AROUND THE HORN

D-BACKS USA250 PACKAGE: There is no better place to celebrate Independence Day weekend than Chase Field as the D-backs host a 2-night must-see Fireworks Spectacular presented by Bar-S on Friday, July 3 and Saturday, July 4...in recognition of America's 250th anniversary celebration, the D-backs are offering a special USA250 ticket package for the July 3 and July 4 games...fans can purchase 4 lower-level or club-level tickets for \$250 by using offer code USA250.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs have won 4 of their last 6 road games, in which 4 of those were decided by 2 or fewer runs...have allowed 3 or fewer runs in 5 of their last 6 road games.

- The D-backs have won 3 of their last 4 series (@ Reds, vs. Angels, @ Cardinals) and 4 of their last 6 on the road (@ Rockies, Giants, Reds and Cardinals).

- Ketel Marte** owns a season-high-tying 13-game on-base streak, hitting .346 (18-for-52)/.971 OPS with 5 doubles, 2 homers, 7 RBI and 5 walks...has posted 3 on-base streaks of 12+ games this season.

 - Has reached base 2+ times in 6 of his last 7 games.

- Gabriel Moreno** has reached base in a career-high 17 straight games, hitting .317 (19-for-60)/.973 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 homers, 7 RBI and 12 walks...owns the longest active streak among catchers and the second longest among catchers this season, behind Shea Langeliers/ATH (20).

- Gabriel Moreno's** 17-game on-base streak is the longest for a D-backs catcher since Carson Kelly's 18-gamer from July 4-Aug. 2, 2022.

- Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely in 15 of his last 17 games, carrying an .821 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 4 homers, 12 RBI and 6 walks.

- Corbin Carroll** has hit 5 homers in 8 career starts vs. Rays, batting .303 (10-for-33)/1.131 OPS (2B, 5 HR, 11 RBI).

 - His 5 homers are tied for most among NL players vs. Rays since 2023 (also: Willy Adames/SF).

LAST NIGHT'S FINALE RESCHEDULED: Last night's series finale @ Cardinals was postponed due to rain and was rescheduled for July 23 at 2:15 p.m. AZ, ahead of the start of the team's scheduled 3-city, 11-day trip @ Nationals, Pirates and Guardians.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 9-4 vs. Cardinals on Wednesday...first series @ Cardinals since April 17-19, 2023.

- Every D-back in the starting lineup recorded 1+ hits for the third time this season.

- Mitch Bratt**, in his MLB debut, allowed 1 run over 3.0 innings (2 H, 2 BB, 3 K).

- LuJames Groover** hit his first career homer (2 run) and combined with **Ketel Marte** to hit back-to-back homers in the fourth inning.

- Ketel Marte** went 2-for-5 and recorded his team-high-tying 13th homer.

- Gabriel Moreno** extended his career-high on-base streak to 17 straight games with a single in the first and went 1-for-2 with 1 RBI and 2 walks.

- Tommy Troy** went 2-for-5 with 1 double and 2 RBI.

- Lourdes Gurriel** went 2-for-5 with 1 double and RBI.

- Ildemaro Vargas** added a 2-run double.

MILESTONE WATCH: Ketel Marte (1,179) is 3 hits away from tying Paul Goldschmidt (1,182) for second most hits in franchise history, behind Luis Gonzalez (1,337).

FAMILIAR FOE: Jonathan Loaisiga is scoreless in 13 straight games (16.1 IP) vs. Rays, going 0-0 with 1 save, a 0.73 WHIP, with 7 hits, 5 walks and 12 strikeouts.

- In 18 career relief appearances vs. Rays, is 0-0 with 1 save, a 0.75 ERA (2 ER in 24.0 IP), opponent .148 AVG (12-for-81)/.480 OPS, 7 walks and 23 strikeouts.

BULLPEN SPOTLIGHT: Kevin Ginkel is scoreless in 11 of his last 12 road games, going 3-0 with a 0.84 ERA (1 ER in 10.2 IP), with 9 hits, 2 walks and 13 strikeouts.

- Taylor Clarke** is scoreless in 16 of his last 17 road games, going 1-0 with a 1.04 ERA (2 ER in 17.1 IP), opponent .175 AVG (10-for-57)/.478 OPS with 5 walks and 7 strikeouts.

DOUBLE UP: The D-backs' 79 road doubles are second most in the Majors, behind the Giants (94)...have recorded 4 doubles in each of their last 2 games.

STAY CALIENTE GABI: Gabriel Moreno has reached base safely in 28 of his last 31 games, hitting .324 (36-for-111)/.935 OPS with 6 doubles, 5 homers, 17 RBI and 18 walks, including 2+ times in 18 of them.

ALL-STAR CALIBER: Ketel Marte ranks among NL second basemen in SLG (2nd, .461), homers (2nd, 13), total bases (2nd, 141), extra-base hits (2nd, 32) and RBI (2nd, 47)...defensively, is the only qualified second baseman without an error (0 E in 536.1 inn.).

- Corbin Carroll** ranks among NL outfielders in extra-base hits (T-1st, 39), triples (1st, 9), SLG (2nd, .537), OPS (3rd, .901) and total bases (4th, 154)...defensively, his 7 Outs Above AVG rank third among NL outfielders, behind Pete Crow-Armstrong/CHC (15) and Jacob Young/WSH (10).

- Gabriel Moreno**, since May 13 [min. 100 PA] leads NL catchers in AVG (.324), OPS (.935), OBP (.421), SLG (.514), walks (T-1st, 18) and ranks in homers (T-2nd, 5) and hits (2nd, 36)...defensively [min. 45 G], is tied for the second fewest errors (1) with Tyler Stephenson/CIN, behind William Contreras/MIL (0).

- Nolan Arenado** ranks among NL third basemen in SLG (2nd, .387), doubles (2nd, 14) and homers (T-4th, 8)...defensively, has the second fewest errors (3), behind Manny Machado/SD (2).

BATSTRAVEL: Gabriel Moreno has reached base in 15 of his last 16 road games, hitting .386 (22-for-57)/1.093 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 homers, 11 RBI and 11 walks.

- Ketel Marte** has a 7-game road hitting streak, batting .367 (11-for-30)/.991 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 homer, 2 RBI and 3 walks...has reached safely in 14 of his last 16 road games, hitting .329 (23-for-70)/.885 OPS with 6 doubles, 2 homers, 11 RBI and 7 walks.

- Corbin Carroll** has reached in 16 of his last 19 road games with an .803 OPS (4 2B, 4 HR, 7 RBI, 10 BB).

VS. RAYS: The D-backs will play their sixth ever series @ Rays and first since 2024.
