AT HOME: The Brewers are 6-7 at home, going 1-2-1 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 12-4 on the road, going 4-0-1 in series play....their 12-4 record ties the best road start in franchise history (also 2014).

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), replacing Bud Black in June of that season....Murphy enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career spent primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff.... Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach) and Charlie Greene (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made six replay challenges this season, going 5-1....their last challenge came on 4/24 at Pittsburgh as a safe call at first base involving Edward Olivares in the ninth inning stood.

TODAY'S STARTER: #48 - RHP COLIN REA (5gs, 2-0, 3.25)

REA AT A GLANCE: Colin Rea, 33, will be making his sixth start of the season....Rea last started last Friday vs. New York-AL and received no decision in the Brewers' 7-6, 11-inning win (6ip, 4h, 5r, 5er, 3bb, 4k, 3hr, 86 pitches)....the team is 4-1 in his starts....has made 1 quality start....opponents are batting .239 (26-for-109, 5hr)....Rea is signed through the 2024 season with a club option for 2025....name is pronounced "RAY."

LAST SEASON: Rea went 6-6 with a 4.55 ERA in 26 games/22 starts during five stints with Milwaukee last season....the team went 14-8 in his starts....he had 4 quality starts....opponents batted .235 (110-for-468, 23hr)....he set career highs in wins (6), games (26), starts (22), innings pitched (124.2) and strikeouts (110).

CAREER: Is 16-14 with a 4.61 ERA in 67 games/54 starts (306.2ip, 157er)....has pitched in the majors for San Diego (2015-16), Miami (2016), Chicago-NL (2020) and Milwaukee (2021, '23-24)....is 14-13 with a 4.69 ERA as a starter (280ip, 146er) and 2-1 with a 3.71 ERA as a reliever (26.2ip, 11er)....Rea was selected by San Diego in the 12th round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Indiana State University....he underwent "Tommy John" surgery on 11/11/16, causing him to miss the entire 2017 season....Rea also pitched in Japan with the Fukuoka SoftBank Hawks in 2021 and 2022.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 3-4 with a 4.75 ERA in 17 games/14 starts (77.2ip, 41er)....is 1-0 with a 4.50 ERA in 2 starts this season (12ip, 6er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 8-6 with a 4.52 ERA in 30 games/22 starts (135.1p, 68er)....is 1-0 with a 2.30 ERA in 3 starts this season (15.2ip, 4er).

CAREER vs. RAYS: Ray has never pitched against Tampa Bay, one of four teams he has never faced (also Boston, Oakland and Texas).
