Pittsburgh Pirates (38-60) at San Francisco Giants (61-37)

TODAY'S GAME: The Giants and Pirates play the final game of this three-game series...SF dropped a second consecutive game to Pittsburgh last night and are now 2-4 against the Pirates this season...SF is trying to avoid being swept by the Pirates in a three-game series here in SF for the first time since August 15-17, 2016.

BEST IN SHOW: Despite consecutive losses, the Giants still enter today's game with the best overall winning percentage in the Majors at 61-37 (.622) just ahead of the Red Sox, Rays and Astros who are all 60-39 (.606)...the Giants are 2.0 games ahead of the Dodgers in the NL West and 4.5 games ahead of the Padres with 64 regular season games remaining.

BOUNCING BACK: The Giants have been resilient this season, bouncing back from losses better than any other team in MLB...SF's 24-12 (.667) record after a loss is the best in MLB.

LOVING THE LONGBALL: The Giants have hit 147 home runs this season, second-most behind Toronto's 149...SF is averaging 1.50 home runs per game in 2021, the second-best average in the Majors this year behind the Blue Jays (1.59) and has scored 52.7% of their runs off home runs (252 of 478 total runs), most in the Majors.

HOME SWEET HOME: SF's 30-15 (.667) home record is second-best in MLB behind the White Sox (35-17, .673)...with yesterday's loss, the Giants have lost just their third home series of the year (also May 21-23 vs. LAD and July 5-7 vs. STL)...the Giants started a stretch Friday night where they play 18 of their next 25 games here at Oracle Park.

STORMY SEAS: With last night's loss, the Giants have now dropped 16 of their last 22 games to the Pirates here at Oracle Park, dating back to the 2014 season... furthermore, the Giants are 16-24 (.400) overall vs. the Pirates since the start of 2015, their second-lowest winning percentage vs. any team in that span behind a 15-25 (.375) mark to the Cardinals (Stats, LLC).

EVERYONE'S CHIPPING IN: The Giants have eight players so far this year (Crawford, Yastrzemski, Posey, Belt, Flores, Ruf, Dickerson and Wade Jr.) that have reached double-digit HRs, the most players with double-digit homers on a single team just ahead of the A's and Twins (both with seven apiece)...aside from those eight, the Giants have two more guys on the cusp of 10-homer seasons (Longoria and Slater have nine HRs)...the most players the Giants have had reach double-digit homers in a season in franchise history was nine in 1952, 1958, 1987 and 2000.

TRADE DEADLINE: The MLB trade deadline is at 1:00 p.m. PT on Friday, July 30... the deadline is a day earlier than it customarily is because July 31 falls on a Saturday this year...Major League Baseball reportedly wanted to avoid having the deadline fall on a weekend when more day games typically are being played amid last-minute trade talks.

HALL PASS: Al Michaels, who was the lead announcer for the Reds in 1971 and the Giants in 1974, will be inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame today as the 45th winner of the Ford C. Frick Award.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHING MATCHUP

LHP Alex Wood aims to play the stopper today, making his 17th start of the season and second of the year against Pittsburgh...Wood beat the Pirates back at PNC Park on May 16 with 6.0 innings of one-run ball with six strikeouts in SF's 4-1 win.

RHP JT Brubaker makes his first career start against the Giants this afternoon...the only Giants player to have faced Brubaker in his young career is **Curt Casali**, who went 1-for-2 off him last season while playing for Cincinnati.

The San Francisco Giants have signed right-handed pitcher **Will Bednar**, the 14th overall draft selection from this year's First-Year Player Draft, the club announced yesterday. The Giants have come to terms with 15 of their 20 draft selections and have also signed two non-drafted free agents.

The 6-2, 229-pound Bednar was 9-1 with a 3.12 ERA (32er, 92.1ip) in 19 games (16 starts) for Mississippi State in 2021 as the Bulldogs captured their first-ever national title by defeating Vanderbilt in this year's College World Series final. Bednar was the winning pitcher in the clinching game after twirling 6.0 hitless innings with three walks and four strikeouts. After getting to Omaha, Bednar was 3-0 with a 1.47 ERA (3er, 18.1ip) in three starts. He notched 139 strikeouts this season as a sophomore, tied for sixth-most in Division 1 this year.

The Pittsburgh-area native attended Mars Area High School. His older brother, David, is currently a reliever for the Pirates this year.

2021 RECORD: 8-3, 3.77 ERA

LAST TIME OUT: Took the mound after a 13-day layoff between starts thanks to the All-Star break last Tuesday in LA and wound up with a no decision...allowed three runs on six hits in 5.0 innings while striking out seven as he left with the Giants leading 6-2...SF wound up losing the game, 8-6.

WHY DON'T YOU SLIDE?: Leaned heavily on his slider in his last outing, using 43 of them which accounted for 46.2 percent of the total pitches he threw in the game (93), his highest usage of the pitch in a single game this season...Dodgers hitters were 1x9 with five strikeouts when he ended an at-bat with the pitch...in his last two starts, opposing hitters are 2x21 (both singles) when he ends the at-bat with the offering.

BOUNCED BACK: After a five-start stretch from May 27-June 19 where Wood was 1-2 and posted a 7.88 ERA (21er, 24.0ip), he's bounced back nicely in his last four outings to post a 2.82 ERA (7er, 22.1ip) with 29 strikeouts and seven walks...SF is 3-1 in his last four starts.

VS. PITTSBURGH: Faces Pittsburgh for a second time this season after defeating them back at PNC Park on May 16...spun 6.0 innings of one-run ball and struck out six in SF's 4-1 win.

PUT THE BALL ON THE GROUND: Through his first 16 starts, Wood has amassed a 53.9% ground ball rate, which would be one of the highest rates of his career...since entering the Majors in 2013, Wood has only had a ground ball rate above 50% three times in his career (50.7% in 2015, 53.5% in 2016 and a career-best 53.8% in 2017)...his 53.9% ground ball rate is fourth-best in the National League (min. 15 games started).

FIRST TAKES: Opposing batters are hitting .150 (20x144) with five XBH off Wood the first time through the order with a .433 OPS...the second time through, however, those numbers jump up to a .288 BAA (36x125) with 14 XBH and an .867 OPS.

AT ORACLE PARK: Is holding opposing hitters to a .202 clip here at home compared to .264 on the road...the .202 batting average against at home is the 10th-lowest in the NL among NL starters.

DICK TIDROW
1947-2021

Senior Advisor to the President of Baseball Operations Dick Tidrow passed away unexpectedly on July 10 in Lee's Summit, MO. He was 74 years old.

A former American League Rookie Pitcher of the Year and 13-year Major League veteran, Dick Tidrow spent 28 seasons in the Giants front office. He came to the organization prior to the 1994 campaign, serving as the club's Major League scout for the American League. Throughout his tenure with the Giants, he held the titles of Special Assistant to the General Manager, Director of Player Personnel, Assistant General Manager for Player Personnel and Senior Vice President and Senior Advisor to the General Manager.

Prior to joining the Giants organization, Tidrow served as a special assignment scout with the New York Yankees from 1985 through 1993. The former right-handed pitcher, nicknamed "Dirt," enjoyed parts of 13 years in the Majors from 1972-84. He was honored as The Sporting News A.L. Rookie Pitcher of the Year as a starter with the Cleveland Indians in 1972, while also capturing pennant and World Series rings as a reliever with the Yankees in 1977 and 1978, respectively. He later pitched for the Cubs, White Sox and Mets. His lifetime numbers show a 100-94 record with 55 saves and a 3.68 ERA.

The San Francisco native graduated from Mt. Eden High School in 1965 and Chabot Junior College in 1967, both located in Hayward. Tidrow also served in the U.S. Marine Corps from 1968-71. He is survived by his wife, Mari Jo, three children- Andy, Matt and Richelle, his grandchild, Trista, and many relatives and loved ones on the West Coast and in the Midwest.
