## PITTSBURGH PIRATES (19-24) vs. MILWAUKEE BREWERS (25-17) May 15, 2024 at American Family Field, Milwaukee, WI - 12:10 CDT - GAME #44/ROAD #23 LHP MARTÍN PÉREZ (1-2, 3.60 ERA) vs. LHP ROBERT GASSER (1-0, 0.00 ERA)

**THE PIRATES:**...lost 4-3 last night in the middle game of their three-game series against the Brewers...Have gone 10-12 on the road this year...Have the fifth-lowest ERA (3.63) among all starting rotations in the National League (11th-best in all of MLB)...Have been involved in 24 games against the Brewers decided by either one or two runs since the beginning of 2022 (the most such games between any two National League teams in that time).

**ABOUT TODAY'S STARTER:** Martín Pérez gets the start today in the finale of this series against the Brewers...Pérez allowed four runs in 5.0 innings but had a no-decision in his last start against the Angels one week ago today at PNC Park...Today is also Pérez' fifth road start of the 2024 campaign, where he has posted a 2.38 ERA (22.2ip/6er).

**ROSTER MOVE:** Prior to today's game the Pirates recalled right-handed pitcher Carmen Mlodzinski from Triple-A Indianapolis...Quinn Priester has been optioned to Triple-A to make room for Mlodzinski on the active roster...The 25-year-old Mlodzinski began this season on the 15-day injured list with right shoulder inflammation...He made his big league debut here in Milwaukee last year on June 16 while also earning the first win of his career on June 30 against the Crew at PNC Park.

**HAPPENING IN THREES:** Connor Joe has gone deep in three straight games for the first time in his career after connecting for his sixth of the season last night in his final at-bat...Joe is the first Pirate to hit a home run in three straight games since Bryan Reynolds did so last year in three straight from April 2-4...Joe has also knocked in a run in four straight games...The longest RBI streak by a Pirate this year belongs to Michael A. Taylor (five games from March 29 to April 3).

**DIALING LONG DISTANCE:** Pittsburgh is tied for the seventh-most home runs (15) in MLB (and tied for second among all National League teams) during the month of May...The Dodgers lead the Majors with 23 home runs this month followed by the Athletics (20), Yankees (19), Mariners (18), Orioles (17) and Guardians (17)...Oneil Cruz has gone deep four times this month, which is tied for the fourth-most among National League players.

**AND WHEN I'M BACK IN CHICAGO:** The Pirates will bus to Chicago following today's game to begin a four-game series against the Cubs tomorrow night...The Bucs dropped two of three games against the Cubs at PNC Park this past weekend...The upcoming series will conclude a stretch of 10 straight games for the Pirates against the National League Central.

**WHAT'S AT STAKE:** The Pirates will look to win their first series at American Family Field today since taking two of three games from July 8-10, 2022...The Pirates lost two of three games against the Crew here at American Family Field from August 29-31, 2022, were swept in three games last year from June 16-18, and split a four-game series from August 3-6, 2023.

**GOING THE EXTRA MILE:** The Pirates have recorded 34 extra base hits dating back to May 4...That's tied for the fifth-most in all of MLB along with the Angels and Brewers...The only four teams to have more extra base hits in that time are the Athletics (40), Dodgers (37), Phillies (36) and Twins (35).

**BEER BATTERS:** Oneil Cruz has hit safely in 13 of his last 14 games against the Brewers, going 19-for-51 (.373) with six doubles, four home runs, 15 RBI, .458 OBP, .725 slugging percentage and 1.183 OPS...Andrew McCutchen is 7-for-22 with a pair of leadoff home runs against the Crew this year...Bryan Reynolds is a .341 lifetime hitter (44-for-129) with 10 doubles, two triples, five home runs and 17 RBI in 38 career games at American Family Field.

**CRUZZING ALONG:** Oneil Cruz is hitting at a .348 clip (24-for-69) with seven doubles, four home runs and 12 RBI in his last 20 games dating back to April 22...Cruz' .348 average since April 22 is the sixth-highest among all National League players behind Alec Bohm (.378), Bryson Stott (.352), Shohei Ohtani (.351), Jurickson Profar (.351) and William Contreras (.349)...Cruz is tied for third among all National League players in that time with 43 total bases, trailing only Shohei Ohtani (52) and Alec Bohm (46).

**JARED JONES:** The 22-year-old righthander will make his ninth start tomorrow night at Wrigley Field...Lost a 7-2 decision (6.0ip/3r/2er) in his last start Friday against the Cubs at PNC Park...Had four outings with seven-plus strikeouts and no walks, which were the most ever in the first seven career games of a big league career (the previous mark was held by Stephen Strasburg who had three such outings in his first seven games in 2010)...Has allowed three runs or fewer in each of his first eight starts...Entered the 2024 campaign rated 72nd among Baseball America's top 100 prospects (No. 3 among Pirates prospects).
