STREAKING IN SEPTEMBER-Littell has thrown back-to-back scoreless STREAKING IN SEPTEMBER—Littell has thrown back-to-back scoreless starts of 5.0+ IP for the first time in his career, becoming the third Ray to turn the trick this season, joining Taj Bradley (3GS, July 12-25) and Zach Eflin (April 15-20)...in club history, only six pitchers have accomplished the feat in three straight starts: Bradley, Ryan Yarbrough (2019), Jake Odorizzi (2016), Alex Colomé (2014), Alex Cobb (2014) and Matt Moore (2012). Littell's 13.0 scoreless inning streak is tied for the second-longest active run among AL starters, trailing DET Keider Montero (14.0), and is tied for fifth longest among all MLB starters.
