MILWAUKEE BREWERS (14-8) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (13-11)

APRIL 24, 2024 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA - 6:40 EDT - GAME #25/HOME #11

RHP BRYSE WILSON (2-0, 3.29 ERA) vs. LHP JOSH FLEMING (1-0, 1.74 ERA)

THE PIRATES:...have won back-to-back games following their season-high six-game losing streak...Improved to 4-1 in one-run games with last night's win...Rank 11th overall in MLB with 209 strikeouts (Philadelphia's pitching staff leads all of MLB with 226 punchouts)...Were swept by the Red Sox in the first three games of this current homestand this past weekend...Began the season 5-0 for the first time since 1983...Won nine of their first 11 games before losing nine of their next 11 from 4/9-21...Are in a stretch that has the team playing 13 straight days before their next scheduled off day on 5/2 coming back from the west coast.

LEADING THINGS OFF: Andrew McCutchen homered leading off the game for the second straight night on Tuesday...Prior to McCutchen, Adam Frazier was the last Pirate to hit a leadoff home run in back-to-back games after doing so on September 1 and 3rd, 2019, at Colorado and vs. Miami...The Pirates have now hit 192 leadoff home runs in 138 seasons as a member of the National League.

ABOUT TONIGHT'S STARTER: Lefthander Josh Fleming will become the seventh different pitcher to start a game this season for the Pirates...Fleming made three starts in 2023 while pitching for Tampa Bay (his last one came on May 28 against the Dodgers) and a total of 22 in his career.

THE BOOK ON FLEMING: Josh Fleming has recorded a 71.0 percent ground ball rate in his first 10 outings this season with the Pirates...That's the third-best ground ball rate among all relievers in MLB...Fleming's 1.74 ERA is the seventh-lowest among left-handed relievers in the National League (Milwaukee's Bryan Hudson has the lowest at 0.77)...Fleming ranks in the 98th percentile in average exit velocity (82.1 miles-per-hour), 98th percentile in hard hit rate (22.6 percent) and 94th percentile in chase rate (36.7 percent) according to Baseball Savant.

ORDINARY AVERAGE GUYS: The Pirates allowed a season-low three hits in Tuesday's game against the Brewers...Coming into today, Pittsburgh's pitching staff has the ninth-lowest batting average against (.224) in all of MLB (the Tigers have the lowest batting average against at .207).

WINNING STARTS HERE: Pittsburgh's starting rotation has recorded a 3.64 ERA (136.0ip/55er) this season...That's the second-lowest ERA among all National League teams and eighth-best in MLB...Philadelphia's starting rotation has a NL-best 2.22 ERA.

COMING THROUGH IN A PINCH: Connor Joe recorded his third pinch hit of the season last night with his run-scoring single in the sixth inning...Joe is now 3-for-3 in pinch-hit situations this season (tied for the Major League lead)...Since the beginning of last season, Joe is tied for the third-most pinch hits (eight) in all of MLB (Harold Ramirez leads with eleven)...As a team the Pirates are tied for the fourth-best batting average (.333), fourth-most RBI (four) and tied for most home runs (two) in MLB in pinch-hit situations.

I FEEL GOOD: Colin Holderman made his fifth straight scoreless appearance (4.2ip) Tuesday night after allowing one earned run in 0.2 inning in his season debut on April 11...Holderman began the season on the 15-day injured list due to illness...During his current five-game stretch, Holderman has allowed just one hit in 15 at-bats (.067 batting average against).

FOUR YOUR INFORMATION: The Pirates are the only team this season that has not lost when scoring four-plus runs...The Phillies are the only team to have one loss (14-1)...Special thanks to the Elias Sports Bureau.

CRUZZING FOR A BREWZZING: Oneil Cruz went 1-for-3 Tuesday night...Cruz has now hit safely in nine of his last 10 games against the Brewers, going 14-for-37 (.378) with three doubles, four home runs and 14 RBI...Since the beginning of 2022, Cruz' 18 RBI against the Brewers are tied for the third-most by any player along with Ian Happ...The only two players with more are Nolan Arenado (22) and Paul Goldschmidt (19).

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

April 24, 1921: Babe Adams won his first game of the season after going the distance in Pittsburgh's 7-2 win against the Reds. Rabbit Maranville led the way for the Pirates by going 3-for-5 with a pair of RBI. Carson Bigbee, George Cutshaw, Cotton Tierney and Charlie Grimm also added a pair of hits in the win.

MITCH KELLER: The 28-year-old righthander will make his sixth start of the season tomorrow afternoon in the finale of this four-game series and seven-game homestand...Was charged with his second loss (6.0ip/4er) in his last start Saturday against the Red Sox...Won back-to-back starts on 4/8 vs. Detroit and 4/14 at Philadelphia...Signed a five-year contract extension through 2028 on 2/23...Has made 36 straight starts of at least 5.0 innings (his last start of fewer than 5.0 innings came on Opening Day 2023 against the Reds)...Has a 3.09 ERA (102.0ip/35er) in 16 starts at PNC Park since the beginning of last season.

vs. MILWAUKEE: 0-4 with a 6.23 ERA (30.1ip/21er) in six career starts...Went 0-2 in two starts last year...Allowed five runs in 4.0 innings while losing a 5-0 decision at American Family Field on 6/17...He also lost a 14-1 decision (5.0ip/8r) to Adrian Houser at Milwaukee on 8/3...He went 0-1 in three starts in 2022.
