



San Francisco Giants (35-37) at Chicago Cubs (34-38) RHP Jordan Hicks (4-3, 3.01) vs. RHP Javier Assad (4-2, 2.81)

TODAY'S GAME: The Giants kick off their two-series, three-state road trip today with the first of three in Chicago...SF is coming off a 3-3 homestand in which they won its series with Houston (2-1) and dropped the first two vs. Los Angeles-AL before winning yesterday's finale 13-6.

- ▶ Yesterday ended a stretch of nine straight Interleague games...the Giants are 7-11 in Interleague games this season, and 28-26 against the Senior Circuit.
- ▶ SF now plays five straight series against National League teams: Chicago (June 17-19, June 24-27), St. Louis (June 20, 22-23), Los Angeles (June 28-30) and Atlanta (July 2-4) before ending the first half with another three consecutive Interleague series (at Cleveland, vs. Toronto and vs. Minnesota).
- ▶ The Giants are 16-12 (.571) in their last 28 games dating to May 15...the .571 winning % in that time is eighth-best in MLB, and fourth-best in the NL behind Philadelphia (17-11, .607), St. Louis (17-11, .607) and Milwaukee (17-12, .586).

GET USED TO US: The Giants and Cubs will see a lot of each other through the end of June with seven games between the teams over the next 11 days...SF first plays here in Chicago for three games, plays the Cardinals for three, and then finishes this stretch with four games at home against Chicago.

- ▶ The Giants went 1-5 against the Cubs last season, including a three-game sweep at the hands of Chicago at Wrigley from September 4-6...even with that one-sided season, SF is 12-8 against CHC since 2021, outscoring them 100-76 (+24).
- ▶ **IF Wilmer Flores** has a strong history against the Cubs...he has a .500 slugging percentage in 44 career games with 22 runs, four doubles, 10 home runs and 23 RBI...his .603 slugging percentage in 19 career games at Wrigley Field is 10th-best among active players (min. 15 games).
- ▶ **OF/DH Jorge Soler**, a member of the 2016 World Series Champion Cubs, has a career .262/.340/.435 slash line in 124 games at Wrigley Field with 18 doubles, 15 home runs and 54 RBI.

ROAD WARRIORS: The Giants are 9-6 (.600) in their last 15 road games dating to May 7 at Colorado, which is the fifth-best road winning percentage in MLB over that span.

- ▶ Since May 7, SF is slashing .258/.338/.417 with its .755 OPS ranking fourth-best in MLB.
- ▶ Overall, the Giants are 15-20 (.429) in road games this season even with the fourth-most road homers this season (43), and an eighth-ranked .719 road OPS.

CAN WE SAY MORE?: **OF Heliot Ramos**, who leads SF with a 2.0 fWAR, added another multi-hit game yesterday, his 16th of the season, and his ninth in 14 June games.

- ▶ Ramos' 17 RBI this month are second-most in the MLB behind NYY's Aaron Judge (19).
- ▶ He has reached base safely in 31 of his 35 games since being recalled on May 8, logging 30 RBI in that stretch, which are fifth-most in the Majors and the most in the National League.
- ▶ In the 34 games Ramos has started, the Giants are averaging 5.21 runs per game and hitting .259, compared to 3.6 runs per games and a .237 average when he doesn't (SIS).
- ▶ Defensively, he has +6 DRS in the outfield in 298.2 innings...the +6 DRS are tied for seventh-best among MLB outfielders with teammate **OF Mike Yastrzemski**.

CARELESS RISP-ER: The Giants had a breakout game yesterday with runners in scoring position, going 9-for-19, tied for their most hits with RISP this season (also May 18 vs. Colorado).

- ▶ The Giants entered yesterday fresh off a 1-for-13 showing with RISP on Saturday, and were 11-for-66 (.167) in those situations over their previous eight games.
- ▶ SF's .304 OBP with RISP this season is fourth-lowest in MLB, while its .241 average ranks as the eighth-lowest.

9 UP: The Giants scored nine runs in the 4th inning yesterday, which is their most in an inning this season, and most since scoring nine runs in the top of the 3rd at Cincinnati on May 20, 2021...it was also the fourth time scoring nine or more runs in an inning at Oracle Park (since 2000), with the last being 10 runs vs. Pittsburgh on September 7, 2008 (4th inning).

SOLER ECLIPSE: **OF/DH Jorge Soler** was 2-for-2 with RISP yesterday with a double, a home run and four RBI.

- ▶ His four RBI were a season-high, and most since knocking in five runs on May 9, 2023 at Arizona while playing for Miami.
- ▶ In 13 games this month, Soler is slashing .313/.400/.500 with three doubles, two homers, 10 runs scored and six RBI.

MILB AWARDS: The Giants had three prospects take home weekly honors this week.

- ▶ **OF Luis Matos** (Sacramento) won PCL Player of the Week after batting .464 (13x28) with nine runs, six doubles, five home runs and 13 RBI over a six-game series at Reno.
- ▶ **RHP Alix Hernandez** (ACL Giants) won ACL Pitcher of the Week by striking out six and walking two over 5.0 hitless/shutout innings on June 12.
- ▶ **IF/OF Angel Guzman** (Giants Black) won DSL Player of the Week, going 11-for-19 (.579) with eight runs, a double, two triples, three home runs, 11 RBI and five walks in five games last week.

COUNTING THE DAYS: Following this series, the Giants will travel south to Birmingham, Alabama to play the Cardinals on Thursday...the jewel event will take place at historic Rickwood Field, the oldest professional baseball stadium in the US...first pitch is scheduled for 6:15 p.m CT (4:15 p.m. PT).

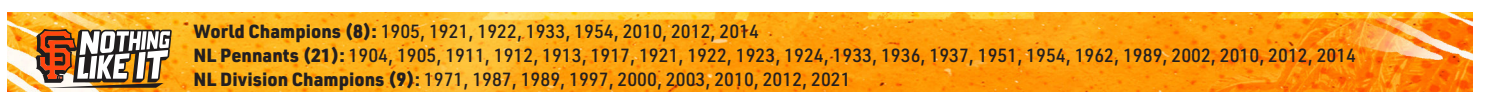
This Date in Giants History

ORANGE AND BLACK: Hicks signed with San Francisco as a free agent on January 18, 2024 on a four-year deal worth \$44 million... he was originally drafted by the Cardinals in the supplemental third round (105th overall) of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft and spent his whole career with St. Louis before being traded to Toronto in July last season for RHP Sem Robberse and RHP Adam Kloffenstein.

PUSH TO START: Has transitioned from a relief role into a traditional starting role this year...has made 22 career starts entering today, 14 of which have come this season...prior to this year, he had pitched 204 games out of the bullpen over parts of five Major League seasons...Hicks worked almost exclusively out of the rotation in the minor leagues, but the Cardinals ended up moving him to the bullpen to accelerate his path to the Majors.

LAST OUTING: Was dealing with flu like symptoms prior to his last start on June 11 against Houston...battled through his start despite feeling ill and threw 4.2 innings, allowing three runs on five hits with five strikeouts in the Giants 1-3 loss to the Astros.

THREE VS. THREE: Has posted a 0-2 record with a 5.93 ERA (9er, 13.2ip) and 1.68 WHIP over his last three starts, compared to a 1-0 record with a 2.40 ERA (4er, 15.0ip) and a 1.00 WHIP over his previous three starts.

VS. CHICAGO-NL: Is scheduled to make his 19th career appearance against the Cubs and first career start...has posted a 2-1-1 record with a 3.60 ERA (8er, 20.0ip) over 18 career starts against Chicago-NL...Hicks has appeared in five games at Wrigley Field and combined to loss 7.0 innings, allowing three runs on two hits with six strikeouts.

SEIZE THE DAY: The right-hander is 3-0 with a 1.72 ERA (7er, 36.2ip) and .189 opposing average in seven day games this season...for comparison, Hicks has a 1-3 record and 4.37 ERA in seven night starts.

ON THE GROUND: His 54.2% groundball rate is the fourth-highest in the National League (min. 50.0 innings)...he has induced 111 ground balls overall this year.

TRYING NOT TO SINK: Opponents are hitting .354 (29-for-82) against his sinker in May and June, more than 100 points higher than they hit against it in March and April when they hit .238 (15-for-63) (SIS).

SPLIT SECOND: Opponents are hitting just .141 (9-for-64) with 26 strikeouts off his splitter...he's been using the pitch 22.8% of the time this year.

VIA THE LONGBALL: Has allowed five home runs over his last six outings...prior to that, Hicks had allowed just one home run over his first eight starts.

THIRD TIME'S A CHARM: Has faired well when pitching longer into the game so far this season, with opponents going 11-for-44 (.250) the third time through the lineup.

HIGH-FIVE: Hicks has pitched 5.0+ innings in 11 of his 14 starts this season...two of three times he hasn't reach the 5th have been his last two starts when he threw 3.2 innings in Arizona on June 5 and 4.2 innings on June 11 against Houston...the only other time he hasn't reached the 5th inning was May 3 at Philly when he tossed 4.0 innings.

FEEL THE HEAT: Since entering the Majors in 2018, Hicks has consistently been one of the hardest throwing pitchers in the league...he has thrown 5,318 pitches in his Major League career, with 1,680 clocked at over 100 mph (32.0%)...so far this year he hasn't thrown a pitch above 100 with his fastest pitch logging in at 99.5 mph on March 30 at San Diego.

DIABETIC PHENOM: Was diagnosed with Type 1 diabetes at age 17 while in high school...he calls himself the "diabetic phenom", which was the Xbox identity he chose for himself...Diabetic phenom evolved into his brand and he now sells merchandise...he wears cleats that say "Type 1" on them

Pitch Arsenal: Two-Seam FB, Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Sweeper

Last Game: 6/17 vs. LAA; W, 3.0ip, 1h, 1r, 1er, 4k, 1hr (36 pitches)

- ▶ Selected from Triple-A Sacramento yesterday and made his MLB debut...earned first career win after tossing 3.0 innings.
- ▶ At 29 years, 354 days old, he became oldest Giant to make his MLB debut since **IF/OF Jason Krizan** on April 29, 2022 (32.305) & the oldest Giants pitcher since **RHP Jean Machi** on Sept. 3, 2012 (30.215).
- ▶ Yesterday, he became the oldest Giants pitcher to earn the win in his MLB debut since **Ace Adams** on April 15, 1941 (31.044).
- ▶ Is on a Major League roster for the first time in his career.
- ▶ Was 4-0 with a 2.81 ERA in 21 relief outings for Triple-A Sacramento... struck out 36 in 41.2 innings with opponents hitting .220 off him.
- ▶ Named the Pacific Coast League's Pitcher of the Month for May after going 2-0 with three saves, a 0.49 ERA (1er, 18.1ip), 17 strikeouts, an 0.98 WHIP and a .153 batting average against.
- ▶ Signed by SF as a minor league free agent on May 13, 2022 after beginning the year in Indy ball with Gastonia.
- ▶ Began his professional career pitching for the Savigny-sur-Orge Lions in French Division One in 2019 before coming back stateside to pitch for Steel City in Indy Ball in Washington, PA in 2020 during the pandemic.
- ▶ In 81 career minor league games since joining SF's organization he's posted a 3.54 ERA in 178.0 innings with 176 strikeouts.
