YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles defeated the Twins in the series opener, 7-4, improving to 5-1 in series openers to begin the season...Gunnar Henderson, Cedric Mullins, and Ryan O'Hearn each homered in the win.... Jordan Westburg went 3 -for- 4 with a double, a run, and two RBI...Adley Rutschman picked up his team-leading seventh multi-hit game....Craig Kimbrel notched his $422^{\text {st }}$ career save, working a perfect ninth inning with two strikeouts.

HOMER HAPPY: Entering today's games, the Orioles lead the AL and rank tied for second in MLB with 24 home runs...The team has hit at least three home runs in three consecutive games for the first time since May 10-12, 2018; the Orioles have hit three-or-more home runs in at least four consecutive games three times in team history (since 1954): May 21-24, 2013 (4G), August 6-10, 1996 ( 5 G ), and May 8-13, 1987 (6 G).
$\theta_{\text {. }}$ Cedric Mullins and Ryan O'Hearn have each homered in back-to-back games; Mullins has done so for the first time since April 1-2, 2023, while O'Hearn last did it from June 11-13, 2023...The last O's batter to homer in three straight games was Anthony Santander from June 23-25, 2023.

COMEBACK KIDS: Seven of the Orioles' 10 wins this season, including four of their last five, have been in comeback fashion, the most in MLB...Baltimore's 55 comeback wins since the start of last season are the most in MLB...Their 91 come-from-behind victories since the start of 2022 are also the most in MLB.

AL PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Colton Cowser was selected as the AL Player of the Week for the period of April $8-14$ after slashing $.435 / .481 / 1.130$ ( 10 -for-23) with four doubles, four home runs, six runs scored, 12 RBI, three walks, and two stolen bases in six games...During that time, he led MLB in slugging, OPS (1.611), extra-base hits (8), total bases (26), and RBI... He led the AL in homers, ranked tied for the lead in doubles, and ranked among the leaders in hits ( $T-3^{-d}$ ), runs ( $\left.T-3^{r d}\right)$, and average ( $\left.4^{\text {th }}\right)$...Marks the first career honor for Cowser, who is the first O's player to win the award since Gunnar Henderson for the week of June 5-11, 2023...Each of the last three Orioles to win Player of the Week have been rookies, including Cowser, Henderson and Ryan Mountcastle in 2021
$\theta_{\text {. }}$ During the three-game series at Fenway from April 9-11, Cowser slashed .462/.467/1.154 (6-for-13) with three doubles, two home runs, three runs scored, 10 RBI, one walk, four strikeouts, and a stolen base, becoming the first player in O's RBI, one walk, four strikeouts, and a stolen base,

KIMBREL COUNT: Craig Kimbrel recorded the $421^{\text {st }}$ save of his career last night against Minnesota, one behind Billy Wagner for seventh in MLB history; only Boston's Kenley Jansen (424) has more among active players...Kimbrel now has 1,205 strikeouts, the fourth-most all-time as a reliever; he trails Hoyt Wilhelm ( 1,363 ), Goose Gossage ( 1,340 ), and Lee Smith $(1,225)$.

STRIKE A POSE: Baltimore pitchers have fanned 148 batters so far in 2024, the most strikeouts through 16 games in O's history...The most strikeouts through the first 17 games in O's history is 150 by the 2020 team
$\theta$. The Birds have an MLB-best 4.35 strikeout-to-walk ratio; since the mound moved back in 1893 , the best $\mathrm{K} / \mathrm{BB}$ in a full season is 3.98 by the 2017 Cleveland Indians.

FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME: The Orioles wrapped up their first road trip of the season with a 4-2 record against Pittsburgh (1-2) and Boston (3-0)...The O's are in the middle of a six-game homestand against the Brewers (1-2) and Twins (1-0).

Ө. The O's are 55-36(.604) at home since the start of last season, tied with the Rangers for the second-best record in the AL and fourth-best in MLB during that time
. The Birds went 49-32 (.605) at Oriole Park in 2023, the third-best record in ballpark history (since 1992), behind the 2014 and 2016 teams who went 50-31 (.617); marked the third-best home record in the AL last season behind Tampa Bay at 53-28(.654) and Texas at 50-31 (.617), and tied for the fifth-best in MLB.

AGAINST THE TWINS: The O's and Twins are meeting for a three-game series in Baltimore this week...The Birds will travel to Minnesota for the final three games of the regular season from September 27-29...The O's have won five straight games against the Twins dating back to July 2, 2023, their second-longest active winning streak against a single opponent, behind a seven-game winning streak against the Nats...The Orioles went 4-2 against the Twins last year, dropping two of three at Oriole Park from June 30 to July 2 before completing a three-game sweep at Target Field from July 7-9, their first sweep of at least three games in Minnesota since a four-game set from August 22-25, 2011...Marked Baltimore's first season series victory over Minnesota since 2016 (5-1).

SWEEPLESS IN BALTIMORE: With tonight's game, the Orioles will have gone 97 consecutive regular-season series of at least two decisions (no ties) without being swept....According to the Elias Sports Bureau, that is the fourth-longest regular-season streak in MLB history, trailing the 1942-44 St. Louis Cardinals (124), 1906-09 Chicago Cubs (115), and 1903-05 New York Giants (105)... Baltimore's current streak is the longest in O's history, ahead of 46 such series from 1971-72...The Birds have not been swept in a regular-season series of at least two games since May 13-15, 2022 at Detroit ( $0-3$ ), and not at home in a series of at least two games since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (0-3).
O. The 2023 Orioles ( 52 series) were the fourth MLB team since 2000 to go a full regular season without being swept in a series of at least two decisions, joining the Braves teams of 2022 ( 51 series), 2004 ( 52 series), and 2002 ( 52 series).

THE SKIPPER: Manager Brandon Hyde is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the Baseball Writers' Association of America (BBWAA) AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award. He was also voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year... Hyde was named the $20^{\text {th }}$ manager in Orioles history on December 14, 2018... His 325 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers, trailing Hank Bauer (407), Paul Richards (517), Buck Showalter (669), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer Earl Weaver $(1,480)$.
