RAYS REPORT—The Rays continue a 12-game, 14-day road trip against the Angels (2-1), Mariners (0-2, one to play), Athletics (3G) and Giants (3G) today in Seattle...are 3-4 in their last seven games, but have lost eight of 11, 12 of 16, 18 of 25 and 26 of their last 37 games...are 4-11 so far on a stretch of 19 road games in a 22-game span (July 25-Aug. 17)...started the season 21-26, went an MLB-best 25-9 from May 20-June 26 and are an MLB-worst 11-26 since June 27...are fourth in the AL East for the 30th consecutive day, a season-high-tying 11.0 GB the division-leading Blue Jays and 5.5 GB the Astros for the AL's third and final Wild Card spot...including off days and the All-Star break, they have spent two days in first, 37 in second, 32 in third, 60 in fourth and four in fifth.

★ The Rays scored first for their season-high-tying fifth straight game (3x, last: June 24-28), but allowed six unanswered runs in last night's 7-4 setback...they held the Mariners to 2-for-15 with RISP, but both hits were home runs.

★ The defeat secured the Rays fifth loss in their last six series and 10th in their last 12...it also marks their seventh series loss in their last eight road sets.

★ The Rays have homered in the 1st inning in three straight games for the second time this season, joining April 12-14...their last longer streak was four games from May 21-25, 2022...they last scored in the opening frame in four consecutive games, regardless of how the runs came across, from June 14-18, 2024.

★ Additionally, the Rays are looking to score first in six straight games for the first time since a nine-game streak from June 14-23, 2024.

★ Tampa Bay is 3-13 in its last 16 road games and 5-18 in its last 23 since June 29, the worst mark in the majors over that span.

★ The Rays have led in three straight and eight of their last 12 losses...their 27 blown lead losses overall are seventh most in the AL/11th most in the majors.

★ Since the All-Star break, Rays pitchers lead the majors in strikeout rate (25.4%), and their 191 SO are tied with the Rangers for second in MLB behind the Mariners (207SO).

WHAT'S AT STAKE—The Rays need to win today to avoid:

★ Falling a season-high-tying five games below .500 (4x, last: 21-26 entering play May 20).
★ Becoming the fifth AL club to be swept six times (or more), joining the White Sox (10), Angels (7), Athletics (7) and Guardians (6).

★ Their ninth sweep at the hands of the Mariners and seventh on the road...they were last swept by Seattle from June 17-20, 2021 at T-Mobile Park in a series that featured three walk-off losses.

HEAT CHECK—Joe Boyle threw 20 pitches at 100.0 mph or faster last night, the most by any Ray in a single outing in the pitch-tracking era (since 2008), surpassing **Diego Castillo** on Sept. 14, 2018 vs. OAK (11)...it was the sixth-highest total by any starting pitcher in the majors this season, and only two hurlers have reached or exceeded the mark: CIN **Hunter Greene** (3x) and MIL **Jacob Misiorowski** (2x)...entering the outing, Boyle had hit triple digits only three times this season and 42 times in his career...he became the ninth starter in the pitch-tracking era to touch 100.0 mph 20 times or more in an outing, joining Greene (12x), Misiorowski (2x), **Jordan Hicks** (2x), **Noah Syndergaard** (2x), **Jacob DeGrom** (1x), **Nathan Eovaldi** (1x), **Bobby Miller** (1x) and **James Paxton** (1x).

★ Boyle averages 98.8 mph on his four-seam fastball, the third-fastest mark among major league starters (min. 100 4SFB thrown as starter) behind Greene (99.3 mph) and Misiorowski (99.3 mph).

LA MÁXIMA—Junior Caminero has homered in three straight games for the second time in his career, joining his streak earlier this season from April 12-14...he is the 12th Ray (19x) to hit 4 HR in a three-game span, first since **Isaac Paredes** (5HR) from June 21-25, 2022...Caminero is also the first Rays hitter to go deep in three consecutive road games since **Yandy Diaz** (3G) from April 18-27, 2023...he has homered five times in his last seven games and nine times in his last 21 games since the All-Star break, tied for third most in the majors...his 32 HR on the season rank third in the AL behind SEA **Cal Raleigh** (43HR) and NYY **Aaron Judge** (37HR) and are fourth most in franchise history before the end of August...with 44 games remaining on the Rays schedule, it already ties the 15th most home runs by any player in an age-21-or-younger season since 1901 (age as of June 30)...among primary third basemen (min. 50% of games at 3B) in an age 21-or-younger campaign, only ATL **Bob Horner** (33HR, 1979) and the Milwaukee Braves **Eddie Mathews** (47HR, 1953) have more homers.

★ He is on pace for 43 HR, which would mark the second-highest total in Rays history behind **Carlos Peña** (46HR) in 2007...he needs 8 HR in the Rays final 44 games to join ATL **Ronald Acuña Jr.** (41HR, 2019), Mathews (47HR, 1953) and NYY **Mel Ott** (42HR, 1929) as the only players in major league history to record 40 HR in an age 21-or-younger season.

★ Today, Caminero looks to become the ninth Ray (10x) to homer in four straight games (or more) and first since **Brandon Lowe** (4G) from April 8-11, 2023...he could also tie the club record for most consecutive road games with a homer (4G), shared by six players (last: **Mike Zunino**, Aug. 11-15, 2021).

DAWG DAYS—Brandon Lowe has hit safely in eight of nine games since returning from the injured list (left foot/ankle tendinitis) on July 30, going 11-for-35 (.314) with 1 2B, 3 HR, 5 RBI and a .951 OPS...four of the 5 RBI have given the Rays a lead...Lowe has tallied a hit in 17 of his last 18 games away from home, batting .403/.459/.701 (27-for-67) with 2 2B, 6 HR and 13 RBI in that span (since June 11), ranking second in MLB in road average (min. 60PA) behind ATH **Shea Langeliers** (.420) and third in OPS, trailing Langeliers (1.426) and ATH **Nick Kurtz** (1.238)...the only road game he failed to record a hit in over that timeframe was July 6 at MIN, when he was removed after 1 AB with left side soreness.

LIVE BY THE LONG BALL—The Rays have hit 9 HR in their last four games after going homerless in four of their previous five games (July 31-Aug. 4)...they have recorded a season-high-tying three consecutive multi-homer games on the road (also: June 26-28)—their last longer streak was four games from April 29-May 9, 2023...each of their last 11 runs have been scored via 8 HR since **Yandy Diaz's** RBI-fielder's choice on Aug. 5 at LAA...however, 14 of their 22 runs allowed on the current road trip came on 7 HR by opponents.

★ The Rays have homered in 12 consecutive games at T-Mobile Park (May 5, 2022—pres.), their longest streak in the ballpark's history and their longest active streak at any current MLB venue (Stats Perform).

★ In eight matchups with the Mariners since the start of last season, 27 of the 34 runs allowed by the Rays have come on 14 Seattle home runs.

PEN PALS—Over the last 13 games since July 27, the Rays bullpen leads the majors in WHIP (0.85), opp. OPS (.497) and strikeout rate (30.9%) and ranks second in opp. average (.173/30-for-173)...their 1.99 ERA (49.2IP, 11ER) in that stretch trails only the Guardians (1.77)...see below for a rundown of recent notable performances by Tampa Bay relievers:

★ **Pete Fairbanks** (19SV) is one save shy of joining **Roberto Hernandez** (1998-2000) as the only pitchers in Rays history with three 20-save seasons...he is 4-for-4 on save opportunities over his last seven outings, and his 82 career saves are fourth most in franchise history, three shy of third-ranked **Fernando Rodney** (85SV).

★ **Edwin Uceta** has allowed 0 ER over his last nine appearances (13.2IP), striking out nearly half of his batters faced (24 of 49/.49.0%). **Mason Englert** has a 1.72 ERA (15.2IP, 3ER) over his last 11 outings...**Garrett Cleavinger** has an 8.2 scoreless inning streak.

★ **Ian Seymour** has yielded 0 ER in nine of his first 10 career outings and has retired 25 of 29 BF across his last five appearances...**Mason Montgomery** has thrown five scoreless appearances (5.0IP) since his July 25 recall from Triple-A Durham, holding opponents to a 2-for-16 (.125) clip with 8 SO.

THIS DAY IN RAYS HISTORY—On Aug. 10, 2002, the Rays hit a club-record 6 HR, including **Carl Crawford's** first career homer, in a 13-6 win over the Royals at Kauffman Stadium...Crawford is the cousin of Mariners infielder **J.P. Crawford**...the 6 HR have since been matched by the Rays five times (last: Sept. 4, 2021 vs. MIN)...on Aug. 10, 2011, **Sam Fuld** hit the first walk-off triple in franchise history in an 8-7 win over the Royals at Tropicana Field, capping a four-run, 9th-inning comeback.

TODAY'S START—Adrian Houser will make his 13th start of the season, second with the Rays and second against the Mariners today...it marks his 117th career start and his third career start opposite Seattle...he was acquired from Chicago-AL on July 31 for **INF Curtis Mead**, **RHP Duncan Davitt** and **RHP Ben Peoples**...he was originally drafted by the Astros in the second round (No. 69 overall) of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft.

LAST TIME OUT—Made his debut with the Rays on Aug. 4 at LAA (L, 5.2IP, 11H, 5R, BB, 3SO, HR, HBP)...11 hits marked a season high and tied a career high (also: May 30, 2023 at TOR)...after a 1-2-3 1st inning, he was tagged for a two-run home run by **Jo Adell** in the 2nd...the 3rd frame opened with a hit batter-double-single-single sequence that plated two more runs...his outing ended in the 6th after he allowed back-to-back doubles by **Bryce Teodosio** and **Zach Neto** to plate the final run he allowed...the losing decision snapped a four-game winning decision streak that went from June 28–July 25 and tied his longest such streak in his career.

✧ The loss also ended a six game streak of wins by his team in his starts from June 22–July 25.

FOO FIGHTIN'—Houser is making his second start against the Mariners this season and for the third time in his career tonight...his other start this season against Seattle came on May 20 with the White Sox at Rate Field, throwing 6.0 scoreless frames with two hits, three walks and two strikeouts...his lone start against the Mariners prior to 2025 came on June 26, 2019 with the Brewers in Milwaukee (L, 2.0IP, 4H, 3R, 3BB, 4SO)...this marks his first start at T-Mobile Park.

✧ In 13 career appearances (10GS) against the AL West, he is 5-4 with a 3.38 ERA (53.1IP, 20ER), a .251 (52-for-207) opp. average...he has made three starts against the AL West this season to a 1-2 record, 4.32 ERA (16.2IP, 8ER) and a .302 (19-for-63) opp. average.

AWAY FROM THE HOUSE(R)—He has made seven starts on the road this season to a 1-3 record, 3.46 ERA (41.2IP, 16ER) and a .297 (49-for-165) average...his 3.46 ERA on the road is the best single-season mark of his career (min. 2.0IP)...in five of the seven road starts, he has gone at least 5.0 innings with three runs or fewer allowed...in each of his road starts in 2025, he has received three runs or fewer in run support.

✧ Across 59 career road starts, he is 17-24 with a 4.77 ERA (301.2IP, 160ER) and a 0.95 home run per 9.0 IP rate...he has spun 17 quality starts in those outings and his teams have gone 11-6 in such starts.

BETTER THAN EVER—2025 marks his first time pitching in the American League and it has turned into a career year for the right-hander...in eight previous major league seasons from 2015-24, Houser made 104 starts in 152 appearances to a 32-39 record, 4.21 ERA (608.2IP, 285ER) and a 1.38 WHIP...thus far in 2025, he is 6-3 with a 2.54 ERA (74.1IP, 21ER) and 1.29 WHIP...his 2.54 ERA, nine quality starts and 3.37 FIP are all career-bests.

SUMMER STARTER—His 2025 debut came on May 20 vs. SEA for the White Sox, throwing 6.0 scoreless innings with two hits allowed, three walks allowed and two strikeouts in a winning decision...since May 20, he has made nine starts with 6.0 innings or more and three runs or fewer allowed, that is tied for the second most in the AL and tied for fourth most in the majors...over that span, his 2.54 ERA (74.1IP, 21ER) ranks sixth in the AL and 13th in the majors among pitcher with 60.0 innings or more.

SLIDE DOWN—Houser has used his sinker as his primary pitch since 2019, but his usage of his slider has dropped this season from his second most thrown pitch in 2024 to his least thrown pitch in 2025...he threw his slider at a 17.3% rate in 2024 and has dropped that to a 10.3% rate in 2025...opposing hitters had an xBA of .326 against the pitch last season and have a .282 against it in 2025.

FEELING SUPPORTED—As a starting pitcher, he has received three runs or more of support in 46 career starts...his teams in those starts are 38-8 and he has earned a 25-5 record with 18 quality starts...in those starts, he has a 3.78 ERA (247.1IP, 104ER) and a 0.69 home runs per 9.0 IP...in 70 career starts with two runs or fewer of support, his teams are 24-46 and with a personal record of 7-36.

RIGHT, RIGHT—Right-handed batters this season are batting .247 (36-for-146) this season compared to .285 (37-for-130) against left-handers...he has allowed 12 extra-base hits (8 2B, 3 3B, 3HR) against lefties compared to nine extra-base hits (8 2B, 1 HR) against righties.

EARLY 2025—He signed a minor league contract with the Texas Rangers on Dec. 3, 2024 and was a non-roster invite to spring training...in the Cactus League, he was 0-1 with a 3.77 ERA (14.1IP, 6ER) in six games (2GS)... he joined Triple-A Round Rock and pitched to a 5.03 ERA (39.1IP, 22ER) across nine outings (8GS) in the Pacific Coast League...he was released from Round Rock on May 15 prior to signing with Chicago-AL on May 20.
