IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM: **OF Akil Baddoo** (left quad), **OF Jackson Chourio** (left hand), **LHP Jared Koenig** (left elbow), **RHP Quinn Priester** (right thoracic outlet), **1B Andrew Vaughn** (left hand), **RHP Brandon Woodruff** (right shoulder), **OF Christian Yelich** (left groin), **LHP Rob Zastryzny** (left shoulder) and **LHP Angel Zerpa** (left forearm) are on the injured list....Baddoo and Zastryzny are on the 60-day IL.

MANAGER: **Pat Murphy** (356g, 208-148, .584) is in his third season as Brewers manager....he was voted NL Manager of the Year in 2024 and 2025....he is one of four managers ever to win Manager of the Year in consecutive seasons, joining the Braves' Bobby Cox (2004-05), Rays' Kevin Cash (2020-21) and Guardians' Stephen Vogt (2024-25)....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he signed a multi-year contract extension on 2/20/26.

COACHES: Returning from the 2025 staff is offense & strategy coordinator **Jason Lane** (11th season/1st in current role), pitching coordinator **Jim Henderson** (5th season/1st in current role), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (4th season/3rd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (8th season), bullpen coach **Charlie Greene** (3rd season), lead hitting coach **Eric Theisen** (2nd season/1st in current role) and third base coach **Matt Erickson** (3rd season/1st in current role)....assistant pitching coach **Juan Sandoval**, hitting coach **Guillermo Martinez**, hitting coach **Daniel Vogelbach** and first base coach **Spencer Allen** are all in their first seasons on the coaching staff.

IN THE STANDINGS (38 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 16, **SECOND:** 1, **THIRD:** 5, **FOURTH:** 10, **FIFTH:** 6....the Brewers are currently in fourth place, trailing the first-place Cubs by 2.5 games and the second-place Reds and Cardinals by 1.5 games....are ahead of the fifth-place Pirates by 1.0 game.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 10-8 at home, going 4-2-0 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 8-6 on the road, going 3-2-0 in series play, including this series against the Nationals.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 11 replay challenges this season, going 9-2....their last challenge (won) came on 4/29 vs. Arizona as a safe call at second base involving Nolan Arenado was overturned.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have qualified for the postseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three seasons in a row....the team was just two games away from making the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by a single game....Milwaukee has won the NL Central in four of the last five seasons and three seasons in a row.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last eight full seasons (2017-25)....this does not include the shortened 2020 season....the Brewers have 781 wins since 2017, which ranks fourth in the majors behind the Dodgers (873), Astros (819) and Yankees (810).

HENDERSON AT A GLANCE: Logan Henderson, 24, will be making his second start of the season for the Brewers....Henderson made his first start in the second game of a doubleheader on 4/4 at Kansas City and had no decision in the Brewers' 8-2 loss (2ip, 3h, 2r, 2er, 1bb, 3k, 1wp, 35 pitches)....he is also 2-0 with a 1.02 ERA in 5 games/3 starts this season at Triple-A Nashville (17.2ip, 12h, 2r, 2er, 9bb, 26k, 0hr)....Henderson was selected by Milwaukee in the fourth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of McLennan (TX) Community College, where he was named 2021 NJCAA Division I Pitcher of the Year in his lone season (17g, 14gs, 10-2, 1.66era, 97.2ip, 169k)....he entered the 2026 season as the sixth-best prospect in the organization according to *Baseball America*.

LAST SEASON: Henderson spent most of last season at Triple-A Nashville, where he went 10-4 with a 3.59 ERA in 16 games/15 starts....he held International League opponents to a .218 batting average with 87 strikeouts in 77.2 innings....Henderson also had three stints with the Brewers (4/15-4/20, 5/14-5/25 and 8/3-8/7) as he made his Major League debut and went 3-0 with a 1.78 ERA in 5 starts....the team went 5-0 in his starts....he had 1 quality start....opponents batted .187 (17-for-91, 3hr).

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER: Henderson is 23-14 with a 3.11 ERA in 65 games/62 starts (269ip, 198h, 97r, 93er, 80bb, 346k, 30hr)....he was limited to 7 starts in his first season (2022) due to a fractured right elbow....he was credited with the best control and best changeup in the organization by *Baseball America* prior to the 2024 season.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 2-0 with a 0.82 ERA in 2 starts, both coming last season (11ip, 1er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 1-0 with a 3.31 ERA in 4 starts (16.1ip, 6er)....is 0-0 with a 9.00 ERA in 1 start this season.

CAREER vs. NATIONALS: His lone outing vs. Washington came in a start on 8/3/25 at Nationals Park (4.1ip, 3h, 1r, 1er, 2bb, 4k)....he had no decision in a 14-3 win.

ODDS & ENDS: Henderson graduated from Cinco Ranch (TX) High School....he enjoys golf, playing basketball and spending time with his family.
