WE'RE TALKIN' BAAASEBALL: The Giants look to win their third series of the season with a win in this afternoon's finale with the D-Backs.

- ▶ The Giants are 30-15 versus Arizona here at Oracle Park since 2019.
- ▶ This series has been pretty level since the start of last season, however, as the Giants are 8-8 in their last 16 games versus Arizona (regardless of venue)...they are 7-3 vs. Arizona here at home dating to last year and 1-5 in the desert.
- ▶ With yesterday's win, SF improved to 7-3 in day games here early in 2024...they are 3-9 in night games.

THE GIANTS BY THE BAY: SF is in the midst of its longest homestand of the season with this 10-game stint...after the D-Backs depart following today's game, the Giants will host the New York Mets for three Monday-Wednesday and the Pittsburgh Pirates for three Friday-Sunday.

- ▶ San Francisco is 5-4 through its first nine home games this year, averaging 3.3 runs/game (30 runs in those nine games) in the early going...last season, SF averaged 3.8 runs/game and went 45-36 by the bay.

LET'S MAKE A DEAL, EH: Following yesterday's game, the Giants acquired **RHP Mitch White** from the Toronto Blue Jays in exchange for cash considerations.

- ▶ In a corresponding move, **RHP Alex Cobb** was transferred to the 60-day IL to make room for White on the 40-man roster.
- ▶ White, 29, was originally drafted by the Dodgers in the second round of the 2016 draft, when current Giants President of Baseball Operations **Farhan Zaidi** was GM of the Dodgers.
- ▶ White attended Santa Clara University, was born in San Jose and went to Bellarmine College Prep in San Jose.

WADE'S WORLD: IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr. remains one of MLB's best on-base machines in 2024.

- ▶ Wade has reached base in 18 of 21 games where he's had an at-bat this season, and is slashing .388/.483/.510 with 10 runs, three doubles, a home run and six RBI.
- ▶ His .388 batting average and .483 OBP are both tops in the Majors (min. 55 PA).

PAT ON THE BACK: C Patrick Bailey tied his career-high in hits yesterday with his 4-for-4 day (two doubles, one homer and a single)...his other career four-hit game came May 26, 2023 at Milwaukee.

- ▶ According to *MLB's Sarah Langs*, Bailey (24 years, 327 days) became the third-youngest Giants player with 9+ total bases in a game as a catcher (since at least 1901)...the only younger catchers to do so were **John Orsino** on September 25, 1961 (23 years, 156 days) and **Dave Rader** on June 27, 1973 (24 years 183 days).
- ▶ The 109.7 mph homer yesterday was Bailey's hardest hit ball of his career and the third-hardest hit homer by a Giants catcher in the *Statcast*-era (since 2015)...former Giants catcher Joey Bart had the other two hardest hit homers (114.3 mph off CHC's Drew Smyly on July 30, 2022 and 111.2 mph off WSH's Sam Clay on April 29, 2022).

HIT ME: The Giants recorded a season-high 16 hits in yesterday's victory...SF had five games with 16 or more hits last season with their last one coming June 17, 2023 at the Dodgers (16 hits).

JORDAN 5s: RHP Jordan Hicks takes the ball this afternoon looking to help guide SF to a series win...SF has gone 3-1 in Hicks' four starts this year, winning his first three outings before dropping his most recent last Tuesday in Miami.

- ▶ Hicks' 1.57 ERA is third-best in the NL while his 0.91 WHIP is seventh-best and his .188 opponents average against is tied for eighth-best.
- ▶ He's allowed two runs or fewer and pitched 5.0 innings in each of his first four outings this season...the last Giants starter to begin a season with four such starts was **LHP Carlos Rodón**, who did so in six straight to open the 2022 season.
- ▶ Right-handed batters are 4-for-42 (.095) against Hicks this season with a .259 OPS...both the .095 average and .259 OPS are the best in MLB.

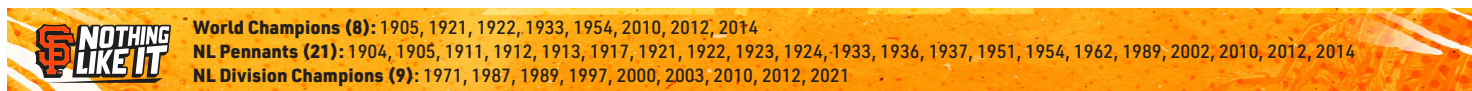
JHL DELIVERS: OF Jung Hoo Lee enters today's game with an 11-game hit streak following his 2-for-5 day yesterday...he is slashing .354/.380/.479 with three doubles, one home run, three RBI, two walks, two steals and 10 runs in that stretch (since April 7).

- ▶ The last Giants rookie to hit safely in 11 straight games was **C Patrick Bailey**, who did so in 11 straight games last year from June 17-30...the last SF rookie to hit safely in more than 11 games was **C Buster Posey**, who did so in 21 games back in 2010.
- ▶ Lee's 11-game hit streak is the fourth-longest active streak in the Majors.
- ▶ Lee's 37 hard-hit balls for this season are tied for seventh-most in MLB entering play today.
- ▶ Among batters who have seen at least 300 pitches this season, Lee is tied for the second-fewest pitches swung and missed in MLB.

WELCOME TO SF: Hicks signed with San Francisco as a free agent on January 18, 2024 on a four-year deal worth \$44 million...he was originally drafted by the Cardinals in the supplemental third round (105th overall) of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft and spent his whole career with St. Louis before being traded to Toronto in July last season for RHP Sem Robberse and RHP Adam Kloffenstein.

PUSH TO START: Is transitioning from a relief role into a traditional starting role...has made 12 career starts entering today, four of which have come this season...Hicks worked almost exclusively out of the rotation in the minor leagues, but the Cardinals ended up moving him to the bullpen to accelerate his path to the Majors.

LAST OUTING: Did not factor into the decision in the Giants 6-3 loss to the Marlins in Miami last Tuesday in Miami...he cruised through 3.0 innings before the Giants failed to convert a double play in the 4th...Hicks needed 37 pitches to finish the inning and was able to limit the damage to two runs on three hits over 5.0 total innings...it marked the first time the Giants had lost a game with Hicks on the mound.

LEADING THE LEAGUE: Hicks has posted a 1.57 ERA over his first four outings, which currently ranks as the third-best ERA in the National League behind CHC's Shota Imanaga and PHI's Spencer Turnbull...his 0.91 WHIP also ranks as the seventh-best in the senior circuit.

VS. THE DIAMONDBACKS: Has appeared in nine games (one start) against Arizona over his career, posting a 3.97 ERA (5er, 11.1ip) with 16 strikeouts...his one career start came on May 1, 2022 when he threw 3.1 innings and allowed two runs on two hits (both homers) with four strikeouts.

SMALL SAMPLE SIZE THEATER: Right-handed hitters have gone 4-for-42 (.095) versus Hicks thus far in 2024...lefties, on the other hand, are 11-for-38 (.289)...lefties have done a lot of their damage against Hicks on his sinker as they are 9-for-24 (.375) vs. the sinker while righties are 3-for-27 (.111) (SIS).

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Has thrown 69.0% first-pitch strikes over his first four starts...Hicks had a first-pitch strike % above 70% in each of his first three starts (75.0% on March 30 at SD, 72.0% on April 5 vs. SD and a season-best 76.2% on April 10 vs. WSH)... last time out versus Miami, however, Hicks only got ahead 0-1 to 52.4% of the batters he faced...the last two seasons he threw an average of 58% and 59% first-pitch strikes (SIS).

FEEL THE HEAT: Since entering the Majors in 2018, Hicks has consistently been one of the hardest throwing pitchers in the league... he has thrown 4,437 pitches in his Major League career, with 1,680 (37.9%) clocked at over 100 mph...so far this year he hasn't thrown a pitch above 100 with his fastest pitch logging in at 99.5 mph on March 30 at San Diego.

2023 SEASON: Made 65 relief appearances between the Cardinals (40 games) and Blue Jays (25 games), posting a combined 3.29 ERA (24er, 65.2ip) with 12 saves...his 81 strikeouts, 11.1 K/9.0ip, and 28.4 strikeout percentage were all career bests...threw 470 pitches at 100+ MPH (42.2% off his total pitches) and 24 pitches at 103+ MPH, both second in MLB to Jhoan Duran.

DIABETIC PHENOM: Was diagnosed with Type 1 diabetes at age 17 while in high school...he calls himself the "diabetic phenom", which was the Xbox identity he chose for himself... Diabetic phenom evolved into his brand and he now sells merchandise...he wears cleats that say "Type 1" on them when he pitches.

#58 NICKAVILA ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Cutter, Slider, Curveball
Last Game: 4/19 vs. ARI; 0.2ip, h, r, er, k, hr (13 pitches)

- ▶ Has appeared in five of SF's 18 games since having contract selected on April 1...has allowed a run in four of his five outings w/SF.
- ▶ Had his contract purchased from Triple-A on April 1 and made his MLB debut that night against the Dodgers, tossing 2.0 innings of relief...his first MLB strikeout was LAD's Shohei Ohtani in the 7th.
- ▶ Pitched in one game for Triple-A Sacramento prior to MLB promotion, earning the win with a shutout inning of relief (two strikeouts).
- ▶ Selected by Chicago-AL in the 2022 Rule 5 Draft and spent 2023 spring training with the White Sox before being returned to SF on March 28, 2023.
- ▶ Spent all of last season at Sacramento, his first Triple-A action... went 14-0 with a 3.00 ERA (24er, 72.0ip), three saves, 64 strikeouts and a 1.29 WHIP over 56 games.

#75 CAMILO DOVAL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker
Last Game: 4/20 vs. ARI; 1.0ip 3k (16 pitches)

- ▶ Since allowing two runs in 0.2 innings in his first appearance of the year on March 30 at SD in a non-save situation (SF won 9-6), Doval has made five appearances and gone 1-0-3 with three hits allowed, one walk, 11 strikeouts and no runs allowed (5.1ip).
- ▶ Earned his first career All-Star selection last season after posting a 2.63 ERA and converting 26 of his 28 save chances in 41 first half games...was the winning pitcher for the NL team after working a scoreless 7th inning.
- ▶ Wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).
- ▶ The 39 SVs were also most by a Giant since **Brian Wilson** (48 in '10).

#64 SEAN HJELLE ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider
Last Game: 4/17 at OKC (w/AAA); 1.0ip, h, 2k (10 pitches)

- ▶ Returned from his rehab assignment with Triple-A Sacramento and reinstated from the 15-day IL yesterday...missed SF's first 21 games with a right elbow strain he suffered early in spring.
- ▶ Made five rehab appearances between San Jose (A) and Sacramento (AAA)...threw 5.1 innings and allowed two runs on five hits with seven strikeouts...threw 4.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts while on his rehab stint with Sacramento (three games).
- ▶ Made 15 appearances for SF at the Major League level last year, posting a 6.52 ERA...had a really nice end to the '23 season with SF, working 7.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts over the season's final 10 days.
- ▶ 6'11" right-hander is tied for the tallest pitcher in MLB history with RHP John Rauch.

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider
Last Game: 4/20 vs. ARI; 1.0ip, 2k (12 pitches)

- ▶ Over his last seven outings dating to April 3, Miller has allowed one run on just one hit in 7.1 innings (1.23 ERA) with 12 strikeouts and one walk.
- ▶ LHBs are 1-for-13 off him early on...RHBs are 2-for-20.
- ▶ Has appeared in 10 games for SF, allowing six runs in 10.0ip.
- ▶ The southpaw made his debut on Opening Day.
- ▶ Is ranked the Giants No. 28 prospect according to *MLB.com*.
- ▶ Made 48 appearances for Triple-A last year and converted 14-of-17 save opportunities while striking out 73 batters (12.63 K/9ip).
- ▶ His 14 saves were tied for fifth-most in all Triple-A.
- ▶ Was acquired from the Phillies on January 9, 2023 in exchange for RHP Yunior Marte.

#33 TAYLOR ROGERS ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Cutter
Last Game: 4/20 vs. ARI; 1.0ip (9 pitches)
