**YESTERDAY'S NEWS:** The Orioles defeated the Twins in the series opener, 7-4, improving to 5-1 in series openers to begin the season...**Gunnar Henderson**, **Cedric Mullins**, and **Ryan O'Hearn** each homered in the win...**Jordan Westburg** went 3-for-4 with a double, a run, and two RBI...**Adley Rutschman** picked up his team-leading seventh multi-hit game...**Craig Kimbrel** notched his 421<sup>st</sup> career save, working a perfect ninth inning with two strikeouts.

**HOMER HAPPY:** Entering today's games, the Orioles lead the AL and rank tied for second in MLB with 24 home runs...The team has hit at least three home runs in three consecutive games for the first time since May 10-12, 2018; the Orioles have hit three-or-more home runs in at least four consecutive games three times in team history (since 1954): May 21-24, 2013 (4 G), August 6-10, 1996 (5 G), and May 8-13, 1987 (6 G).

⚾ **Cedric Mullins** and **Ryan O'Hearn** have each homered in back-to-back games; Mullins has done so for the first time since April 1-2, 2023, while O'Hearn last did it from June 11-13, 2023...The last O's batter to homer in three straight games was **Anthony Santander** from June 23-25, 2023.

**COMEBACK KIDS:** Seven of the Orioles' 10 wins this season, including four of their last five, have been in comeback fashion, the most in MLB...Baltimore's 55 comeback wins since the start of last season are the most in MLB...Their 91 come-from-behind victories since the start of 2022 are also the most in MLB.

**AL PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** **Colton Cowser** was selected as the AL Player of the Week for the period of April 8-14 after slashing .435/.481/1.130 (10-for-23) with four doubles, four home runs, six runs scored, 12 RBI, three walks, and two stolen bases in six games...During that time, he led MLB in slugging, OPS (1.611), extra-base hits (8), total bases (26), and RBI... He led the AL in homers, ranked tied for the lead in doubles, and ranked among the leaders in hits (T-3<sup>rd</sup>), runs (T-3<sup>rd</sup>), and average (4<sup>th</sup>)...Marks the first career honor for Cowser, who is the first O's player to win the award since **Gunnar Henderson** for the week of June 5-11, 2023...Each of the last three Orioles to win Player of the Week have been rookies, including Cowser, Henderson and **Ryan Mountcastle** in 2021.

⚾ During the three-game series at Fenway from April 9-11, Cowser slashed .462/.467/1.154 (6-for-13) with three doubles, two home runs, three runs scored, 10 RBI, one walk, four strikeouts, and a stolen base, becoming the first player in O's history to drive in 10 runs in a series at Fenway Park.

⚾ Hit his first two Major League home runs on April 11 at Boston, becoming the seventh player since the team moved to Baltimore in 1954 to hit his first two career home runs in the same game, and first since Mountcastle on August 30, 2020 at Toronto's Sahlen Field, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

**KIMBREL COUNT:** **Craig Kimbrel** recorded the 421<sup>st</sup> save of his career last night against Minnesota, one behind Billy Wagner for seventh in MLB history; only Boston's Kenley Jansen (424) has more among active players...Kimbrel now has 1,205 strikeouts, the fourth-most all-time as a reliever; he trails Hoyt Wilhelm (1,363), Goose Gossage (1,340), and Lee Smith (1,225).

**STRIKE A POSE:** Baltimore pitchers have fanned 148 batters so far in 2024, the most strikeouts through 16 games in O's history...The most strikeouts through the first 17 games in O's history is 150 by the 2020 team.

⚾ The Birds have an MLB-best 4.35 strikeout-to-walk ratio; since the mound moved back in 1893, the best K/BB in a full season is 3.98 by the 2017 Cleveland Indians.

**FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME:** The Orioles wrapped up their first road trip of the season with a 4-2 record against Pittsburgh (1-2) and Boston (3-0)...The O's are in the middle of a six-game homestand against the Brewers (1-2) and Twins (1-0).

⚾ The O's are 55-36 (.604) at home since the start of last season, tied with the Rangers for the second-best record in the AL and fourth-best in MLB during that time.

⚾ The Birds went 49-32 (.605) at Oriole Park in 2023, the third-best record in ballpark history (since 1992), behind the 2014 and 2016 teams who went 50-31 (.617); marked the third-best home record in the AL last season behind Tampa Bay at 53-28 (.654) and Texas at 50-31 (.617), and tied for the fifth-best in MLB.

**AGAINST THE TWINS:** The O's and Twins are meeting for a three-game series in Baltimore this week...The Birds will travel to Minnesota for the final three games of the regular season from September 27-29...The O's have won five straight games against the Twins dating back to July 2, 2023, their second-longest active winning streak against a single opponent, behind a seven-game winning streak against the Nats...The Orioles went 4-2 against the Twins last year, dropping two of three at Oriole Park from June 30 to July 2 before completing a three-game sweep at Target Field from July 7-9, their first sweep of at least three games in Minnesota since a four-game set from August 22-25, 2011...Marked Baltimore's first season series victory over Minnesota since 2016 (5-1).

**SWEETNESS IN BALTIMORE:** With tonight's game, the Orioles will have gone 97 consecutive regular-season series of at least two decisions (no ties) without being swept...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, that is the fourth-longest regular-season streak in MLB history, trailing the 1942-44 St. Louis Cardinals (124), 1906-09 Chicago Cubs (115), and 1903-05 New York Giants (105)...Baltimore's current streak is the longest in O's history, ahead of 46 such series from 1971-72...The Birds have not been swept in a regular-season series of at least two games since May 13-15, 2022 at Detroit (0-3), and not at home in a series of at least two games since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (0-3).

⚾ The 2023 Orioles (52 series) were the fourth MLB team since 2000 to go a full regular season without being swept in a series of at least two decisions, joining the Braves teams of 2022 (51 series), 2004 (52 series), and 2002 (52 series).

**THE SKIPPER:** Manager **Brandon Hyde** is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the Baseball Writers' Association of America (BBWAA) AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award... He was also voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde was named the 20<sup>th</sup> manager in Orioles history on December 14, 2018...His 325 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers, trailing **Hank Bauer** (407), **Paul Richards** (517), **Buck Showalter** (669), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Earl Weaver** (1,480).

**QUICK HITS:** Scheduled to make his fourth start of the season tonight against Minnesota...Posted a 7-4 record and 4.35 ERA (59 ER/122.0 IP) across 23 starts in his rookie campaign last year...Began last season with Triple-A Norfolk before being promoted and making his MLB debut on April 5 at Texas...Optioned to Norfolk on May 27...Recalled on July 17 for the remainder of the season...Originally selected by the Orioles in the first round (No. 11 overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the decision last Thursday in Boston... Allowed two runs on six hits and two walks with five strikeouts across 5.2 innings...Threw 94 pitches, 61 strikes.

**AGAINST TWINS AND THE AL CENTRAL:** Tonight marks Rodriguez's first career appearance against the Twins...Owned a 2-0 record with a 3.64 ERA (12 ER/29.2 IP) and 39 strikeouts across six starts against the AL Central in 2023.

**HOME SWEET HOME:** Owns a lifetime 5-2 record and a 4.33 ERA (34 ER/70.2 IP) across 13 home starts...Opponents are slashing .266/.328/.405 (73-for-274) against Rodriguez at Oriole Park.

**NIGHT OWL:** Posted a 7-3 record and a 4.18 ERA (41 ER/88.1 IP) in 16 starts at night last season...Has surrendered 10 home runs at night, compared to nine home runs allowed during the day across 46.0 innings pitched.

**GAME OF ADJUSTMENTS:** In Rodriguez's 10 starts in his initial stint with the club in 2023, he notched a 7.35 ERA (37 ER/45.1 IP)...After being optioned to Norfolk, he returned to Baltimore on July 17 and posted a 2.58 ERA (22 ER/76.2 IP) across his remaining 13 starts...Has posted nine quality starts in his last 13 outings, dating back to July 28, 2023; tied with eight others for the fifth most such starts in that span...Did not register a quality start in his first 12 outings to begin his career.

**GAS'EM UP:** Punched out 129 batters for the O's last season, the most for an Orioles rookie since 2012 (Wei-Yin Chen, 154)...His mark ranks sixth among rookies in team history (since 1954)...He became the 20<sup>th</sup> rookie pitcher in Orioles history to strike out at least 100 batters.

**2023 HIGHLIGHTS:** Rodriguez opened last season with the Norfolk Tides, earning the nod as their Opening Day starter...Recalled by the Orioles on April 5, making his MLB debut in a start at Texas...Marked the first of six Orioles to make their big-league debut last year...Earned his first career win on April 29 (G2) at Detroit, throwing 5.0 shutout innings and striking out nine...Tossed a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings on September 16 vs. Tampa Bay, tied for the longest outing by an Oriole in 2023; at 23 years old, 304 days old, became the youngest O's starter to work 8.0 scoreless frames since Zack Britton (23-141) tossed a shutout on May 12, 2011 vs. Seattle, and the youngest rookie right-hander to do since Brad Bergesen (23-257) worked 8.0 scoreless on June 9, 2009 vs. Seattle.

**POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE:** Made his Postseason debut last season, taking the loss in Game 2 of the ALDS against the Rangers on October 8... Allowed five runs on six hits and four walks across 1.2 innings...Marked the most runs that Rodriguez had surrendered since May 26 when he allowed eight, also against the Rangers.
