RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals continue their six-game homestand with to-night's opener of a three-game series against the visiting Washington Nationals. St. Louis opened its homestand by dropping two of three to the division-rival Milwaukee Brewers. With 13 games remaining, St. Louis enters today in first place in the National League Central, 2.0 games ahead of Chicago (vs. Reds) and 3.0 games in front of Milwaukee (vs. Padres).

TIME TO FLY: After a five-game losing streak on a West Coast trip to Oakland and Los Angeles-NL (August 3-7), the Cardinals are 25-11 since August 9, tied with Atlanta for most wins in the Majors while boasting a MLB-best 2.92 ERA.

THE HUNT FOR A RED OCTOBER: The Cardinals have 13 games remaining against opponents with winning records in contention for playoff positions (.535 combined win pct.), and sport a 34-37 record (.479) this season when facing opponents with winning records (6th-best in the NL). After its current series with Washington, seven of St. Louis' remaining 10 games are against the Cubs: Sept. 19-22 at Wrigley Field (4G) and Sept. 27-29 at Busch Stadium (3G).

NATIONAL NEWS: Since Busch Stadium III opened in 2006, the Cardinals' .725 home winning percentage (29-11) against the visiting Washington Nationals is their 2nd-best against any opponent, trailing only the Colorado Rockies (.745, 38-13). St. Louis has won the home series vs. the Nationals in 11 of 13 visits.

CASE OF THE MONDAYS: The Cardinals (12-2) and Yankees (12-4) co-lead Major League Baseball in wins this season on Monday, with St. Louis going a perfect 7-0 at Busch Stadium. One of their 12 Monday wins came on April 29 at Washington, a 6-3 win in the opener of a four-game series at Nationals Park.

DAK ATTACK: Dakota Hudson, who celebrated his 25th birthday yesterday, is 13-4 over his last 21 starts dating back May 18, trailing only **Stephen Strasburg** (14-3) for most wins in the Majors in that time span. Hudson (L, 6.0 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 7 K) and Strasburg (W, 6.2 IP, 6 H, 1 R, 9 K) faced off in a pitchers duel earlier this season during a 2-1 loss on May 2 in Washington. Overall, Hudson leads Major League rookies with his team-leading 15 wins, making him the first Cardinals rookie to lead the club in that category since Matt Morris (12, 1997). The last Cardinals rookie to win 16 games was **Dick Hughes** (1967)

RUNNIN' REDBIRDS: The Cardinals (105-for-131) lead the National League in stolen bases this season, two more than 2nd place Washington (103). Their 80.2% SB success rate ranks 4th in the NL and currently stands as the highest all-time in franchise history since 1951 (STATS LLC)...19 different Cardinals have stolen at least one base this season, most in MLB and T5th-most in franchise history (record held by 1906 club with 21 Cardinals).

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: Matt Carpenter has reached base safely in 15 consecutive games against Washington (April 10, 2017-present), 2nd-lon-gest among active Major Leaguers behind Mark Trumbo. Harrison Bader (.351/.432/.595) has reached base safely in all 11 career games vs. Washington (August 13, 2018-present), 7th-longest among active Major Leaguers.

A WINNING TRADITION: The Cardinals have posted their 12th consecutive winning season (2008-19), something they'd done just once previously in franchise history when they compiled 15 consecutive winning seasons from 1939-53. Only the Yankees (27 seasons) sport a longer active consecutive winning season streak in Major League Baseball.

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (September 16, 1997): Hours after signing a three-year contract extension with St. Louis, recently acquired Mark McGwire hits a home run off of the left field scoreboard in his first at-bat. McGwire's 517-foot first-inning blast, the longest ever measured at Busch Stadium II at the time, is his 52nd of the season that ties Seattle's Ken Griffey, Jr. for the Major League lead.

WASHINGTON CONNECTIONS

Nationals Manager Dave Martinez made his MLB de-Tvler Webb was born in Nassawadox, Va...graduatbut vs. St. Louis (June 15, 1986) while with Chicago. ed from Northampton High School in Eastville, Va. John Gant made his Major League debut against the Nationals (April 6, 2016) while with Atlanta.

Matt Wieters played the previous two seasons with Washington (2017-18) before signing with St. Louis this offseason.

Andrew Knizner was born in Glen Allen, Va... graduated from Hanover (Va) High School, where he was a quarterback and punter for the football team and was an All-State shortstop on the 2013 Virginia AAA State Championship team.

Cardinals pitching coach Mike Maddux served in the same role with the Nationals for two seasons (2016-17)...also pitched parts of two seasons (1998-99) for the Expos. Nationals Bench Coach **Chip Hale** played in 132 games for Memphis (AAA) in the Cardinals orga-

nization during his final season (1998).

Cardinals bullpen coach **Bryan Eversgerd** pitched in 25 games for Montreal in 1995...became an Expo via trade with St. Louis (April 5, 1995), pack-aged with pitcher **Kirk Bullinger** and outfielder **DaRond Stovall** to Montreal for pitcher **Ken Hill**. Matt Adams played parts of last seven seasons

in a Cardinals uniform (2012-18), including 26 Postseason games (2013-14)...originally selected by St. Louis in the 23rd round of the 2009 MLB Draft...later traded by St. Louis with cash to Atlanta for infielder Juan Yepez (May 20, 2017).

Max Scherzer is a native of Chesterfield, Mo graduated from Parkway Central (Mo.) High School...originally selected by St. Louis in the 43rd of the 2003 MLB Draft, but did not sign pitched at the University of Missouri (2005-07).

Joe Ross' older brother, Tyson Ross, pitched in nine games for the Cardinals last season.

Cardinals Sr. Special Asst. to the GM Bob Gebhard was a player/coach in the Expos organization from 1974-75, and coached through 1986, including on the Montreal coaching staff in 1982.

Nationals broadcaster Bob Carpenter worked 10 seasons with the Cardinals on both radio and television before joining Washington...graduated from nearby McBride (Mo.) High School...his sister. Judy Carpenter-Barada, previously served as Cardinals Director of Major League Administration. Nationals broadcaster Charlie Slowes worked three years at KMOX (1984-86).

Hall of Famer Lou Brock served as a baserunning consultant for Montreal in 1993.

Cardinals Hall of Famer and broadcaster Tim Mc-**Carver** played in 92 games for Montreal (1972). Nationals Vice President of International Opera-tions Johnny DiPuglia worked as an area scout for the Cardinals from 1990-98.

- Rookie right-hander makes his 30th career start (57th appearance) in tonight's start.
- Celebrated his 25th birthday yesterday.
- Leads all Major League rookies with 15 wins & is T3rd overall among NL wins leaders.
- Won a career-best 5-straight games Aug. 14-Sept. 5. Is trying to avoid losing twostraight decisions, something he's done just twice this year. (WSH, PHI & HOU, OAK).
- Leads the NL with 8 wins post ASB, matching Miles Mikolas' total from last season. Joe Kelly (2013) was the last Cardinal to win 9 games post ASB.
- His team-leading 15 victories makes him the first Cardinals rookie to lead the Cardinals in that category since Matt Morris (12, 1997). The last Cardinals rookie to win 15 games was Shelby Miller in 2013 (15-9) & Dick Hughes (1967) was the last to win 16.
- His .682 win pct. is best by Cards rookie since Jason Simontacchi (.688, 11-5) in 2002 and 3.38 ERA is best by STL rookie since Shelby Miller (3.06) in 2013.
- Is 8-2 with a 2.92 ERA in 15 starts at Busch Stadium this season with the Cardinals going 12-3 (.800) in his home starts
- Is 13-4 over his last 21 starts since May 18, trailing Washington's Stephen Strasburg (14-3) for most wins in MLB in that time span.
- Is the majors 1st pitcher with 15+ wins & 1+ save in a season since Randy Johnson (SEA, 1993) who was 19-8 with 1 save. The last rookie to do so (min. 25 GS) was the NY Yankees Ron Guidry (16-7, 1 save in 31 games/25 starts) in 1977.
- Since Ground Ball Pct. became a recorded stat in 1987, currently has the 10th-best single-season mark (57.4) in Cards history & highest since Jaime García (57.9) in 2016.

• Had his career-best 5-game win streak snapped in a 2-1 loss to the Rockies at Coors Field last Wed. (9/11). It was the 2nd consecutive 2-1 loss for the Cardinals at Coors.
