**TONIGHT'S GAME:** Is Game 1 of a 3-game series vs **Tiffany Seal's Padres** and the fourth game (0-3) of a 6-game road trip that includes a 3-game weekend sweep by the **Cardinals at Busch Stadium**.

- The Reds have lost 8 of their last 10 games (since 5/27 at **NYM**) and on Saturday dropped below .500 for the first time since they were 0-1 following an **Opening Day** loss to the **Red Sox** (3/26).
- Following Wed's game and Thu's off day, the Reds will return home for a 6-game homestand vs **AZ** (6/12-6/14) and **NYM** (6/15-6/17).

**STRUGGLING AGAINST PEERS:** The Reds are 2-13 (.133) vs their NL Central counterparts and 14-23 (.378) vs all National League opponents.

- Of the 31 games remaining until the All-Star break, 25 will be against National League teams, including 13 within the Central Division.

**LOSSES AFTER LEADING:** The Reds have lost 14 games the season in which they held a lead, including all 3 games in the weekend series sweep at **StL**.

- 12 of those 14 total losses have occurred since 5/2.
- Cin was ahead or tied after the 7th inning in both Sat's and Sun's losses at **Busch Stadium**...have 8 such losses in 2026.

**BRING 'EM ON:** The Reds own a 20-20 record (.500) this season against opponents entering play with a .500-or-better winning percentage but are just 9-21 (.300) vs teams currently at or above .500.

**BLAKE SUPERIOR: OF Blake Dunn** has collected 9 hits over his last 23 at-bats since 6/2 to lift his batting average to .300 (27-for-90).

- Has started 20 of Cin's last 27 games (22 apps), and played the entire game in 17 of those games, beginning 5/7 at **Chc**.
- Has reached base in 18 of his 25 apps (33 times on base).
- Overall has made 10 starts in RF, 9 starts in CF, and 1 start in LF.

**CATTLE DRIVE: OF/INF Spencer Steer's** 24-game on-base streak ended yesterday at **StL** (0-for-4, 2k)...it was the longest active streak in MLB and longest by a Red since **Joey Votto** (25g, 7/2-7/31, 2021).

- Yesterday marked just the fourth time since 4/25 that he struck out 2 or more times in a game (38g, 157 PA).
- Since 4/18, **Steer** is slashing .297/.389/.471 (.860ops) in 44 games (46-for-155, 6hr, 19rbi, 15xbh, 70 times on base).
- Has at least 1 hit in 46 G this season, which ranks among Major League leaders...hit safely in 24 games during the month of May, most in MLB.
- Overall this year, **Steer** has appeared in 27g in LF, 26g at 1B, 16g in RF, 9g at 2B, and 2g at 3B.

**POWER SURGE:** The Reds have homered 59 times over their last 41 games (since 4/21 at **TB**), seventh-most in the majors during that time.

- Are on pace to hit 205 homers this season, which would be the 10th time in franchise history they'd reach the 200-HR mark.
- Have produced 5 sets of back-to-back home runs this season, including yesterday at **StL** (**McLain** & **Stephenson** in the 3rd inning)...only the **White Sox** have more (6)...last year, the Reds had 2 sets of back-to-back homers, tying them with **Det** for fewest in the majors.
- Have hit 2 or more HRs in a game 22 times this season.
- Have hit 48 homers at **Great American Ball Park** in 2026, fifth-most by any Major League team at its home venue.
- 125 of their 275 runs scored this year have come via HR (45.5%, 4th).

**BLEADY NAMED PLAYER OF THE MONTH: OF JJ Bleday** last week was named **National League Player of the Month for May**, his first career monthly award.

- Bleday** batted .301 (31-for-103) for the month with 8 HR, 25 RBI, 8 doubles, 1 triple, 15 walks, 17 runs scored, a stolen base, a .631 slugging pct., and a .387 on-base pct.
- He ranked second in the majors in slugging (.631), extra-base hits (17) and total bases (65)...he led the National League in slugging, TB, OPS (1.018) and T1st in RBI (25).
- Bleday** is the first Red to win a player of the month award since **Joey Votto** in July 2021...became the first Red with at least 30 hits and 25 RBI in a single month since **Votto** did it in July 2021.
- Bleday** became the first Red with 17 extra-base hits in a single month since **Aristides Aquino** in August 2019 (18).

### SERIES NOTES:

- Since winning 6 of 8 from **SD** in 2012, Cin is 30-47 against the **Padres**, including 12-26 at **Petco Park** and 18-21 at **Great American Ball Park**.
- Since 2013, the Reds have won just 2 season series (2025, 4-2; 2019, 5-2) and split 2 season series with the **Friars** (2013, 3-3 & 2023, 3-3).

**BASES LOADED WALKS:** The Reds' pitching staff has issued a Major League-leading 19 walks with the bases loaded this season, most by any team in a single campaign since the 2024 **Pirates** allowed 20 bases-loaded walks.

- Cin's 19 bases loaded walks are tied for its most in a single season in the expansion era (since 1961), matching the mark set by the 1969 club.
- Reds pitchers have faced 97 opposing batters with the bases loaded this season, most among all Major League pitching staffs.
- Overall, Reds relievers lead the majors with 158 walks...the Cin staff as a whole has issued 298 free passes (third-most).

**OFF THE BENCH:** Reds substitutes have combined to bat .263 with a .795 OPS over the season's first 64 games (25-for-95, 3hr, 12rbi, 37k, 40 x on base).

- Cin subs rank fourth in AVG., fifth in SLG and OPS, and T3rd w/ 10xbh.
- In 2025, Reds in-game replacements batted .180 (28th in the majors), with a .266 OBP (28th), a .212 SLG (29th), and a .478 OPS (29th)...Cin was the only team in the majors last year not to produce a HR off the bench.

**NO, THANKS:** The Reds are 1 of 5 teams without an ABS challenge from their pitching staff (also: **Diamondbacks**, **Twins**, **Blue Jays**, and **Rays**).

**ALL-STAR BALLOTS:** Major League Baseball opened fan voting for the 2026 All-Star Game, using a 2-phase system to select all starters.

- Fans can cast their ballots online and via mobile devices on all MLB platforms, including the MLB App, the MLB Ballpark App, and at MLB.com/Vote.
- Phase 1 runs 6/3-6/25 with up to 5 votes per day; top finalists advance.
- League leaders in Phase 1 automatically earn starting spots.
- Phase 2 runs 6/29-7/2 with reset totals to choose the rest of the starters.
- Full All-Star rosters will be announced on 7/4.
- The 2026 Midsummer Classic will be held on 7/14 in **Philadelphia**.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor in the decision in the 10-inning, 4-3 win vs KC on Tue, 6/2 (6.0ip, 5h, 3r/3er, 4bb, 5k, 0hr, 105TP).

- Was his second straight quality start, his fifth this season and the 34th of his career.
- Threw 31 of his 105 pitches in the 4th inning (4h, 2bb, 2r).
- Produced 11 swings-and-misses...was his third straight game with double-digit misses...it marks the first time since July of last year that he produced 3 straight starts of double-digit swings-and-misses.
- Of the 41 contact swings, just 4 were hard hit.
- Allowed 9 of his 27 batters to reach.
- Issued 4 walks for the second time this season (also: 5/5 at Chc).
- His 5 strikeouts matched a season high for the fourth time.
- Retired 7 of his final 8 batters before turning it over to Tejay Antone.

**HAPPY BIRTHDAY!:** Celebrated his 27th birthday on 6/1.

**MAY 27 at NYM:** Suffered the 4-2 loss on Wed, 5/27 at NYM (6.0ip, 6h, 3r/3er, 1bb, 4k, 2hr, 101TP).

- Was his fourth quality start of the season, the 33rd of his career.
- Threw a season-high 101 pitches...the first time he eclipsed the 100-pitch mark since 9/10/25 vs SD (102).
- Produced a season-high 10 fly balls, the most since he allowed 11 on 8/6/25 at Chc.
- Generated 11 swings-and-misses (54 swings)...batters put 19 pitches in play.
- 7 hard-hit balls marked a season high.
- 7 of his 24 batters reached.

**MAY 20 at PHI:** Earned the 9-4 win on Wed, 5/20 at Phi (5.1ip, 3h, 2r/1er, 3bb, 3k, 1hr, 96TP).

- Reached max velocity of 94.5 mph, his highest since 9/21/2025 vs Chc (94.6).

- Eight different **Reds** pitchers have earned a save this season (last: **Sam Moll**, 5/31 vs **Atl**)...**Cin's** 8 pitchers with at least 1 save are tied for third-most among all Major League teams, behind the **Twins** (11) and **Nationals** (9).
