Zack Gelof (OAK) posted two home runs for the Mesa Solar Sox in a 9-7 victory over the Glendale Desert Dogs. He went 2-for-5 and now holds a .259/.355/.481 slash (7-for-27) through seven games of AFL action. He holds a career OPS of .861 in the Minors. Heston Kjerstad (BAL) went 3for-6 with the Scottsdale Scorpions on Thursday in a 14-8 victory over the Surprise Saguaros. Kjerstad hit a double and home run, collecting four RBI. He now holds the AFL's ninth-highest slugging percentage (.711) among qualified players.

David Fry (CLE) went 3-for-3 with the Peoria Javelinas on Thursday, driving in four of his team's six runs on the night. Through four games of AFL action, Fry holds a .385/.500/.692 batting slash (5for-13) with a double, home run and six RBI. **Braxton Fulford (COL)** hit a walkoff two-RBI double for the Salt River Rafters on Thursday. It was Fulford's third hit in the Fall League (3-for-12) and his first for extra bases. The catcher held an OPS of .829 with Single-A Fresno this year (104 games).

Hunter Stanley (CLE) pithed 3 2/3 innings of scoreless work for the Peoria Javelinas on Thursday, allowing three hits and collecting five strikeouts. Stanley now holds a 1.35 ERA and 1.35 WHIP in the Fall League over a combined two starts (6 2/3 IP).

In-N-Out Double-Double Batter - AFL Week 2 Update



Presented by In-N-Out Burger, the AFL "Double-Double Batter" promotion is back in effect for all three Fall League games today. Two of nine Double-Double Batters (22.2%) have successfully hit a double in AFL action this year: **Owen Caissie** (Chicago Cubs) and Matt McLain (Cincinnati Reds).

Introduced for the 2022 season, all AFL regular-season games on Tuesdays and Fridays feature the In-N-Out Double-Double Batter promotion. One hitter from each home team's starting lineup is selected prior to first pitch. If they hit a double that day, all spectators at that given venue receive a complementary coupon card for an In-N-Out Double-Double hamburger upon exiting the ballpark.

Arizona Fall League Alumni Spotlight

Max Scherzer (Scottsdale Scorpions, 2007; Phoenix Desert Dogs, 2008) was the 11th-overall selection in the 2006 MLB Draft out of the University of Missouri. He came to the Fall League during his second and third year as a professional while also making his MLB debut in 2008 with the Arizona Diamondbacks. Scherzer has since been named an eight-time All-Star and three-time Cy Young Award winner, currently holding a career 3.11 ERA through 2,682 2/3 MLB innings. Scherzer has pitched in a combined 15 MLB seasons between the Diamondbacks, Tigers, Nationals, Dodgers and Mets.

Fifth-ranked Dodgers prospect according to MLB Pipeline. Played exclusively with Double-A Tulsa in 2022, posting a .236/.336/.468 slash in 132 games. 86 career home runs in 367 minor league games. Made his organizational debut with the Dodgers at 17 years old. Born in La Habana, Cuba.
