## AROUND THE HORN

**\$100 MILLION IN GIVING:** The D-backs and Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation have earned a place among professional sports' most impactful philanthropic organizations in fewer than three decades, reaching a historic milestone of \$100 Million In Giving through their signature "D-backs Give Back" approach and investment in communities across Arizona...March 9 will forever be celebrated annually as "D-backs Give Back Day" as proclaimed by Arizona Governor Katie Hobbs ensuring the organization's longstanding statewide commitment will be recognized each year.

**HERE'S THE STORY:** Since March 30, the D-backs' 13 wins are tied for MLB's most (also: Padres).

- Since April 4, their 10-3 (.769) record is tied for second (also: Rays and Dodgers), behind the Padres (12-2, .857).
- The D-backs have won 4 straight games (first time since Sept. 13-16, 2025) and 8 of their last 10.
- Last 5+ straight wins: 5 from June 9-14, 2025.
- The D-backs seek their second sweep of the season (last: March 30-April 1 vs. Tigers) and second all-time vs. Blue Jays (prev: June 7-9, 2019 @ Blue Jays).
- The D-backs have won 4 straight series and won/ split 6 straight:
  - Last 4+ straight series wins: 9 straight from July 14-Aug. 14, 2024.
  - Last 6+ straight series wins/splits: 6 series, Aug. 18-Sept. 7, 2025.
- **Corbin Carroll** is the first MLB player to reach 6+ doubles, 3+ triples, 3+ homers, 16+ RBI and 11+ walks before the end of April in a season since 1920 (when RBI became an official stat).
  - Since 1920, Carroll is also the only MLB player to reach multiple seasons of 6+ doubles, 3+ triples, 3+ homers, 16+ RBI and 10+ walks before the end of April in a season (also: 2025)...only other to reach the feat is Matt Kemp/LAD (2009).

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs won 6-2 vs. Blue Jays fueled by **Corbin Carroll's** go-ahead, eighth-inning grand slam (fourth career; last: Top 6 on April 15, 2025 @ Marlins).

- Was the D-backs' 18th go-ahead grand slam in the seventh inning or later all-time and first since Josh Naylor on June 9, 2025 vs. Mariners (Bot 11).
- **Ildemaro Vargas'** eighth-inning single extended his MLB-best and career-long 17-game hit streak (since Sept. 26, 2025).
- **Geraldo Perdomo** had a season-high-tying 3 hits (also: April 14 @ Orioles).
- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.**, in his season debut, recorded his first outfield assist in the fourth inning (Myles Straw out at second base trying to extend a single).
- **Zac Gallen** (ND; 2 ER in 5.2 IP, 9 H, 0 BB, 3 K) made his fourth straight start of 5.0+ innings with 3 or fewer runs allowed.

**GRAND SLAM CORBIN:** **Corbin Carroll's** 4 grand slams are tied for third by a D-back all-time (also: Ketel Marte and Paul Goldschmidt), behind Matt Williams (7) and Eugenio Suárez (5).

- His 2 go-ahead grand slams (seventh inning or later) since 2023 are tied for most in MLB with Daniel Schneemann/CLE, Shea Langeliers/ATH, Patrick Bailey/SF, Taylor Ward/LAA-BAL, Bobby Witt Jr./KC, Cal Raleigh/SEA and James Outman/LAD.

**COMEBACK WINS:** The D-backs' 10 comeback wins lead the Majors (8 - Dodgers, Cardinals), and tied the club record for March/April (10 in 2017, '19, '25).

- 10 comeback wins are the most all-time thru the team's first 21 games...last had 11 comeback wins thru 28 games in 2017.

**VARGY FOR MVP:** **Ildemaro Vargas** is the fifth MLB player since 2017 to hit safely in 14+ straight games to start a season (last: Jacob Wilson/ATH, 15, March 27-April 12, 2025).

**THOMPSON'S START:** **Ryan Thompson's** 12 straight games without an earned run is tied for the eighth longest streak by a D-back to start their season, behind 7 others...last with 12+ straight to start their season was Shelby Miller (13 from March 28-May 1, 2025).

**HOLDING SERVE:** D-backs starters' 16 straight starts with 4 or fewer earned runs is the longest active streak in MLB, ahead of the White Sox (15 since April 3).

- Tied for the team's third longest since 2022 (also: April 29-May 16, 2022), behind 19 (April 7-27, 2022) and 21 (July 13-August 9).

**WITH RISP:** Since April 5, with runners in scoring position, the D-backs are hitting .328 (38-for-116)/.969 OPS with 12 doubles, 3 triples, 5 homers and 59 RBI.

- Since April 5, the D-backs lead the Majors with runners in scoring position in extra-base hits (1st, 20), hits (1st, 38), AVG (1st, .328), SLG (1st, .612), OPS (1st, .969) and RBI (1st, 59).

**NOT A PRESSURE PROBLEM:** The D-backs' 21 high-leverage hits to tie the game or take the lead are the most in MLB, ahead of the Rays (20) and Athletics (20) [source: Stathead].

**ROTATION ERA:** The D-backs rotation's 3.40 ERA (43 ER in 113.2 IP) is fourth in the NL to the Braves (2.60), Pirates (2.82) and Dodgers (3.06).

**5.0 IP, 4 ER:** D-backs starters' 11 straight starts of 5.0+ innings with 4 or fewer runs is the Majors' longest streak (9, Tigers, April 9-18).

- The 11 straight is the third-longest April stretch in team history to 12 games (April 4-15, 2000) and 14 games (April 16-30, 2005).

**IN RELIEF:** Since April 4, the D-backs bullpen's 2.35 ERA (15 R-12 ER in 46.0 IP) is second in the Majors, behind the Reds (1.56; 9 ER in 52.0 IP).

- Have allowed 1 or 0 runs in 8 of their last 9 games.
- Since April 4, ranks among MLB leaders in walks (1st, 8), hits (1st, 30), OBP (1st, .223), OPS (1st, .485), WHIP (1st, 0.83) and AVG (2nd, .183).

**INTERLEAGUE:** The D-backs are 7-1 vs. AL opponents (3-0 vs. Tigers, 2-1 @ Orioles, 2-0 vs. Blue Jays).

- Since Aug. 12, 2025, the D-backs' 17 wins and .773 win pct. (17-5) rank second in the Majors to the Braves (18 wins) and Yankees (.917, 11-1), respectively.

**ON DECK - WHITE SOX:** The D-backs have won 6 straight series vs. White Sox (14-4 record) since 2014, tied with the Brewers and Dodgers for the longest streak by a NL team.

- Since 2014 vs. White Sox, the D-backs' .778 win pct. (14-4) ranks second among NL teams, behind the Dodgers (.789, 15-4).

## NEXT STARTER: RHP MERRILL KELLY (1-0, 3.38)

- With 868 strikeouts as a D-back, is 7 shy of tying Curt Schilling (875) for sixth in franchise history.
- Won in his season debut on April 14 @ Orioles (2 ER in 5.1 IP, 5 H, 4 BB, 3 K).
- Second start vs. White Sox...earned the win in his lone start on Aug. 27, 2022 @ White Sox (4 ER in 7.1 IP, 5 H, BB, 7 K).
