TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Is the finale (2-0) of a 3-game series vs **Nick Kappel's Royals** and the third game (2-0) of a 7-day, 6-game road trip that includes an upcoming weekend series at **Wrigley Field**.
- Following Sun afternoon's affair in **Chicago**, the Reds will return home to **Great American Ball Park** for a 6-game homestand vs the **Brewers** (6/2-6/4) and **Diamondbacks** (6/6-6/8).
- The Reds are coming off a brief 3-game homestand vs **Chc** (1-2).

SERIES NOTES:

- The Reds are 19-21 all-time vs **KC**, including 13-7 here at **Kauffman Stadium** and 4-11 at **Great American Ball Park**.
- Cin has won 8 of the last 12g vs **KC**.
- The **Royals** swept the Reds last season in a 3-game series at **GABP** (8/16-8/18)...it was **KC's** first ever 3-game sweep in **Cincinnati** and the first **Royals'** 3-game sweep of the Reds since 6/12-6/14, 2009 in **Kansas City**...of the 13 completed **Reds/Royals** series, 8 have resulted in sweeps.
- The Reds' first appearance at **Kauffman Stadium**, a 3-game sweep here in **June 1999**, was their first appearance in **KC** since the **Red Stockings** and **Cowboys** of the **American Association** met in 1889.
- The first game of that **June 1999** series was postponed because of a power failure...the Reds swept the next day's doubleheader, 9-4 and 7-4 in 10 innings, before winning the series finale, 14-3...was the first doubleheader in interleague history.

TJ MAX: OF TJ Friedl has multiple hits in each of his last 5 games (11-for-22) and in 7 of his last 8 games (16-for-35, 3 2B, 1 3B).

- His 5-game multi-hit streak is the longest by a Red since **Jonathan India's** 8-game run in 2024 (6/22-6/29).
- Began the season with 6 hits over his first 29 at-bats (.207/.258/.207)...since then is slashing .314/.400/.448.
- Enters tonight's game with 37 hits on the road (ranks fourth in majors).
- Ranks among Major League **leadoff batters** (min. 40g) in AVG (.299, 2nd), OBP (.381 2nd), SLG (.413, 8th), OPS (.794, 6th), hits (60, T5th), and times on base (88, 2nd).

ELLY GOING FOR 50: SS Elly De La Cruz last night at **KC** produced his second multi-homer game of the season and the fifth of his career, tying **Pete Rose** for most by a Reds switch hitter since 1900 (*courtesy Elias*).

- 8 of his 11 HR this season have either tied the game or put Cin ahead.
- His next homer will be the 50th of his career...at 23 years, 137 days today, would be the fifth-youngest Red to reach that mark (**Adam Dunn**: 23 years, 154 days in 2003).

REDS BATTING: Through the Reds' first 16 games (3/27-4/13), Cin batters slashed .200/.272/.320 and averaged 3.88 runs per game...in 40 games since then (4/15-5/27), the club ranks fourth in the majors with a .266 AVG, third with a .343 OBP, sixth with a .430 SLG, and eighth by averaging 5.00 runs per game.

- The Reds have scored at least 6 runs in each of their last 5g, their longest such streak since doing it in 6 straight from 7/20-7/26, 2016.

HOME (RUNS) AWAY FROM HOME: The Redlegs are averaging 4.93 runs per game on the road compared to 4.43 runs per game back home in **Cincinnati**...overall during the **Great American Ball Park** era (since 2003), the team has averaged 4.60 runs per game at **GABP** and 4.26 runs per game on the road.

- 5 times in the history of **GABP** has Cin averaged more runs per game on the road than at home (2023, 2013, 2009, 2004, 2003).
- Cin has homered 29 times in 28 games this year at home compared to 29 times in 28 road games.
- 2004 marks the only season during the **GABP** era in which the Reds hit more home runs on the road (102) than at home (92).

ALL THINGS SEEM POSSIBLE IN MAY: At 12-13 with 3 games to play in May, Cin is trying to post its second consecutive winning month (16-15 in Mar/Apr) and its third winning May in 4 years (9-18 in 2024, 14-13 in 2023, 14-13 in 2022).

- With 2 more wins this month, the Reds would guarantee their first winning record before June 1 since 2013 (34-21, .618).
- Have won 15 games in May just once in the last 11 years (2019, 15-13).
- Cin's 262 runs scored are the most scored by a Reds team before June 1 since 2013 (262r) and 2011 (275r).

LAST TIME OUT: On 5/23 was activated from the 15-day injured list and started that night vs Chc...did not factor in the decision in the 13-6 loss vs the Cubs (4.0ip, 3h, 2r/2er, 2bb, 2k, 1hr, 83TP).

- Exited the game with a 4-2 lead.
- Threw 37 pitches in the 4th inning (2h, 2r/2er, 2bb, 1hr)...marked the second time in his career that he fired as many as 37 pitches in an inning (also: 4/16/24 at Sea, 39TP in the 3rd inning).
- His 4th inning base-on-balls to Dansby Swanson marked the first time this season he walked a bottom of the order (7,8,9) batter, and the first time he did it since 8/13/24 vs StL (No. 7 batter Lars Nootbaar in the top of the 5th).
- Was on the IL since 5/8 with a right groin strain and missed 2 starts.

MAY 7 at ATL - INJURED : Exited the 5/7 game at Atl with a right groin injury after 2 warm-up pitches in the top of the 4th inning...had pitched 3.0 shutout innings to that point (2h, 6k, 53TP).

- Struck out all 3 batters he faced in the 2nd inning...was the third time this season he fanned all 3 batters he faced in an inning...has punched out all 3 batters he faced in an inning 17 times, which ranks second-most among all Major League pitchers since 2022, fewer only to Atl's Spencer Strider (22) and ranks sixth-most by a Cin pitcher in the expansion era (since 1961)...*courtesy Elias*.

ON MAY 2: Earned the 6-1 win on 5/2 vs Wsh (6.0ip, 2h, 1r/1er, 2bb, 12k, 1hr, 114TP).

- Collected his fifth quality start of the season.
- Fanned a season-high 12 batters...the only time he struck out more in a game was on 9/20/23 vs Min (14k).
- Marked his 10th career game w/ 10+ strikeouts.
- Struck out all 3 batters he faced in the 2nd inning...has fanned all 3 batters he faced in an inning 16 times, which ranks second-most among all Major League pitchers since 2022, fewer only to Atl's Spencer Strider (22).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the 6-4 win on Sat (5/24) vs Chc (5.2ip, 6h, 1r/1er, 2bb, 2k, 1hr, 83TP).

- RF Kyle Tucker's single in the 1st inning snapped Abbott's streak of starts without allowing a 1st inning hit at 9 (dating back to 8/12/24 vs StL)...had last allowed a 1st inning hit in Mia's 6-4 win on 8/7/24 at loanDepotPark (Derek Hill grand slam)...the streak matched RHP Jim Maloney 9/17/68-4/30/69) for the longest such-run by a Reds pitcher in the expansion era (since 1961).
- Allowed 3rd-inning homer to 1b Justin Turner to snap his homerless streak at 23.2 innings...went 100 batters without giving up a round-tripper.

MAY 18: Earned the 3-0 win on 5/18 vs Cle (5.0ip, 4h, 0r, 3bb, 5k, 1hb, 96TP).

- Did not issue a base-on-balls to any of his previous 45 batters until he gave up back-to-back walks to Carlos Santana and Gabriel Arias in the 1st inning...streak started on 5/1 vs StL (walk to Jordan to lead off the 4th inning).
- 28 of his 96 pitches were thrown in the 1st inning.
- It was his ninth career scoreless start of at least 5.0 innings, third-most by a Cin pitcher through their first 53 starts since 1901, fewer than only Gary Nolan (11g, 1967-68) and Ewell Blackwell (11g, 1946-47).
