YESTERDAY'S GAME: The Brewers beat the White Sox, 8-2, in Glendale....**1B Wes Clarke** belted a 3-run homer, his fourth home run of the spring....**RF Brewer Hicklen** went 2-for-2 with 2 runs, a solo homer, walk and SB....**SS Yonny Hernández** went 2-for-3 with a run and 2 RBI....**LHP Aaron Ashby** [2.2ip, 2h, 2r, 2er, 3bb, 2k] started for Milwaukee.

THE ROSTER: The team opened Cactus League play with 58 players in Major League camp: 31 pitchers, 6 catchers, 13 infielders and 8 outfielders....there were 18 non-roster invitees: 11 pitchers, 2 catchers, 4 infielders and 1 outfielder.... there are currently 53 players in Major League camp: 28 pitchers, 5 catchers, 12 infielders and 8 outfielders....there are 13 non-roster invitees remaining: 8 pitchers, 1 catcher, 3 infielders and 1 outfielder.

2023 IN REVIEW: The Brewers went 92-70 and qualified for the postseason for the fifth time in the last six seasons.... the team won the NL Central for the third time in the last six seasons, taking the division by 9.0 games over the Cubs.... the Brewers were defeated by Arizona, two games to none, in the NL Wild Card Series in Milwaukee.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last six full seasons (does not include 2020)....the Brewers have 573 wins since 2017, which ranks sixth in the majors and third in the National League....the teams was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in seven consecutive seasons, missing out by just a game in both 2017 and 2022.

TODAY’S STARTER: #37 - LHP DL HALL

LHP DL Hall, 25, was acquired from Baltimore, along with INF Joey Ortiz and a 2024 Competitive Balance Round A selection, in exchange for RHP Corbin Burnes on Feb. 1.....Hall enters the season as the fifth-best prospect in the organization according to *Baseball America*.....he was selected by Baltimore in the first round (21st overall) of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft from Valdosta (GA) High School.....Hall pitched parts of the last two seasons (2022-23) in the majors, including his postseason debut last season with the Orioles.....the initials “DL” stand for Dayton Lane.

ALSO SCHEDULED TO PITCH...

LHP Robert Gasser, 24, enters the 2024 season as the sixth-best prospect in the Brewers organization according to *Baseball America*.....he was 2023 International League Pitcher of the Year and Brewers Co-Pitcher of the Year as he went 9-1 with a 3.79 ERA in 26 games (25 starts) at Triple-A Nashville.....Gasser was acquired from San Diego on 8/1/22 as part of the trade for LHP Josh Hader.....he is a non-roster invitee.

LHP Hoby Milner, 33, went 2-1 with a 1.82 ERA in 73 relief appearances last season.....his 73 outings led the team and marked a career high.....he ranked among NL relief leaders in appearances (4th), ERA (5th) and WHIP (6th, 0.96).....he held opponents to a .209 batting average, marking a career best.

RHP Thyago Vieira, 31, spent most of last season at Triple-A Nashville, where he went 2-2 with a 3.35 ERA and 8 saves in 33 relief appearances.....he held opponents to a .223 batting average with 51 strikeouts in 37.2 innings.....he appeared in 2 games with Milwaukee in 2023 after joining the team on Sept. 6.....Vieira also has Major League experience with Seattle (1g in 2017) and Chicago-AL (22g from 2018-19) and in Japan with the Yomiuri Giants from 2020-22.....he was born and resides in Brazil.
