SILENT IN SANTO DOMINGO—The Rays were shut out by the Red Sox last night, 4-0, in the opening contest of the Dominican Republic Series...21-year-old RHP Yoniel Curet, a native of San Pedro de Macorís, DR, made the start and took the loss after allowing two

- runs on two hits and two walks with three strikeouts in 1.0 inning.

  Three Dominican Republic natives worked out of the Rays bullpen, including RHP Edwin Uceta (2.01P, 3H, 1ER, 6SO), LHP Antonio Jimenez (2.01P, 3H, 4SO) and
  - **18.** B Jonathan Aranda (2-for-4) was responsible for two of the Rays four hits on the night...he is batting .400 (8-for-20) with 3 2B in eight games this spring.

**RECENT TRANSACTIONS**—On Thursday afternoon, the Rays announced the following players were reassigned to minor league camp: **INF Evan Edwards**, **C Dominic Keegan**, **LHP Mason Montgomery**, **C Kenny Piper**, **RHP Nathan Wiles** and **RHP Logan Workman**.

WORLD TOUR—This marks the fourth time MLB has staged Spring Training games in the Dominican Republic, joining 2020 (DET vs. MIN), 2000 (HOU vs. BOS) and 1999 (NYM vs. MTL)...prior to this weekend, the Rays had never played in the country—their last international contests came during a season-opening series against the Yankees in Tokyo, Japan from March 30-31, 2004...they also played an exhibition game against the Cuban national team in Havana, Cuba on March 22, 2016.

The Rays have 10 players currently in major league camp who hail from the Dominican Republic: INF Junior Caminero, RHP Yoniel Curet, RHP Carlos Garcia, LHP Antonio Jimenez, RHP Enmanuel Mejía, C Francisco Mejia, INF/OF Amed Rosario, INF Ronny Simon, OF Jose Siri and RHP Edwin Uceta...both Caminero and Rosario are from Santo Domingo.

Bench Coach **Rodney Linares** is the son of **Julio Linares**, a San Pedro de Macorís,

Dominican Republic native who has been a member of the Astros organization as a coach, manager or scout since 1973...Rodney managed the Dominican Republic at the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

 ${\color{red} {\rm SOX}}$  STUFF—Tampa Bay serves as the visitor this afternoon in game two of the Dominican Republic Series at Estadio Quisqueya, marking the finale of four meetings between the clubs this spring...the Red Sox have defeated the Rays in all three matchups... since 2019, the Rays are 53-27 against the Red Sox during the regular season, including 11-2 last season.

PROSPECT WATCH—On Monday, MLB.com released its Top 30 Rays Prospect list...INF Junior Caminero leads the group, followed by INF Carson Williams, INF Curtis Mead, INF Xavier Isaac and INF Brayden Taylor...the largest jump in the system was made by C Dominic Keegan, who vaulted from No. 25 in 2023 to No. 6 in 2024.

On the 20-80 scouting scale, Caminero and Mead received a 60 for their hit tool, while Caminero received a 70 for Power...OF Chandler Simpson, rated Tampa Bay's No. 12 prospect, received an 80 for Speed following his 94 SB performance in 2023, added to the 40 man rester this offseason, PHP Vonial Curet extracts.

SPRING FEVER—The Rays are scheduled for 30 spring games in 32 days, including split-squad games on March 23 and off days on March 8 and 20...of the Rays 15 home games,

squad games on March 23 and off days on March 8 and 20...of the Rays 15 nome games, 13 will be played at Charlotte Sports Park...they will host the Tigers at Tropicana Field in their spring finale on March 26.

To March 16, Rays top prospects will battle their Twins counterparts in Fort Myers as part of MLB's Spring Breakout event...rosters will primarily be constructed through MLB.com's Top 30 Prospects list...the seven-inning contest will take place following the conclusion of the regularly scheduled Grapefruit will take place following the conclusion of the regularly scheduled Grapefruit League game between the two clubs.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN—The Rays have 71 players in major league camp, including 29 non-roster invites...of those 71 players, 18 (25.4%) are homegrown, meaning they were drafted or signed as an amateur free agent and developed by the Rays player development system, while 20 (28.2%) are new to the organization since the conclusion of the 2023 season...the Rays have 36 pitchers (14 NRI), six catchers (5 NRI), 17 infielders (5 NRI) and 12 outfielders (5 NRI) in major league camp.

Nine players have been added to the Rays 40-man roster since the conclusion of last season: LHP Tyler Alexander, INF José Caballero, RHP Yoniel Curet, OF Jonny DeLuca, RHP Phil Maton, OF Richie Palacios, RHP Ryan Pepiot, RHP Manuel Rodríguez, INF Amed Rosario and INF Austin Shenton.

**AT THE HELM**—Entering his 10th season, Rays manager **Kevin Cash** is the longest-tenured skipper in the majors with his current club...Cash is set to surpass his predecessor, Joe Maddon (2006-14), as the longest-tenured manager in Rays history on Opening Day (March 28 vs. TOR)...he sits 16 victories shy of overtaking Maddon (754) as the Rays all-time leader in managerial wins...despite being the seventh-youngest active manager in the majors, he ranks among his peers in career winning pct. (4th, .545) and wins (8th, 739).

He has been named a BBWAA AL Manager of the Year finalist five times in the last six seasons (since 2018), winning the award twice (2020-21) and receiving

votes in all six campaigns.

In 2023, Cash became the youngest manager in MLB history to reach the postseason in five consecutive seasons (45), ahead of LAD **Dave Roberts**, who was 48 years old when he clinched his fifth straight postseason berth in 2020 (Elias).

On Feb. 8, the Rays announced that Cash and President, Baseball Operations **Erik Neander** have been signed to long-term contract extensions.

**COACHING STAFE**—The Rays have announced their 2024 major league coaching staff under manager **Kevin Cash...Michael Johns** joins the club as first base coach following 16 seasons in the Rays minor league system, including nine as a manager...Bobby Kinne (pitching strategist) has been added to the uniformed coaching staff after spending six years in the Rays organization, most recently as coordinator, major league operations over the last two seasons (2022-23)...returning coaches include Tomas Francisco (field coord.), Rick Knapp (asst. pitching/rehab), Rodney Linares (bench), Jorge Moncada (bullpen), Chad Mottola (hitting), Brady North (asst. hitting), Kyle Snyder (pitching) and Brady Williams (third base).

### **2023 IN REVIEW**

- Split the season between the Guardians and Rays after being acquired by Tampa Bay in a July 31 trade in exchange for INF Kyle Manzardo...between both clubs, set career highs in starts (23), strikeouts (116), opp. slugging pct. (.363) and bWAR (2.7).
- After making two starts with Cleveland on April 1 and 7, was on the 15-day IL with a left oblique strain from April 10-June 2...recorded a 2.24 ERA (64.1IP, 16ER) in his final 11 starts with the Guardians...led the AL with a 1.45 ERA (27.1IP, 6ER) across six starts in July.
- Went 2-3 with a 5.06 ERA (45.1IP, 27ER) over 10 starts with the Rays.

- 2023: Made 47 relief appearances for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, going 2-6 with a 5.45 ERA (67.2IP, 41ER)...the 47 appearances were third most among Yankees farmhands.
- Selected by the Rays in the minor league portion of the 2023 Rule 5 Draft.

- Spring Training: Has made two apperances (1GS)...started on Feb. 25 vs. Detroit and tossed 2.0 innings of one-run ball...allowed two runs (1 earned) on two hits on March 1 at PIT.
