AROUND THE HORN

2027 SCHEDULE RELEASED: The D-backs' 2027 schedule is packed with fan favorites and holiday staples including Mother's Day in May, Father's Day in June and the 4th of July, monthly NL West matchups culminating with a huge season-ending homestand against the San Diego Padres and Los Angeles Dodgers, and Interleague action against the Boston Red Sox, Cleveland Guardians and more...2027 Advantage Memberships are available now by placing a deposit at [dbacks.com/membership](#) and are packed with various benefits including discounted ticket plans, preferred seat priority and priority for Postseason tickets as well as presale opportunities for Chase Field concerts & events...for the full schedule, visit [dbacks.com/schedule](#).

- HERE'S THE STORY:** The D-backs have won 10 of their last 14 games since July 9, the NL's most wins in the span and second most in MLB, behind the Red Sox (12).
- Since July 9, the D-backs' 6 road wins are tied for the most in MLB with the Dodgers, Yankees and Reds.
 - The D-backs currently hold the third NL Wild Card spot, 4.5 games behind the Cubs (WC1) and 2.0 games behind the Phillies (WC2), and 1.0 game ahead of the Pirates and Nationals.
 - The D-backs' 63 runs scored post-All-Star break are tied for MLB's second most with the Padres, behind the Nationals (68).
 - **Gabriel Moreno's** 42 straight starts reaching base safely is the second-longest streak in club history, behind only Corbin Carroll (44 in 2024).
 - **Gabriel Moreno** has recorded an RBI in a career-best 5 straight games...4 D-backs since 2019 have done so in 6 straight games (7 by Eduardo Escobar in 2019, 6 by Ketel Marte in 2019/2023-2x, 6 by Kole Calhoun in 2020, and Lourdes Gurriel Jr. in 2025).
 - **Gabriel Moreno**, in his last 17 games, since July 6, has reached base 2+ times in 13 of those games, batting .422 (27-for-64)/1.043 OPS with 6 doubles, 1 homer, 12 RBI and 10 walks.
 - **Ryan Waldschmidt**, since July 18, has hit safely in 6 of his last 7 games, batting .364 (8-for-22)/.939 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer and 4 RBI.
 - **Merrill Kelly**, in his last 4 starts, is 3-0 with a 2.45 ERA (6 ER in 22.0 IP), 8 walks and 18 strikeouts...in 5 career starts vs. Pirates (4 on road), is 3-1 with a 3.14 ERA (10 ER in 28.2 IP).

- LAST GAME:** The D-backs lost 10-7 @ Nationals.
- The D-backs scored a solo run in each the first, third, fourth, fifth and eighth innings...in the ninth, the D-backs rallied for 2 runs, loading the bases to bring the go-ahead run to the plate but could not mount a comeback.
 - D-backs' 1-4 hitters (**Corbin Carroll**, **Geraldo Perdomo**, **Gabriel Moreno**, and **Ketel Marte**) combined for 5 hits, including 3 doubles (Moreno/Carroll) and 2 homers (Perdomo/Marte), 4 RBI and 2 walks.

- THE ROAD AHEAD:** The D-backs are on their longest road trip, in games [10 total], this season: 1-0 @ Cardinals, 1-2 @ Nationals, 3 @ Pirates from July 27-29 and 3 @ Guardians from July 31-Aug. 2.
- This is their second 11-day, 9+-game roadie (also: April 6-15 @ Mets, Phillies, Orioles).

RECENT WITH RISP: Since July 18, the D-backs' 47 runs with runners in scoring position are most in MLB, ahead of the Cubs (42).

QUALITY AT-BAT PERDOMO: **Geraldo Perdomo**, among NL players, ranks third with a 21.3 chase pct. (behind Juan Soto-NYM/19.7 and Jake Bauers-MIL/20.3) and 15.5 walk pct. (behind Soto/17.5 and James Wood-WSH/16.5), and fifth with 4.22 pitches/PA (behind Seiya Suzuki-CHC/4.30, Matt Olson-ATL/4.30, Kyle Schwarber-PHI/4.28 and Brice Turang-MIL/4.23).

- MORENO'S ACTIVE ON-BASE STREAKS:** **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 23 straight games, MLB's longest active streak, and 42 straight starts since June 2 (C: 33, DH: 9), MLB's longest active starts streak (second-longest this season, behind 48 straight starts by Nick Kurtz/ATH from April 3-May 25).
- His 42-start on-base streak is third longest by a MLB primary catcher since 2000, behind Jonathan Lucroy/MIL (49 from May 9-July 5, 2014) and Joe Mauer/MIN (43 from Aug. 7-Sept. 24, 2015).
 - Since June 2, is hitting .356 (53-for-149)/.940 OPS with 8 doubles, 4 homers, 20 RBI and 26 walks (18 K).
- MORENO LEADS THE MAJORS SINCE MID MAY:** Since May 15, **Gabriel Moreno's** .352 AVG ranks atop the Majors, ahead of Luis Arraez/SF (.343 AVG).
- Additionally, in MLB since May 15, ranks 11th in OPS (.942) and tied for 11th in fewest strikeouts (28).

- MORENO RAKING ON THE ROAD:** **Gabriel Moreno's** .417 (45-for-108) road AVG since May 13 ranks atop the Majors, ahead of Luke Keaschall/MIN (.363).
- Since May 13, is carrying a 1.060 OPS with 9 doubles, 3 homers, 21 RBI and 16 walks in 30 games.
 - Moreno is the second D-back all-time to have a 30-game road span in a season with a .400 AVG, 20+ RBI and 15+ walks, joining Luis Gonzalez (3x - last: May 4-July 13, 2001 - .403 AVG, 41 RBI, 17 BB).

- TREND OF RECENT HISTORICAL SERIES OPENERS @ PIRATES:** On July 25, 2025 @ Pirates, the D-backs became the only team since 1900 to win 1-0 in 11.0+ innings while allowing only 1 or no hits (source: @OptaSTATS)...it was the first-ever D-backs extra-inning 1-0 win where the lone run was produced by a sacrifice fly, fourth extra-inning 1-0 win in franchise history, and fourth game in franchise history with 11.0+ shutout innings.
- On Aug. 2, 2024 @ Pirates, the D-backs became the first team in MLB history with 15 total bases from the first 4 batters of a game: **Corbin Carroll** leadoff triple followed by back-to-back-to-back homers in the top of the first by **Ketel Marte**, Joc Pederson and Josh Bell (eighth franchise occurrence)...the D-backs tied a franchise high with 6 consecutive batters reaching (via H, BB or HBP) to start the game (second occurrence of 2024, seventh all-time)...the first-ever time also happened @ Pirates (Aug. 22, 2001).

- LINEUP 4-9 PRODUCTION:** Since July 9, the D-backs 4-9 batters' have combined for an MLB-best .308 AVG (97-for-315), .895 OPS and 34 extra-base hits, ahead of the Rays (.291 AVG, .817 OPS, 36 XBH).
- Since July 1, D-backs 7-8-9 batters' 40 RBI lead MLB.

VS. PIRATES: The D-backs have won 2 of their last 3 series @ Pirates, going 5-4 (2-1 in 2023, 2-1 in 2024, 1-2 in 2025) and 5 of their last 8 since 2017, going 21-17.
