THE TWINS: Began their seven-game roadtrip by splitting the first two games against the Cubs in Wrigley, winning Friday night and losing yesterday afternoon...today, they will play the three-game series finale on the North Side...after today's game, Minnesota will travel to Cleveland for four games against the Guardians at Progressive Field from Monday-Thursday.
☞ Twins have gone 10-6 in rubber games this season, winning each of their last six instances: June 14 vs. St. Louis, June 21 at Arizona, June 28 vs. Colorado, July 1 at Houston, July 5 at New York-AL and July 12 vs. Los Angeles-AL
☞ Twins have won seven of their last 10 and 10 of their last 15 games.

TWINS DROP GAME TWO AT WRIGLEY: The Twins lost to the Cubs yesterday afternoon at Wrigley Field by a score of 6-2...Taj Bradley (9-4) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing five runs on seven hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with three walks and six strikeouts...the offense recorded eight hits and were led by Kody Clemens, who recorded his third career multi-homer game...both homers hit off lefties, one of Matthew Boyd in the second inning and the other off Caleb Thielbar in the seventh inning.

WINNESOTA: Since June 14, the Twins have gone 17-10, posting a winning percentage of .630, tied for fourth-best in MLB since that date...below are overall MLB rankings since June 14:

MIDWEST MASHUP: The Twins and Cubs are playing each other for the 49th time in their history today...the Twins are 23-25 all-time against the Cubs, going 7-7 at Target Field, 10-15 at Wrigley Field and 6-3 at the Metrodome...Minnesota has gone 8-5 in its last 13 against the Cubs (since '21).

☞ 48 games against the Cubs are second-most against any National League opponent (Pittsburgh - 51)...this excludes Milwaukee, which was in the AL from 1969-97.
☞ In 10 career games against the Cubs, Kody Clemens is hitting .314 (11-for-35) with two doubles, five home runs, six RBI and a 1.133 OPS.
☞ In 13 career games against the Cubs, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .294 (10-for-34) with three doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, four walks and a .959 OPS.

SUMMER KEASCH MAKES ME FEEL FINE: In 12 games this month, Luke Keaschall is hitting .412 (14-for-34) with a 1.158 OPS...below is his June and July comparisons:

MAJORITY RULES: A win today and the Twins will earn their 17th series victory of the season...they have gone 16-14-1 in series play, 9-5-1 at home and 7-9-0 on the road.

☞ Twins have won eight of their last nine series, taking series from St. Louis (6/12-14), Texas (6/15-18), Arizona (6/19-21), Colorado (6/26-28), Houston (6/29-7/1), New York-AL (7/3-5), Cleveland (July 7-9) and Los Angeles-AL (July 10-12)...their only series loss in that span was a sweep by Los Angeles-NL (6/22-24).
☞ Twins are seeking their sixth-straight series win, which would mark their longest since winning six-straight from June 21-July 10, 2024 (at OAK, at ARI, at SEA, vs. DET, vs. HOU, at CWS).
☞ Twins are 8-8-0 all-time in series play against the Cubs...Twins last series win over the Cubs was at Target Field from July 8-10, 2025 at Target Field (2 of 3)...their last series win at Wrigley was September 21-22, 2021, sweeping in two.

HOTELS AND HANDSHAKES: The Twins have gone 10-4 in their last 14 road games...in those 14, they have hit .282 (142-for-503) and averaged 6.6 runs-per-game...they have outscored opponents 93-57.

☞ Twins have won four-straight road series (6/15-18 at TEX, 6/19-21 at ARI, 6/29-7/1 at HOU & 7/3-5 at NYY)...they are seeking their fifth-straight road series win today, which would mark the first time since September 1-October 1, 2023, when they won each of their final five road series at Texas, at Cleveland, at Chicago-AL, at Cincinnati and at Colorado.

WHEN LIFE GIVES YOUR CLEMENS: Kody Clemens has 18 home runs, one shy of his single-season career high of 19, set last year...seven of his home runs have come in his last 17 games...yesterday's first homer marked the 50th of his career.

☞ Since June 1, he's homered 12 times, tied with Ben Rice for second-most in baseball, trailing Junior Caminero (16).
☞ Among AL players with at least 330 plate appearances on the season, he ranks eighth in slugging percentage (.495).

TOP JEFF: In four games since returning from the IL, Ryan Jeffers has gone 4-for-15 with two doubles, one home run, five RBI and two walks...over his last 23 games, dating back to April 23, he is hitting .313 (25-for-80) with seven doubles, six home runs, 19 RBI, 14 walks, a .411 on-base percentage, a .625 slugging percentage and a 1.036 OPS.
☞ Over his last 10 road games, he has a 1.145 OPS with seven walks, four doubles, three home runs and nine RBI.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Twins have named Low-A Fort Myers outfielder/infielder Luis Fragoza and right-handed pitcher Merit Jones as their minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

☞ Fragoza, 19, played in five games for the Mighty Mussels, going 6-for-16 (.375) with three doubles, one home run, three RBI and one walk...the Valencia, Venezuela native was signed by the Twins as an international free agent in January of 2024.
☞ Jones, 22, made the start last Sunday vs. Bradenton, pitching 5.0 shutout innings, with two hits allowed, one walk and four strikeouts...the American Fork, Utah native was selected by the Twins in the 14th round of the 2025 MLB Draft out of the University of Utah.
