season, Joe is tied for the third-most pinch hits (eight) in all of MLB (Harold Ramirez leads with eleven)...As a team the Pirates are tied for the fourth-best batting average (.333), fourth-most RBI (four) and tied for most home runs (two) in MLB in pinch-hit situations.

IFEEL GOOD: Colin Holderman made his fifth straight scoreless appearance (4.2ip) Tuesday night after allowing one earned run in 0.2 inning in his season debut on April 11...Holderman began the season on the 15-day injured list due to illness...During his current five-game stretch, Holderman has allowed just one hit in 15 at-bats (.067 batting average against).

FOUR YOUR INFORMATION: The Pirates are the only team this season that has not lost when scoring four-plus runs...The Phillies are the only team to have one loss (14-1)...Special thanks to the Elias Sports Bureau.

CRUZING FOR A BREWZING: Oneil Cruz went 1-for-3 Tuesday night...Cruz has now hit safely in nine of his last 10 games against the Brewers, going 14-for-37 (.378) with three doubles, four home runs and 14 RBI...Since the beginning of 2022, Cruz' 18 RBI against the Brewers are tied for the third-most by any player along with Ian Happ...The only two players with more are Nolan Arenado (22) and Paul Goldschmidt (19).

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

April 24, 1921: Babe Adams won his first game of the season after going the distance in Pittsburgh's 7-2 win against the Reds. Rabbit Maranville led the way for the Pirates by going 3-for-5 with a pair of RBI. Carson Bigbee, George Cutshaw, Cotton Tierney and Charlie Grimm also added a pair of hits in the win.
