RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a brief three-game road trip at Yankee Stadium this afternoon following last night's 5-3 setback...they went 4-3 on their seven-game homestand against the Giants (2-1) and Angels (2-2)...the Rays have alternated wins and losses over their last seven contests (3-4) following a 5-1 stretch from April 6-12...they are 4-4 so far in a stretch of 13 consecutive games without an off day that concludes on

Last night, the Rays suffered a 5-3 loss despite churning out a season-high 14 hits,

Last right, the Rays surfered a 5-3 loss despite churning out a season-righ 14 fits, their most since Oct. 1, 2023 at TOR (16)...all nine Rays starters recorded a hit for the first time since Sept. 24, 2023 vs. TOR...the Rays hit. 378 (14-for-37) in the loss, but went 5-for-23 (.217) with runners on vs. 9-for-14 (.643) with the bases empty. The defeat marked the first time in club history the Rays lost despite out-hitting an opponent by nine or more (Elias)...it also dropped them to 7-2 in games decided by two runs or fewer this season.

by two runs or fewer this season. The Rays dropped to 1-6 in series openers, including 0-3 on the road, after posting the majors' fourth-best record in such contests in 2023 (34-18). Thursday's 2-1 win over the Angels was the 750th of **Kevin Cash's** career...he is five victories shy of surpassing his predecessor, **Joe Maddon** (754), as the Rays alltime managerial wins leader. The Rays need a win today to avoid just their second road series loss in their last 13 tries dating back to July 28-30 at HOU...they are 10-1-1 in road series over that span, with the lone defeat coming from Sept. 1-3, 2023 at CLE (2-1).

RECENT TRANSACTIONS—Prior to today's contest, the Rays selected **RHP Erasmo Ramírez** from Triple-A Durham, optioned **LHP Jacob Lopez** to Durham and transferred **INF Taylor Walls** (recovery from right hip surgery) to the 60-day IL...Ramírez, 33, has made 139 of his 314 career appearances with the Rays...he was with the Rays from July 30–Sept. 30 last season, going 1-0 with a 6.48 ERA (33.1IP, 24ER) over 15 games (2GS).

DOOMED BY DEFENSE—All five Yankees runs in yesterday's defeat were unearned tallies pushed across in the 7th frame following errors by Yandy Díaz and Curtis Mead... it marked the Rays first time allowing 5+ unearned runs in a game since May 20, 2022 at BAL (5)...it also marked the most unearned runs the Rays have permitted in a game in which they did not allow an ER, surpassing the previous mark of four (May 19, 2009 vs. OAK), and signaled just the ninth time the Rays have lost a game without allowing an ER (last: May 29, 2023 at CHC).

Over their last four games, the Rays have committed four errors...they had totaled four miscues in their previous 12 contests from April 2-15.

The Rays have yielded 11 unearned runs, tied for fourth most in the AL behind the Red Sox (26), Tigers (16) and White Sox (15)...their 47 unearned tallies last season were tied for third fewest in MLB behind the Rangers (33) and Twins (35).

IN THE BOX—The Rays are averaging 3.0 runs per game in their last three contests despite batting a collective .306 (30-for-98) in that timeframe...on the season, they own the AL's fifth-highest average (.249) while ranking 10th in slugging pct. (.369)...they also sit third in the AL in singles (128), but are tied for 10th in extra-base hits (47)...the Rays have been held to 2 XBH or fewer in five straight games, their longest streak since Sept. 10-13 (G2), 2022 (5G)...their last drought of 6+ games came from May 26-31, 2022 (6G).

Over their last five games, the Rays are 6-for-43 (.140) with RISP...this comes on the heels of posting a .312 (24-for-77) RISP average from April 2-13 (10G).

Rays hitters have been at their best in late-game situations, batting an AL-leading .323 (53-for-164) from the 8th inning on, third in the majors behind the Braves (.352) and Mets (.325)...their .226 (122-for-540) average in innings 1-7 ranks 24th.

ON THE MOUND—Rays pitching has posted a 2.08 ERA (39.0IP, 9ER) over the last four games after producing a 7.33 ERA (27.0IP, 22ER) in their previous three contests (April 13-15)...however, they have been charged with eight unearned runs in that stretch, their most over any four-game span since April 23-27, 2022 (8)...they have allowed only 1 ER over their last two games (17.0IP)...on the season, their 4.49 ERA ranks 24th in the majors and signals their highest mark through 21 games since 2018 (4.71).

The Rays rotation ranks fourth in the AL/sixth in the majors with a 3.46 ERA (106.2IP, 41ER)...the rotation owns a 2.30 ERA (31.1IP, 8ER) over the last six games and has permitted 1 ER in its last 11.1 IP.

Despite holding opponents to 1 ER in their last 17.0 IP, the bullpen's 5.81 ERA (83.2IP, 54ER) is second highest in the majors behind the Giants (6.03)...they have allowed at least one run in 19 of the Rays 21 contests.

The Rays have yielded 13 SB over their last four games, the most in any four-game span in club history...the current team record over a five-game span is 14 SB (April

span in club history...the current team record over a five-game span is 14 SB (April 5-9, 2011)...opponents are 25-for-28 (89.3%) on SB attempts against the Rays—only the Mets (26-for-26) have allowed more steals...opposing baserunners have been successful on 12 straight and 21 of their last 22 SBA against the Rays.

HOMER (UN)HAPPY—The Rays have been tagged for 30 HR, tied with the Blue Jays for the most in the majors...it marks the third-most homers allowed through 21 games in club history, trailing only the 2003 and 2000 Devil Rays (31HR)...the 2000 club holds the record through 22 contests (32HR)...the Rays have allowed at least 1 HR in 16 of 21 games, going 6-10 in those affairs compared to 5-0 when holding the opposition homerless...on the season, 48 of the 106 (45.3%) runs allowed by Rays pitching have come off the 30 HR.

Meanwhile, the Rays offense has tallied 3 HR in their last five games since launching a season-high 4 HR on April 14 vs. SF.

They have 10 HR in their last 15 games since April 3, tied with four other clubs for the fourth fewest in the majors, ahead of only the White Sox (4HR), Tigers and Cardinals (9HR each)...from Opening Day through April 2, their 8 HR tied the Astros and Royals for the AL lead.

HOT HITTERS—Amed Rosario has gone 19-for-48 (.396) with 2 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR and 9 RBI during his 11-game hitting streak, the longest active run in the AL and one game shy of his career-best 12-game streak (June 5-18, 2022)...he has multiple hits in five of his last seven games...his average has increased from .167 on April 3 to .333 today, sixth highest in the AL...his .396 average since the streak started on April 4 paces the AL.

Yandy Díaz has hit safely in six of his last seven games, going 8-for-29 (.276) with 2 2B...in his previous five games, he went 1-for-21 (.048)...he owns a 23-game onbase streak against the Yankees dating back to Aug. 15, 2022.

Richie Palacios, who homered in his first career game at Yankee Stadium yesterday, is batting .400 (10-for-25) with 2 2B, 1 HR and 2 RBI in his last eight games.

NEW YORK, NEW YORK—The Rays and Yankees continue a 13-game season series today in the Bronx ...the Rays went 8-5 against the Pinstripes in 2023, taking four of seven games in New York...they have won three of the last four season series vs. the Yankees since 2020, posting the best record against New York by any AL team over that span (35-27/.565)...they went 38-57 (.400) from 2015-19.

TODAY'S START-Eflin makes his fifth start of the season, including his second on the road...has gone 9-6 with a 3.10 ERA (145.0IP, 50ER) in 25 career April starts, his lowest mark in any month during his career...in his last six day game starts since July 16, 2023, Eflin is 1-4 with a 9.47 ERA (25.2IP, 27ER).

LAST TIME OUT—He did not factor into the decision on April 15 vs. Los Angeles-AL...worked a season-high-tying 6.1 scoreless innings, scattering six hits with no walks and five strikeouts.

He retired 11 consecutive batters in the 2nd through 6th innings before **Mike Trout's** two-out single in the 6th frame. It marked his 13th career start working 6.0+ innings without allowing a run, including his first since Aug. 30, 2023 at MIA (6.1IP, 4H, 0R, 0BB, 4 SO).

NEW YORK STATE ON MIND—In five career starts opposite New York, Eflin is 3-1 with a 1.86 ERA (29.0IP, 6ER) and 36 strikeouts against five walks...in two starts at Yankee Stadium last season, he went 2-0 with a

3.00 ERA (12.0IP, 4ER), striking out 14 batters against one walk.

His 1.86 ERA against the Yankees is the fifth lowest in the majors among all active pitchers (min. 25.0IP) behind TOR Chris Bassitt (1.00), BOS Brayan Bello (1.45), MIN Diego Castillo (1.78) and LAD Clayton Kershaw (1.85).

BEAST OF THE EAST—In 22 career appearances (20GS) against the AL East, Eflin is 9-7 with a 4.18 ERA (116.1IP, 54ER)...since joining the Rays in 2023, he has gone 6-3 with a 3.56 ERA (60.2IP, 24ER) with 61 strikeouts against only eight walks.

RUNNING ON FUMES—In innings 1-4, Eflin has posted a 2.25 ERA (16.0IP, 4ER) and held opponents to a .190/.203/.345 (11-for-58) slash line... from the 5th inning on, he owns a 9.82 ERA (7.1IP, 8ER) and .405/.436/.649 (15-for-37) opponent line...15 of Eflin's 20 SO have come in the first four frames

When his pitch count resides between 1-60, opponents are 12-for-72 (.167) against him...once he surpasses the 60-pitch mark, opposing hitters have gone 14-for-23 (.609).

THIS AND THAT-Eflin has worked at least 5.0 IP in each of his first four

starts to open the season...he did so in each of his first 11 starts in 2023.

In his first 17 starts with the Rays, Eflin went 10-4 with a 3.25 ERA (102.1IP, 37ER) and .225 opp. average...in his last 18 starts since the 2023 All-Star break, he is 7-6 with a 4.01 ERA (98.2IP, 44ER) while

allowing a .255 opp. average.

Opponents are batting .217 (15-for-69) against Eflin with no baserunners compared to 11-for-26 (.423) with at least one man on the basepaths.

QUALITY CONTROL—He has produced the lowest walk rate in the majors since 2020 at 4.0 pct. (min. 1,500BF), ahead of Zack Greinke (4.4%)...he has walked two batters or fewer in each of his last 38 starts, the longest active streak in the majors, ahead of SEA George Kirby (35GS).

Posted a 68.9 pct. strike rate last season, second highest among qualified pitchers behind MIA Sandy Alcantara (70.1%).

Effin did not allow 10+ hits or 3+ walks in any of his 31 starts last season...per OptaStats, it marked the most such starts in a season without recording either of those statistics in the modern era (since

without recording either of those statistics in the modern era (since 1900)...the next closest pitcher is CLE **Josh Tomlin** in 2016 (29). His 7.75 SO/BB ratio in 2023 ranked second in the majors behind Kirby (9.05) and was the second-best mark by a Rays pitcher behind **David Price's** 2014 campaign (8.22).

PRETTY EF-LIN GOOD—Eflin recorded 16 victories last season, tying TOR Chris Bassitt for the most in the AL...he became the third Rays pitcher to lead the AL (or tie) in wins, joining Blake Snell (21, 2018) and David Price (20, 2012 - T1st)...the 16 wins were tied for fifth most in Rays history...his 177.2 innings were the most by a Rays pitcher since Charlie Morton in 2019 (194.2)...he joined Corey Kluber in 2022 (31GS) as the only Rays to make 30+ starts in a season since 2020.
