PENNANT CHASE FEVER \$15 TICKETS FOR GIANTS SERIES: The D-backs are playing pennant race baseball for the third straight year and calling on The Valley's faithful fans to pack the park for this pivotal series by offering Pennant Chase Fever \$15 tickets all-in (includes fees) for lower-level bleacher and bullpen tickets as well as upper-level tickets for this series against the Giants at <u>dbacks.com/tickets</u> or by calling 602.462.4600.

SNAKE BITES: The D-backs are 2.0 games out of the final Wild Card spot behind the Mets and a half-game behind the Giants (1.5 games out) while leading the Reds (2.5 games out) by a half-game.

- · Zac Gallen's 999 strikeouts as a D-back are 1 shy of becoming the third D-back to reach 1,000 whiffs with Randy Johnson (2,077) and Brandon Webb (1,065).
- The D-backs are 5-5 vs. Giants (2-2 at home) this year.
- Since August 1, the D-backs' 24-17 (.585) record is third in the NL to the Phillies (28-14, .667) and Brewers (27-15, .643).
- The D-backs' .552 remaining strength of schedule is the hardest in the Majors ahead of the Twins (.548), Rays (.547), Cardinals (.544) and Dodgers (.533).

LAST GAME: The D-backs 6-4 win @ Twins was their first series win @ Target Field (second @ Twins).

- Nabil Crismatt got his third win with 5.0 innings, 2 unearned runs, 3 hits, 0 walks and 4 strikeouts...it was just the second start by a D-back this season with 5.0+ innings, 3 or fewers hits and 0 walks (also: Zac Gallen on April 2 @ Yankees, 6.2 IP, 3 H, 0 BB).
- James McCann was 2-for-4 with a season-high 4 RBI on a RBI single in the second inning and a 3-run homer in the fourth inning.

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs recalled RHP **Juan Morillo** (No. 67) from Triple-A Reno and designated RHP Anthony DeSclafani for assignment.

WILD CARD HUNTING: On August 1, the D-backs trailed by 10.0 games in the NL Wild Card race but now sit 0.5 game back of the Giants (fourth in Wild Card) and 2.0 back of the Mets (third in Wild Card).

STACKING DUBS: The D-backs are 3-1 in their last 4 games and 11-6 since Aug. 27, highlighted by a pair of 4-game win streaks from Aug. 27-30 @ Brewers and Dodgers and Sept. 2-6 vs. Rangers and Red Sox.

• Are 6-1-1 in their last 7 series and 9-3-1 in their last 13.

ON THE BUMP: Zac Gallen, in his last 5 home starts vs. Giants (team is 5-0), is 4-0 with a 2.64 ERA (11 R-9 ER in 30.2 IP), an opponent .198 AVG (21-for-106)/.578 OPS, 8 walks and 38 strikeouts.

• In his last 5 starts vs. NL West, since July 1, is 4-1 with a 1.99 ERA (9 R-7 ER in 31.2 IP), an opponent .193 AVG (21-for-109)/.595 OPS, 10 walks and 36 strikeouts.

YEAR OF THE SNAKE: Geraldo Perdomo's 6.3 bWAR (Baseball-Reference.com) leads NL position players and is third in the Majors to Aaron Judge/NYY (8.2) and Bobby Witt Jr./KC (6.4) and ahead of Cal Raleigh/SEA (6.3).

• Perdomo's 6.3 fWAR (FanGraphs.com) is third in the NL to Trea Turner/PHI (6.7) and Shohei Ohtani/LAD (6.7) and ahead of Corbin Carroll/AZ (5.9).

START ME UP: D-backs starters, since Aug. 27, lead the Majors with a 2.69 ERA, tied for first with 11 quality starts, third with 9 starters wins, tied for third with 97.0 innings and eighth with an opponent .656 OPS.

- In their last 17 starts (11 quality), the starters are 9-1 with a 2.69 ERA (33 R-29 ER in 97.0 IP), opponent .236 AVG, 27 walks and 73 strikeouts...the team is 11-6 vs. Brewers, Dodgers, Rangers, Red Sox, Giants, Twins.
- D-backs starters' season-high-tying 6 straight quality starts from Sept. 1-7 (also: April 8-15) were their longest since 8 straight from Sept. 9-16, 2017.

GABI DISHIN' IT: Gabriel Moreno, in his last 18 games since being reinstated from the Injured List on Aug. 22. is batting .355 (22-for-62)/1.011 OPS with 3 doubles, 4 homers, 17 RBI and 7 walks.

• Among NL players since Aug. 22, is sixth with a .355 AVG, tied for eighth with a .414 OBP, ninth with a 1.011 OPS and 10th with a .597 SLG.

DYNAMIC DUO: Geraldo Perdomo (19 HR, 26 SB) and Corbin Carroll (30 HR, 28 SB) look to become the seventh teammates in baseball history with 20+-HR, 30+-SB seasons: Paul Goldschmidt and Jean Segura in 2016, Jose Cruz and Raul Mondesi/TOR in 2001, Jeff Bagwell and Craig Biggio/HOU in 1997, Dante Bichette and Ellis Burks/COL in 1996, Howard Johnson and Darryl Strawberry/NYM in 1987 and Barry Bonds and Andy Van Slyke/PIT in 1987.

 The duo look to become the second D-backs teammates with 30+ stolen bases in a season: 2016's Jean Segura (33) & Paul Goldschmidt (32).

(C7 FUN: Corbin Carroll (30 HR, 28 SB) is looking to become the first D-back with a 30+-HR/30+-SB season.

- His 75 extra-base hits are tied for third in the Majors with Kyle Schwarber/PHI (75) and Cal Raleigh/SEA (75) to Shohei Ohtani/LAD (78) and Aaron Judge/NYY (78)...is 2 extra-base hits shy of moving from tied for ninth to tied for third on the franchise list with Ketel Marte (77 in 2019) behind Luis Gonzalez (100 in 2001, 80 in 2000).
- His 101 runs scored have him as 1 of 4 players to reach the mark each of the last 3 seasons with Shohei Ohtani/LAD, Francisco Lindor/NYM and Kyle Schwarber/PHL

A LEAP IN PRODUCTION: Geraldo Perdomo is 5 RBI shy of his first career 100 RBI season and becoming the first player since Carlos Gonzalez in 2009-2010 with a season of 100+ RBI the year following recording 40 or fewer RBI with 300+ PA (100 RBI rookie seasons excluded) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

HIT, RUN, SCORE: Since Sept. 1, the D-backs' 5.25 runs per game are third in the NL behind the Phillies (6.00) and Giants (5.92) and ahead of the Dodgers (5.17).

- Since Sept. 1, the D-backs' 20 runs in Innings 1-2 are third in the NL to the Reds (23) and Padres (21) while their 21 runs in Innings 7 or later are tied for third in the NL with the Dodgers (21) behind the Phillies (25) and
- In the last 12 games since Sept. 1, D-backs 6-9 hitters are third in NL with a .274 AVG and 30 RBI, fourth with a .715 OPS and tied for fifth with 15 extra-base hits.

NEXT STARTER: LHP EDUARDO RODRIGUEZ (8-8, 4.98)

- In his last 3 starts, is 3-0 with a 0.49 ERA (1 ER in 18.1 IP), an opponent .161 AVG (10-for-62)/.483 OPS, 8 walks and 14 strikeouts.
- Tossed 6.1 scoreless frames (2 H, 2 BB, 6 K) in the 5-3 win @ Giants in his last start on Sept. 10.
- Has made 4 career starts (2 quality) vs. Giants, 2 at home and 2 on the road.

AT A GLANCE: Seventh season with the D-backs.

- D-backs' Most Valuable Pitcher by the Arizona BBWAA the last 3 seasons (2022-24) and 4 of the last 5 seasons (2020, '22-'24).
- 2023 NL All-Star starting pitcher.
- Finished in Top 5 in NL Cy Young Voting in 2023 (3rd) and 2022 (5th).

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: His 999 strikeouts are 1 shy of becoming the third D-back pitcher to reach the 1,000 mark.

- Is 10.0 innings shy of eclipsing 1000.0 career.
- Has quality starts in 6 of his last 8 starts, going 4-2 with a 2.83 ERA (15 ER in 47.2 IP), opponent .213 AVG (38-for-178)/.625 OPS, 13 walks and 36 strikeouts.
- Has had 3 quality starts in his last 4 home starts vs. Giants, going 4-0 with a 2.81 ERA (9 R-8 ER in 25.2 IP), opponent .205 AVG (18-for-88), 0.97 WHIP, 7 walks and 33 strikeouts.
- Has tossed 6.0+ innings in 5 straight starts, 9 of his last 10 starts and 11 of his last 13 starts.
- His 63 wins are third in franchise history, ahead of Merrill Kelly (62) and behind Brandon Webb (87) and Randy Johnson (118).
- Among NL starting pitchers since July 1, his 77.2 innings are seventh (leader is Cristopher Sánchez/PHI at 88.2 IP).

VS. GIANTS: 19th career start, ninth @ Chase Field.

- Took the loss in his last start on Sept. 9 @ Oracle Park, allowing 5 runs on 5 hits and 3 walks with 3 strikeouts over 6.2 innings.
- Has struck out 10+ batters in consecutive home starts (21 strikeouts).
- In 11 starts (7 quality) since 2022, is 6-2 with a 3.16 ERA (26 R-24 ER in 68.1 IP), opponent .209 AVG (50-for-239)/.635 OPS, 19 walks and 78 strikeouts.

APPROACHING 1,000TH K AS A D-BACK: With 1 strikeout, will become the third pitcher to reach 1,000 strikeouts as a D-back...his 999 strikeouts currently rank third in franchise history, behind Randy Johnson (2,077) and Brandon Webb (1,065).

- Recorded his 1,000th career strikeout on July 21 vs. Astros in the fourth inning (Brice Matthews).
- Second pitcher to debut in 2019 and reach 1,000+ career strikeouts, joining Dylan Cease (source: Elias Sports Bureau).
- Among all pitchers since 2019, his 1,042 strikeouts are 11th...Top 3 are Zack Wheeler/PHI (1,289), Aaron Nola/PHI (1,266) and Gerritt Cole/NYY (1,241)...teammate Corbin Burnes/AZ (1,079) is 10th.

10+ WINS: Is 1 of 4 D-backs to have 4+ consecutive 10+-win seasons with Randy Johnson (1999-2002), Brandon Webb (2005-08) and Zack Greinke (2016-19).

5.0+ INNINGS: Dating back to April 13, has pitched at least 5.0 innings in 27 straight starts, the second-longest streak in the Majors this season behind Bryan Woo/SEA (29 games) and ahead of Jacob deGrom/TEX (25).

• The 27-game streak is the longest by a D-back pitcher in a single season since Merrill Kelly went 29 straight games of 5.0+ innings from April 6-Sept. 30, 2023.

VS. NL WEST: Has won 5 of his last 6 starts vs. NL West opponents...in those starts, has a 3.44 ERA (16 R-14 ER in 36.2 IP) with 11 walks and 41 strikeouts.

- In 9 starts in 2025, has gone 5-2 (team is 6-3) with a 4.70 ERA (30 R-28 ER in 53.2 IP) and 57 strikeouts.
- In 30 starts from 2022-24 vs. NL West went 13-4 with a 3.37 ERA (69 R-66 ER in 176.1 IP), an opponent .212 AVG (137-for-645)/.630 OPS, 50 walks and 201 strikeouts.

AT HOME: In his last 6 home starts (5 quality), is 3-2 with a 2.92 ERA (13 R-12 ER in 37.0 IP), opponent .210 AVG (29-for-138), 0.95 WHIP, 6 walks and 37 strikeouts.

VS. RIGHTIES: In his last 9 starts, is holding righties to a .184 AVG (19-for-103)/.552 OPS with 8 walks and 26 strikeouts.

VS. LEFTIES: In his last 5 starts, is holding lefties to a .190 AVG (11-for-58)/.599 OPS with 5 walks and 13 strikeouts.

INNING BREAKDOWN: In his last 7 starts, in innings 3-6, has limited opponents to 7 runs in 27.0 innings with an opponent .158 AVG (15-for-95)/.506 OPS, 4 walks and 19 strikeouts.
