- · Was the second sweep of the season and third alltime 3-game sweep @ Braves (also: April 16-18, 2019 and May 6-8, 2016).
- Eugenio Suárez hit an eventual game-winning 2-run double in the ninth inning.
- Ketel Marte went 2-for-4 with a solo homer (11), 2 RBI and 2 walks and extended his season-high on-base streak to 18 straight games.
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr. hit a solo homer (9), to start the epic comeback in the ninth inning, to extend his season-high 11-game hitting streak.

ROSTER MOVES: Reinstated LHP Eduardo Rodriguez from the 15-day injured list (left shoulder inflammation) and optioned LHP Tommy Henry to Triple-A Reno following yesterday's game.

ONE-OF-A-KIND COMEBACK: Yesterday was the D-backs first win all-time when trailing by 6+ runs entering the ninth inning (previously 0-418).

• It was their largest comeback win since July 29, 2024 vs. Nationals (6 runs, won 9-8 after trailing 8-2 in mid sixth) and tied their second-largest comeback win in franchise history (12th time).

STREAKING SNAKES: Ketel Marte's season-best 18-game on-base streak is tied for the fourth-longest active streak in the Majors (also: Nico Hoerner/CHC)...in that span is hitting .329 (23-for-70)/1.153 OPS with 2 doubles, 8 homers, 14 RBI, 12 walks and 4 hit-by-pitches.
